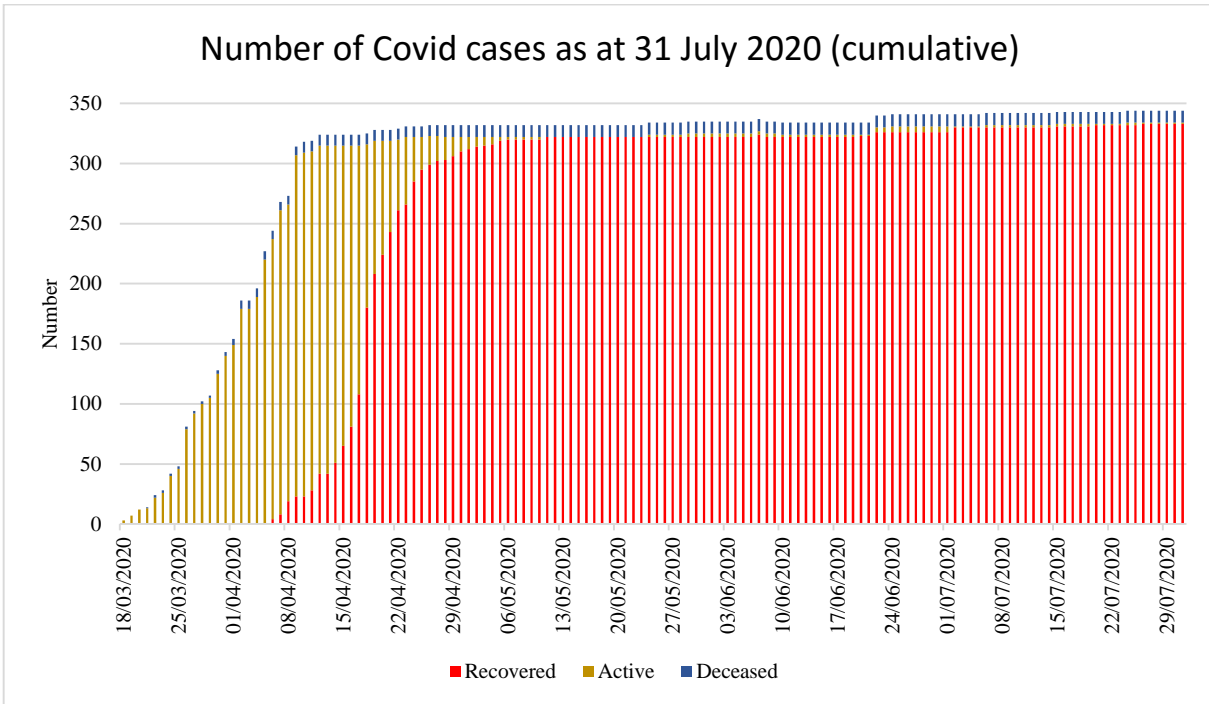

Mauritius curbs the spread of the virus to near Covid-free at end of July 2020



Men are more vulnerable to COVID-19 than women

The incidence of COVID-19 is nearly twice as high among men than among women

	Male	Female	Total
Covid-19 cases (no.)	213	131	344
Incidence rate (per 100,000 population)	34.0	20.5	27.2

