This is the fourth issue of a regular publication of the Central Statistics Office on business activity statistics.

Data refer to business activities undertaken in the Island of Mauritius, which are either licensed with the Local Authorities (Municipalities and District Councils) or registered with an organisation.

The figures provided in this publication are based on the latest available data and are thus slightly different from those published in the April 2002 issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Business Activity Statistics.

The business activities have been coded according to the National Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities (NSIC) given in the annex.

It is hoped that this report will be of valuable help to the public in general and to planners and policy makers in particular.

The co-operation and assistance of the Local Authorities and other organisations are gratefully acknowledged.

## **Business Activity Statistics, July 2000 - June 2001**

### **Introduction**

**Business Activity Statistics** are compiled mainly from the administrative records of the local authorities and government departments responsible for the delivery of licences and registration certificates. Thus only licensed and registered activities are covered. Currently all agricultural related activities are also not covered.

It must also be pointed out that the statistics on business activity refer to the total number of licensed or registered activities and not to the total number of operation units or establishments. For example, a general retailer may hold three licences: one for trading in foodstuffs, a second for selling tobacco and a third for selling liquor. An analysis of the data on licences and registrations provides useful information on trends in business activities.

### **2. Licences issued and cessations between July 2000 and June 2001**

During the period July 2000 to June 2001, 4,931 new licences were issued, of which 3,396 (68.8%) were for activities classified under 'Wholesale & Retail trade; Repair of motor vehicles, motorcycles and personal and households goods'. During the same period 1,359 licences were cancelled. The total number of licences as at June 2001 therefore stood at 64,029 which, compared to 60,457 as at June 2000, represents an increase of 3,572 (5.9%) (Table 1.1).

### **3. Licences and registrations as at June 2001**

The number of licensed and registered business activities as at June 2001 totalled 77,937 which, compared to 74,393 at the end of June 2000, shows a net addition of 3,544 (4.8%). The highest number of such activities was in 'Wholesale and Retail trade; Repair of motor vehicles, motorcycles and personal and households goods' with 42,713 activities (57.4%), followed by 'Transport, Storage & Communications', 13,827 (18.6%).

The highest increases over the previous year are noted in the 'Other Community, social & personal services' with 409 new activities (17.1%) and in the Construction sector with 67 new activities (12.0%) (Table 3).

### **4. Distribution by urban and rural region**

The distribution of licences and registrations by main activity and region (urban and rural) is given in Table 4.1. Of the 77,937 licensed and registered activities, there were 40,242 (51.6%) in the rural areas and 37,695 (48.4%) in the urban ones.

Analysis of the data, however, shows some disparities in the spatial distribution of the activities at industry group level. It is observed that activities classified under 'Mining and Quarrying' and 'Hotels and Restaurants' are more concentrated in the rural areas because such activities are mostly located in the coastal regions. Those of 'Transport, Storage and Communication' follow the same trend. On the other hand activities pertaining to industry groups 'Health and Social Work', 'Real Estate, Renting and Business Services' and 'Financial Intermediation' are mostly found in the urban areas.

## Technical Notes

### 1. Concepts and coverage

Data compiled in this publication pertain to all activities licensed at the relevant local authorities (Municipal and District Councils) as well as those registered with the respective government authorities. All activities carried out without a licence or registration are therefore excluded. Currently all agricultural related activities are also not covered.

An operator is required to obtain a licence from the Municipal or District Councils for each type of activity or to register with the appropriate Ministry or Organisation (eg Ministry of Education, Medical Council etc.). In some cases an operator may hold both a licence and a registration certificate and to avoid double counting, such activities have been accounted for in either registration or licence only.

### 2. Classification and presentation of data

To cater for the wide range and diverse business activities and for classification purposes, each activity has been assigned an activity code according to the **National Standard Industrial classification of Economic Activities (NSIC)**, which is an adapted version of the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC), Rev. 3, 1990.

