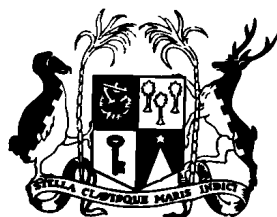

# Digest of Educational Statistics

1992

This is the ninth issue of a regular publication of the Central Statistical Office on educational statistics.

Detailed and comprehensive data on primary and secondary education have been collected from all schools and colleges of the country in 1992 and processed on micro-computer at the Ministry of Education and Science. Some data on tertiary education have also been included. The results showing information relating to schools, enrolments, teaching and administrative staff, examinations, etc. are presented in this publication.

Data on teaching staff refer to 30 April while those on enrolment and infrastructure refer to 30 June 1992.

It is hoped that the Statistics which have been assembled in this report will be useful to the public in general and to education planners and policy makers in particular.

The assistance of the Ministry of Education and Science in the collection and processing of the data and the co-operation of all head teachers and managers of educational institutions in providing the necessary information are gratefully acknowledged.

 Republic of Mauritius

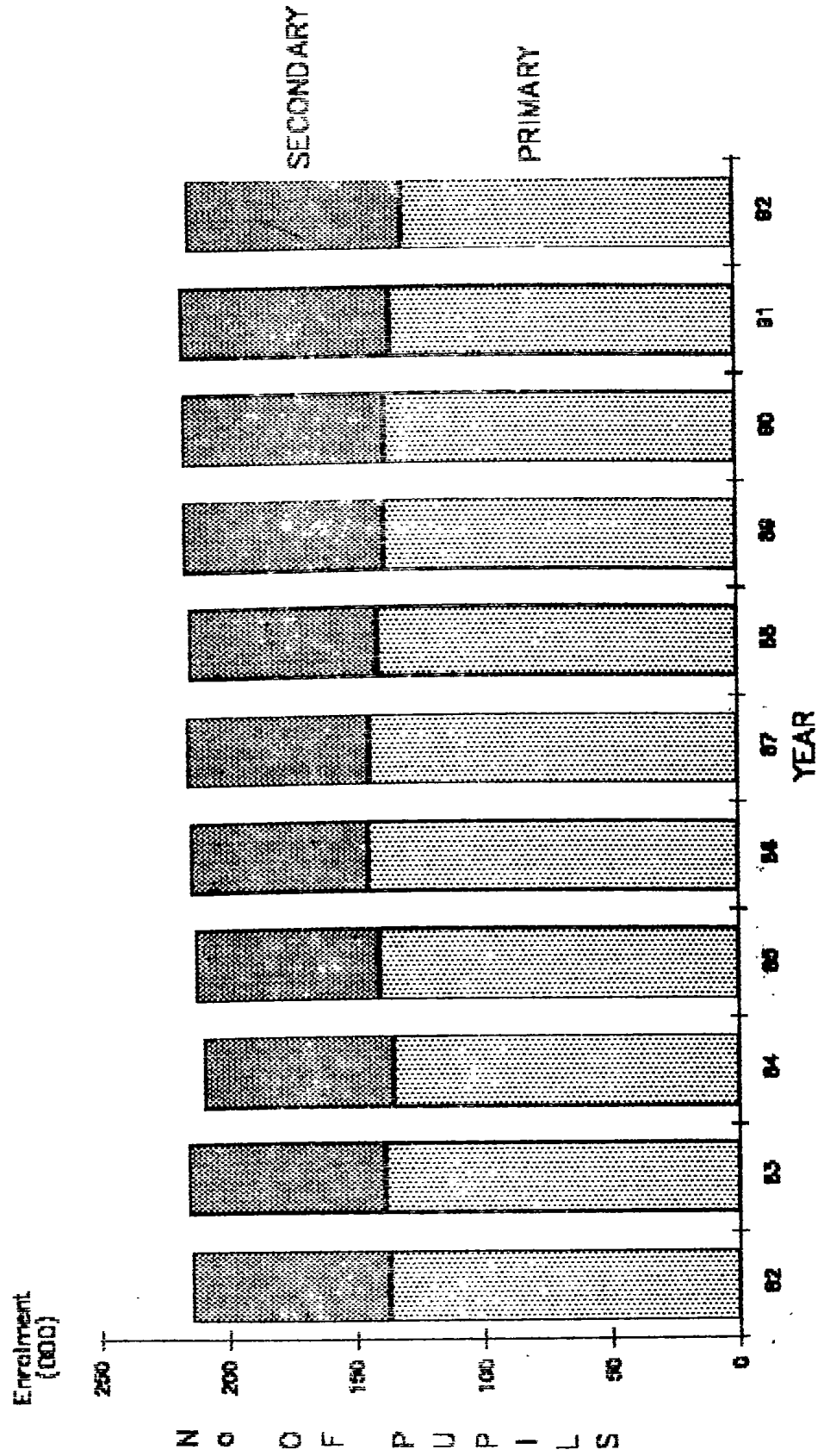


Fig.2 - Primary and Secondary enrollment, 1982-1992  
Island of Mauritius

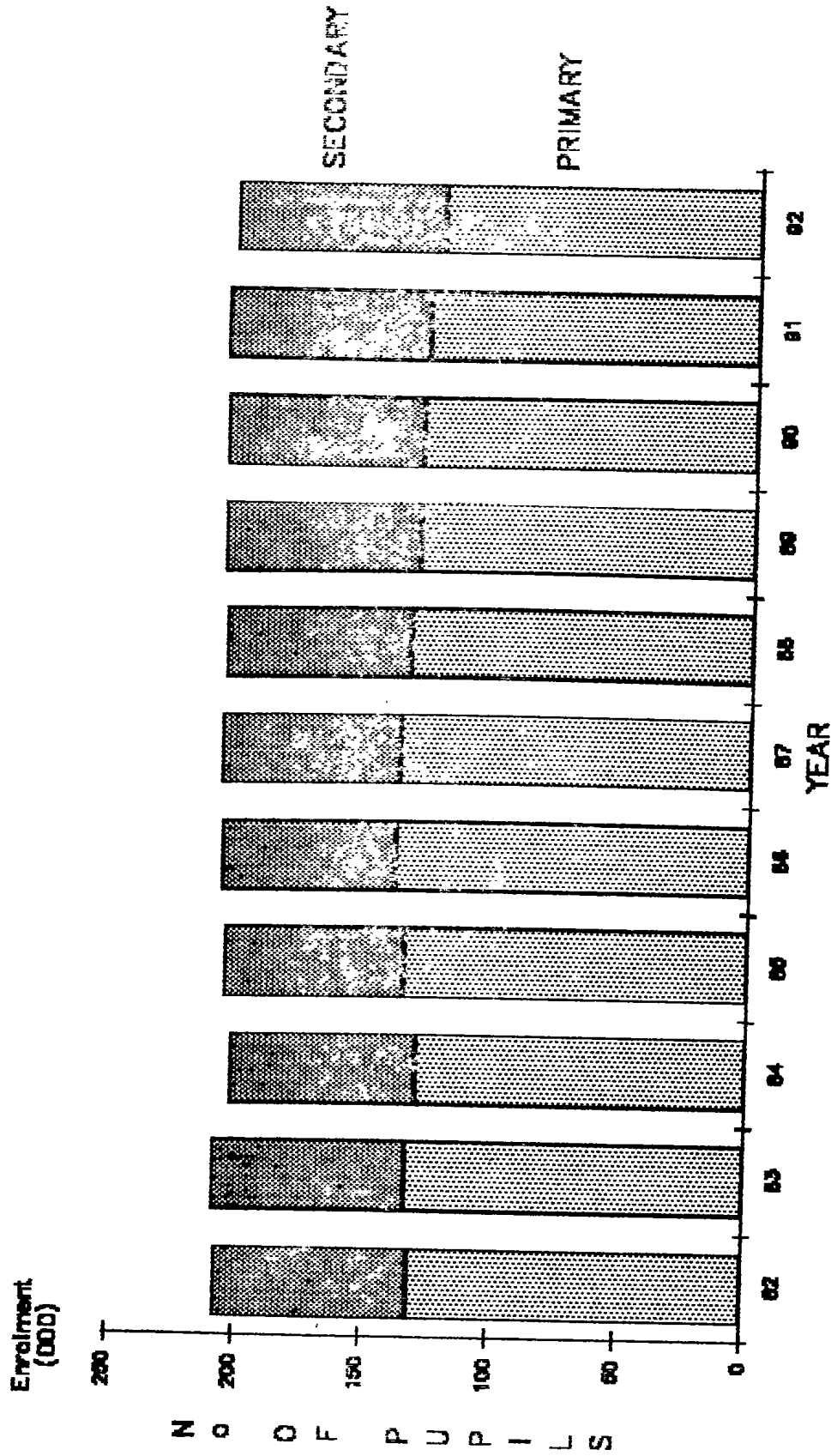
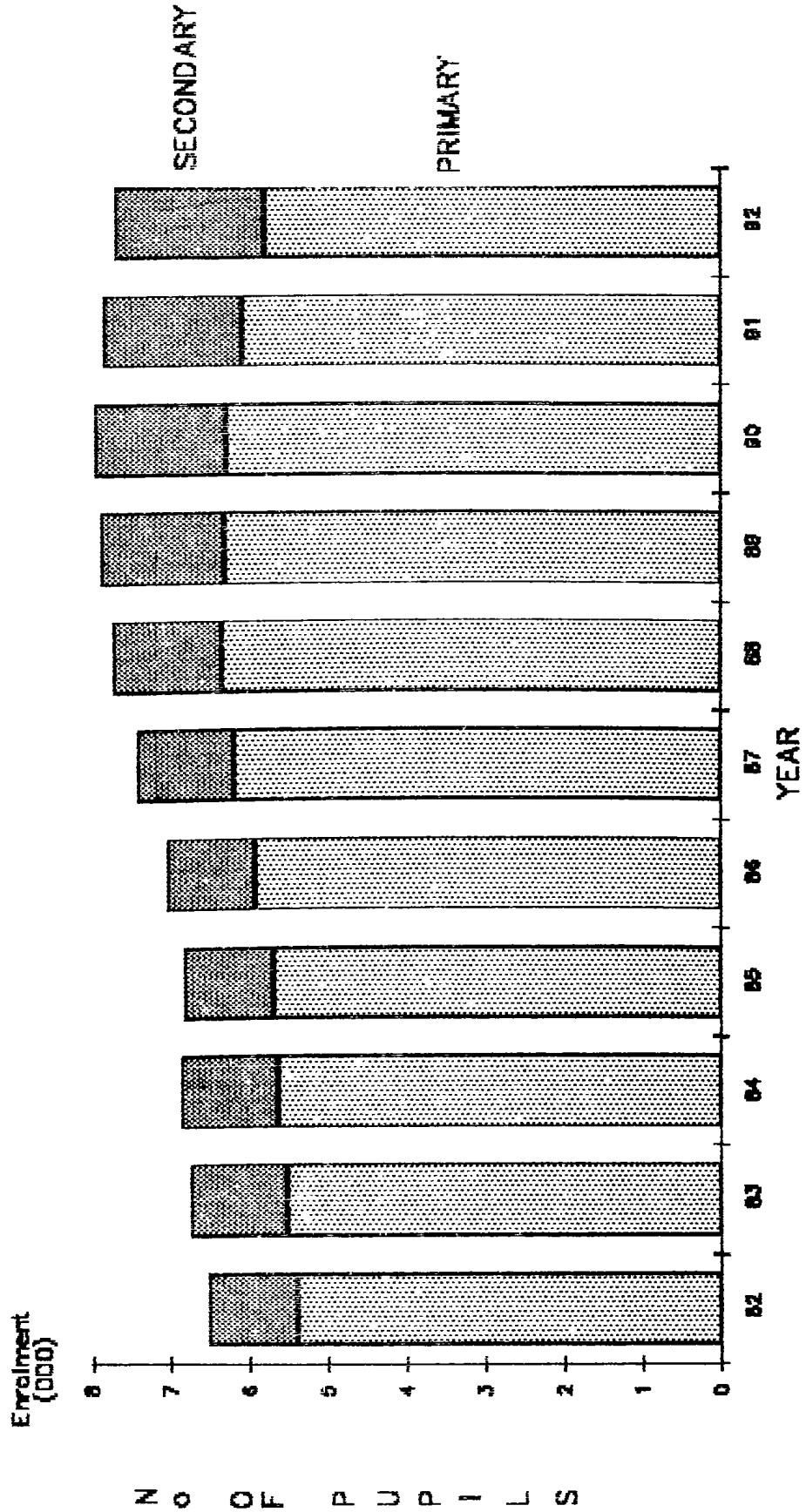


