In February 2025, United Kingdom (12.9%), France (9.5%), Madagascar (9.2%), South Africa (8.0%), Spain (7.8%) and United States (6.8%) were our major exports destinations while our imports were mainly from China (17.2%), Sultanate of Oman (14.9%), India (9.7%), South Africa (8.7%), U.A.E. (4.5%) and France (4.1%).