The NSIC consists of 5 levels of classification namely:

Level 1	<b>Section:</b>	17 sections identified by one of the letters A to Q
Level 2	<b>Division:</b>	56 divisions identified by the first 2 digits
Level 3	<b>Group:</b>	151 groups identified by the first 3 digits
Level 4	<b>Classes:</b>	302 classes identified by the first 4 digits
Level 5	<b>Sub-classes:</b>	546 sub-classes identified by the first digits

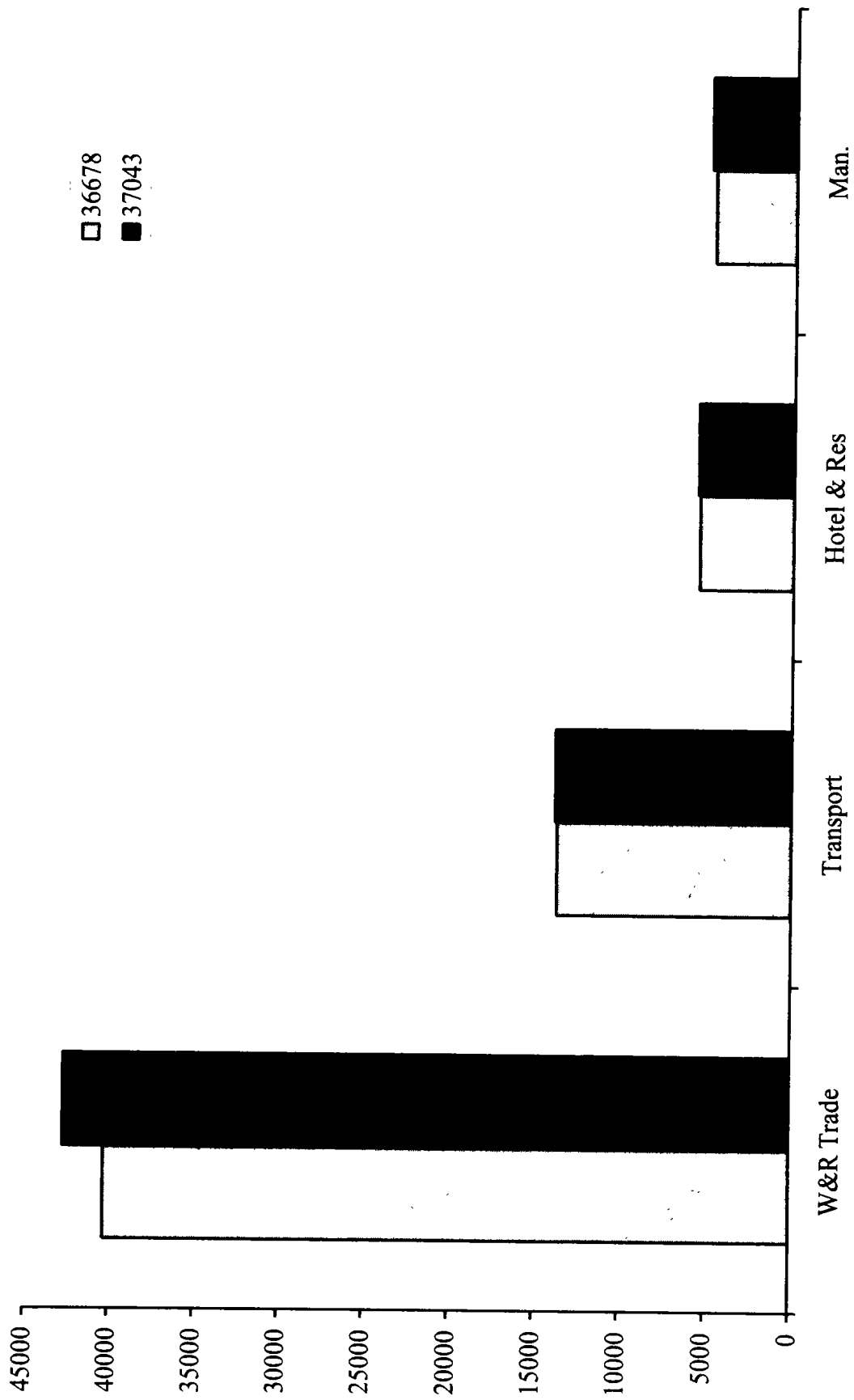

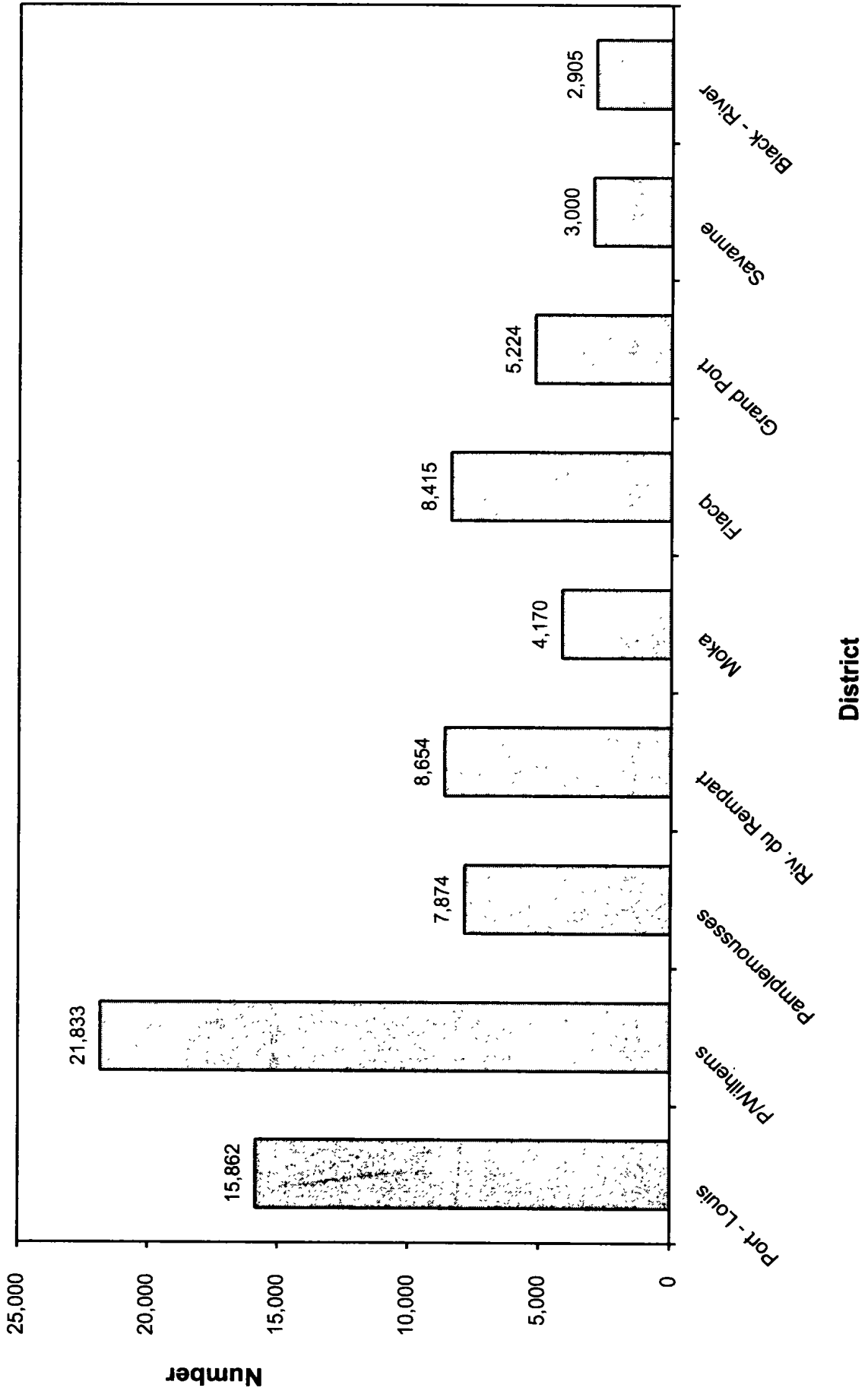
