

## **Business Activity Statistics – Financial Year 2002/2003**

### **Foreword**

This is the sixth issue of a regular publication of the Central Statistics Office on business activity statistics.

Data refer to business activities undertaken in the island of Mauritius, which are either licensed with the local authorities (Municipalities and District Councils) or registered with the appropriate organizations such as the Medical Council, the Ministry of Education and Scientific Research, the National Transport Authority, etc.

The business activities have been coded according to the National Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities (NSIC) which is an adapted version of the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC) Rev. 3, 1990.

It is hoped that this report will be of valuable help to the public in general and to planners and policy makers in particular.

The co-operation and assistance of the local authorities, professional councils and other organisations are gratefully acknowledged.

## Technical Notes

### 1. General

Data compiled in this publication provide useful information on demography and trend of business activities in the different economic sectors of the country.

### 2. Concepts and Coverage

An operator is required to obtain a licence from the Municipal or District Councils for each type of activity or to register with the appropriate Ministry or organisations (e.g Ministry of Education and Scientific Research, the Medical Council, the National Transport Authority, the Mauritius Freeport Authority, etc.) Statistics published in this report pertain only to activities that are either licensed or registered. Thus activities which are not licensed/registered are excluded. All agricultural related activities, except those in the manufacture of food products, are also not covered.

In some cases, an operator may hold both a licence and a registration certificate. To avoid double counting, such activities have been accounted for in either registration or licence only. For example the owner of a bus, besides registering his vehicle with the National Transport Authority may also hold a licence issued by a district council. In the table giving figures for both licences and registrations, the activity of the bus owner is accounted for in registration only.

### 3. Classification and presentation of data

To cater for the wide range and diverse business activities and for classification purposes, each activity has been assigned an activity code according to the **National Standard Industrial classification of Economic Activities (NSIC)**, which is an adapted version of the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC), Rev. 3, 1990.

**The NSIC consists of 5 levels of classification namely:**

Level 1	<b>Section:</b>	17 sections identified by one of the letters A to Q
Level 2	<b>Division:</b>	56 divisions identified by the first 2 digits
Level 3	<b>Group:</b>	151 groups identified by the first 3 digits
Level 4	<b>Classes:</b>	302 classes identified by the first 4 digits
Level 5	<b>Sub-classes:</b>	546 sub-classes identified by the first digits

## **Business Activity Statistics, July 2002 - June 2003**

### **1. Evolution of Licences between July 2002 and June 2003**

During the period July 2002 to June 2003, a total of 5,820 new licences were issued whilst 1,822 were cancelled. This resulted in a net addition of 3,998 licences which brings the total number of licences to 69,316 as at June 2003. The distribution of the new licences by industry group shows that 65% (3,756) of new licences comprised activities classified in 'Wholesale & retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, personal and household goods'. The majority (66%) of the number of licences cancelled during the same period pertained to the same sector (Table 1.1).

### **2. Licences and registrations as at June 2003**

The total number of licensed and registered activities as at June 2003 reached 85,993 showing an increase of 4,597 (6%) over the corresponding figure of 81,396 for June 2002. The highest number of activities 46,875 (54%) was in the industry group 'Wholesale & retail trade; repair of motor vehicles, personal and household goods', followed by 17,208 (20%) in 'Transport, storage and communications' (Table 2.1).

### **3. Distribution by region and industry**

The distribution of licensed and registered activities by industry group and region is given in Table 4.1. The number of activities is slightly higher in rural regions – 44,856 (52%). Activities which are predominantly in urban regions are from the industry group 'Health and social work' (77%) and 'Real estate, renting and business activities' (66%). On the other hand activities pertaining to the group 'Hotels and restaurants' are located mainly in rural areas (65%).

