KLLM's objective is to present a core set of labour market indicators to minimum market, toaching on employment and other variables relating to employment (status, sector, hours, flows etc.), the lack of work and the characteristics of jobseekers, education, wages and compensation costs, labour productivity and working poverty. KLLM's objective is to present a core set of labour market indicators to minimum market, toaching on sources such as household surveys (e.g. Continuous Multipurpose Household Survey (CMPHS), Survey of employment and Earnings (SEE), povery statistics), administrative data (e.g. Ministry of labour) and Housing and population census.