Infected men are more likely to die of the virus than infected women

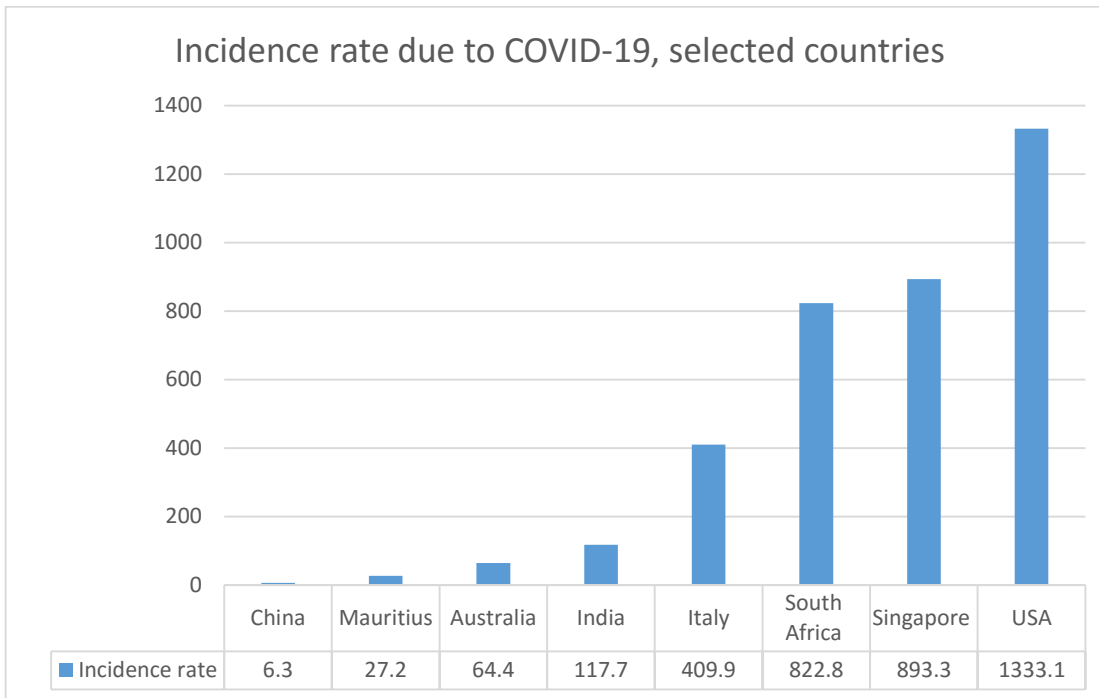
	Male	Female	Total

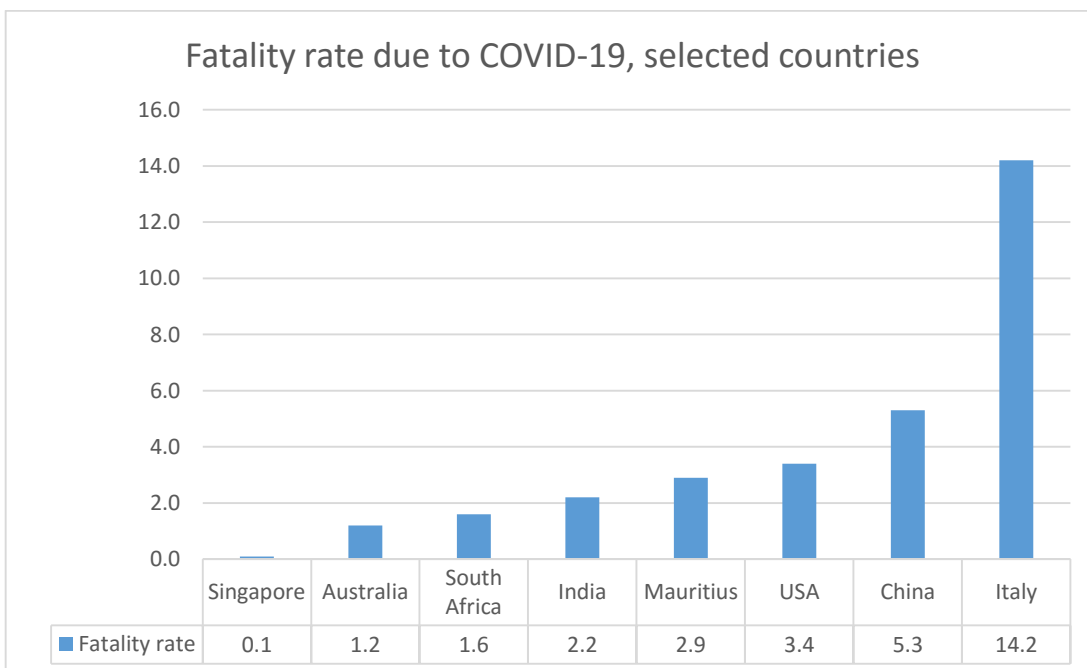

Mauritius fares well compared to advanced countries ...