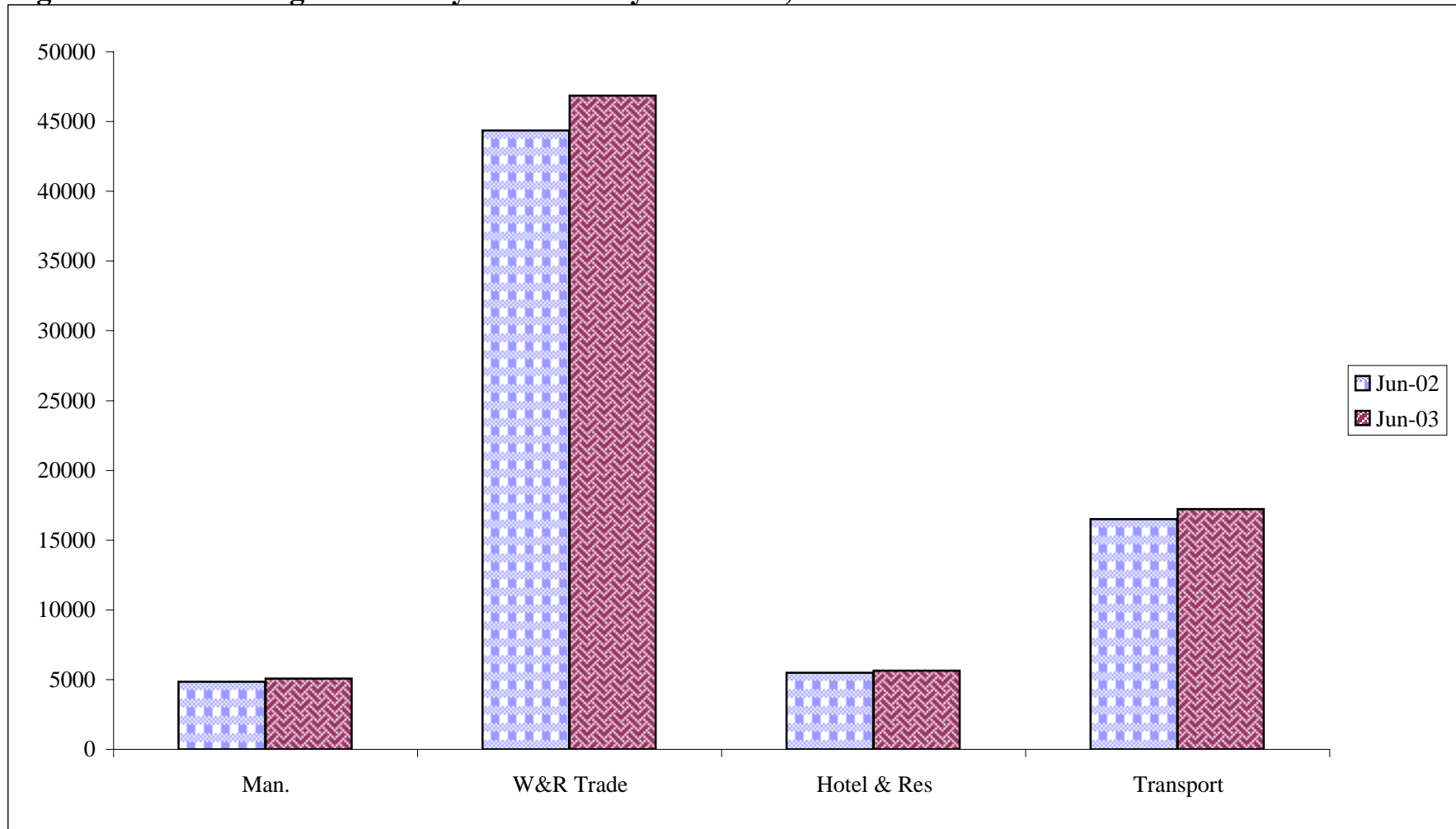

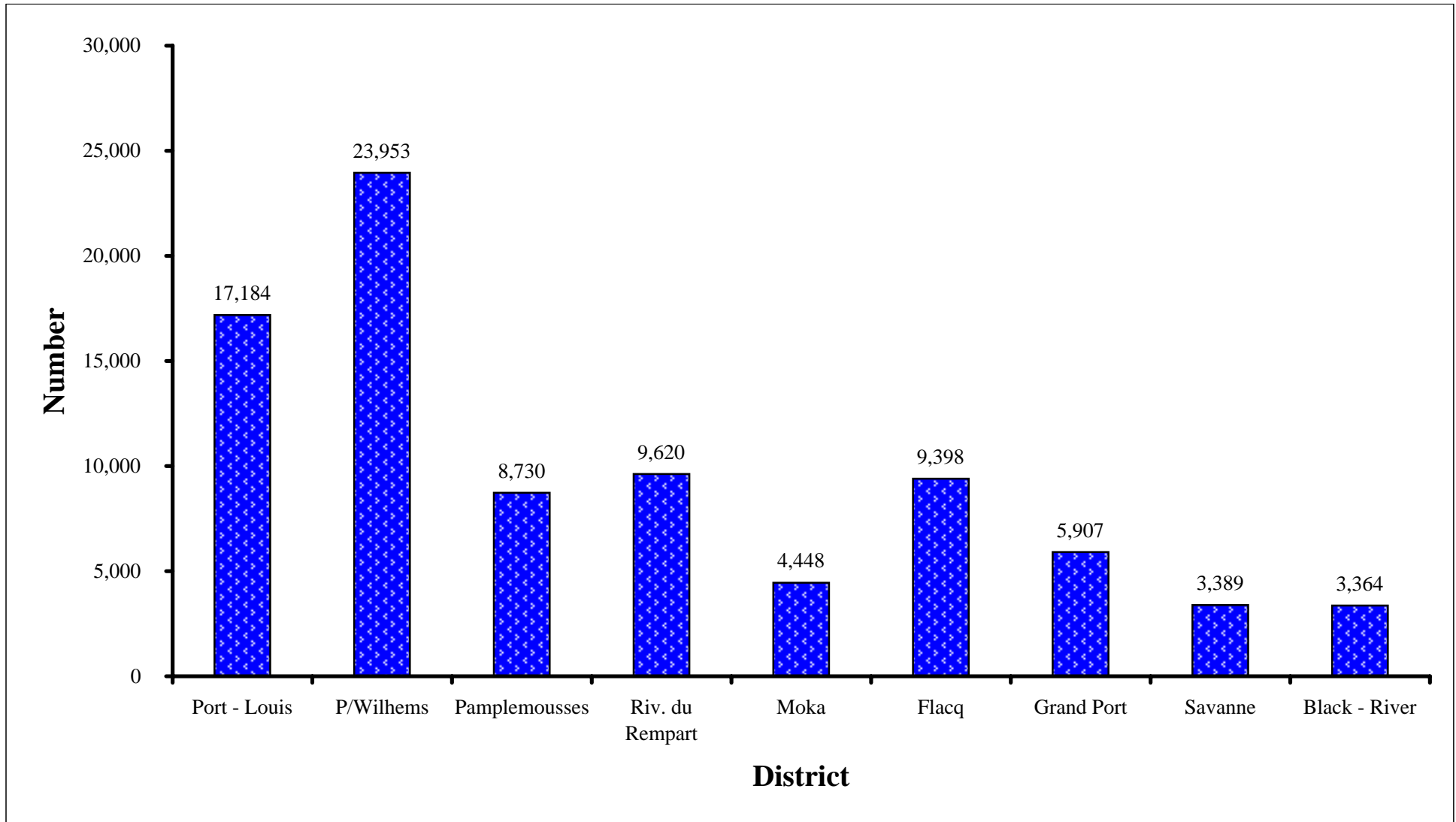