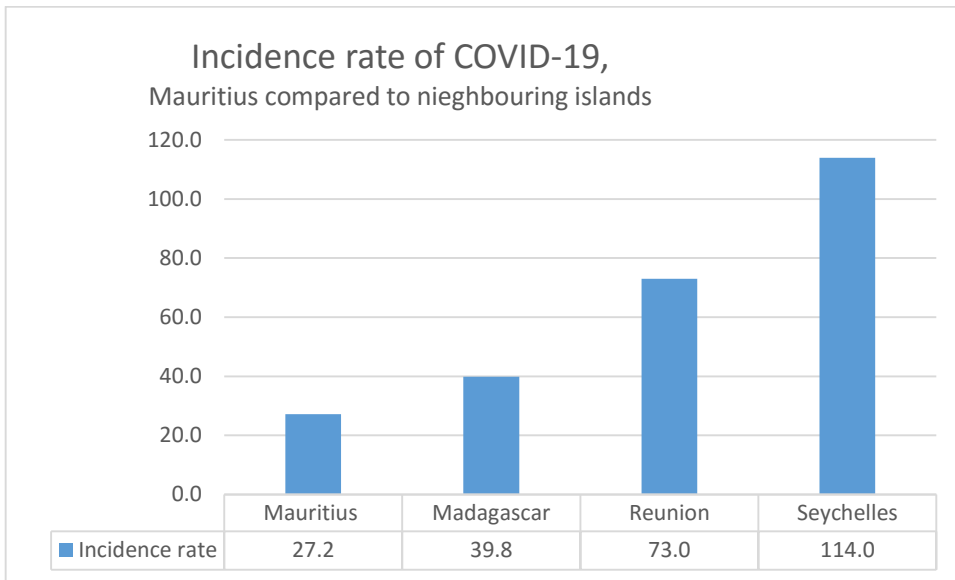

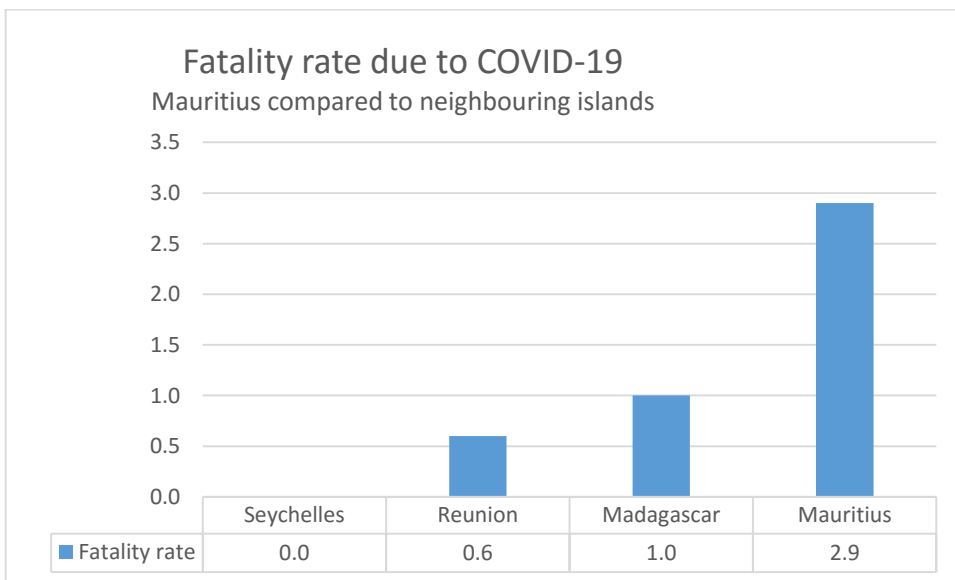