Fig.3 - Primary and Secondary enrolment, 1982-1992

Republic of Mauritius**

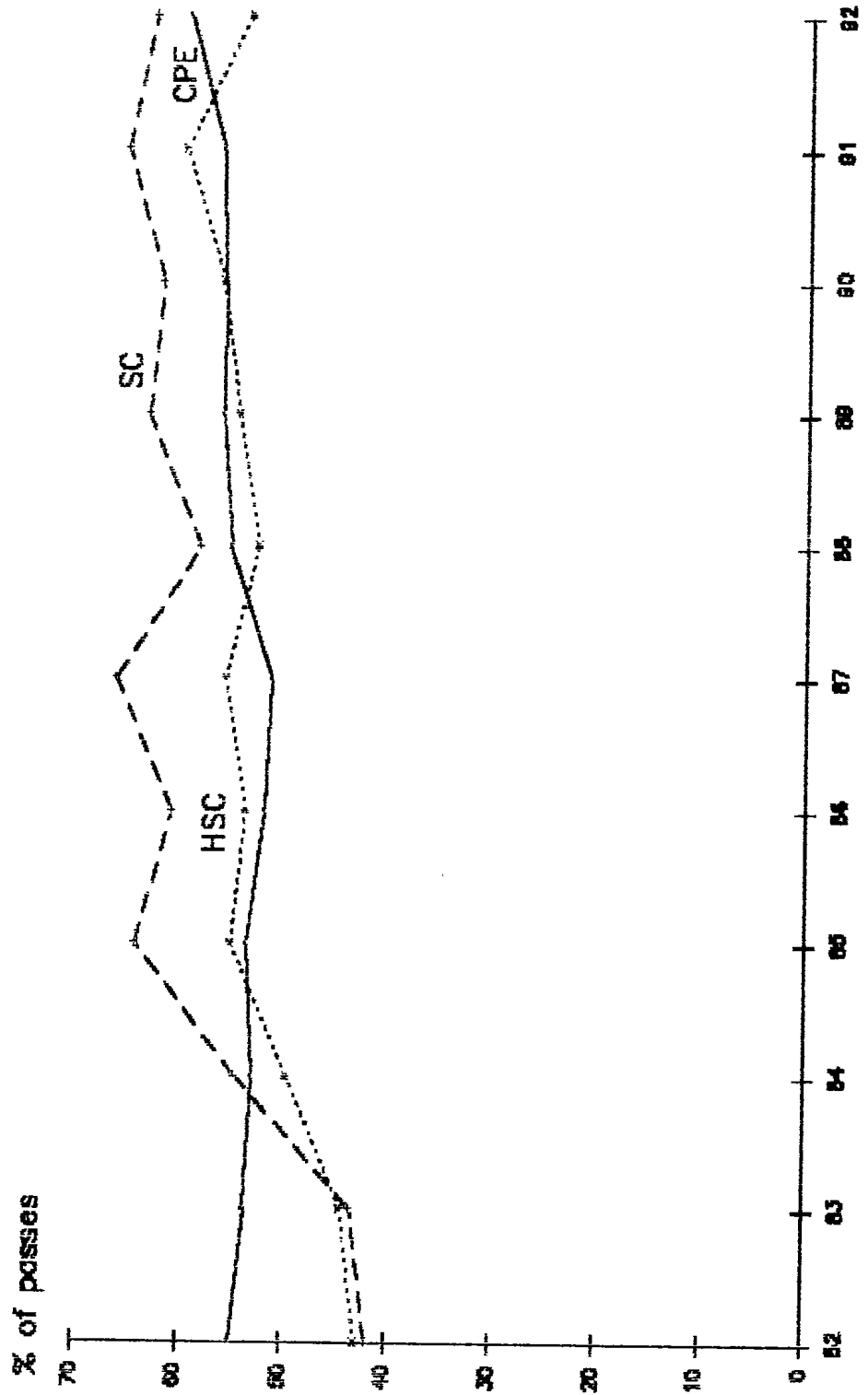


Fig.5--Certificate of Primary Education, School Certificate and Higher School Certificate Examination results, 1982--1992  
Island of Mauritius

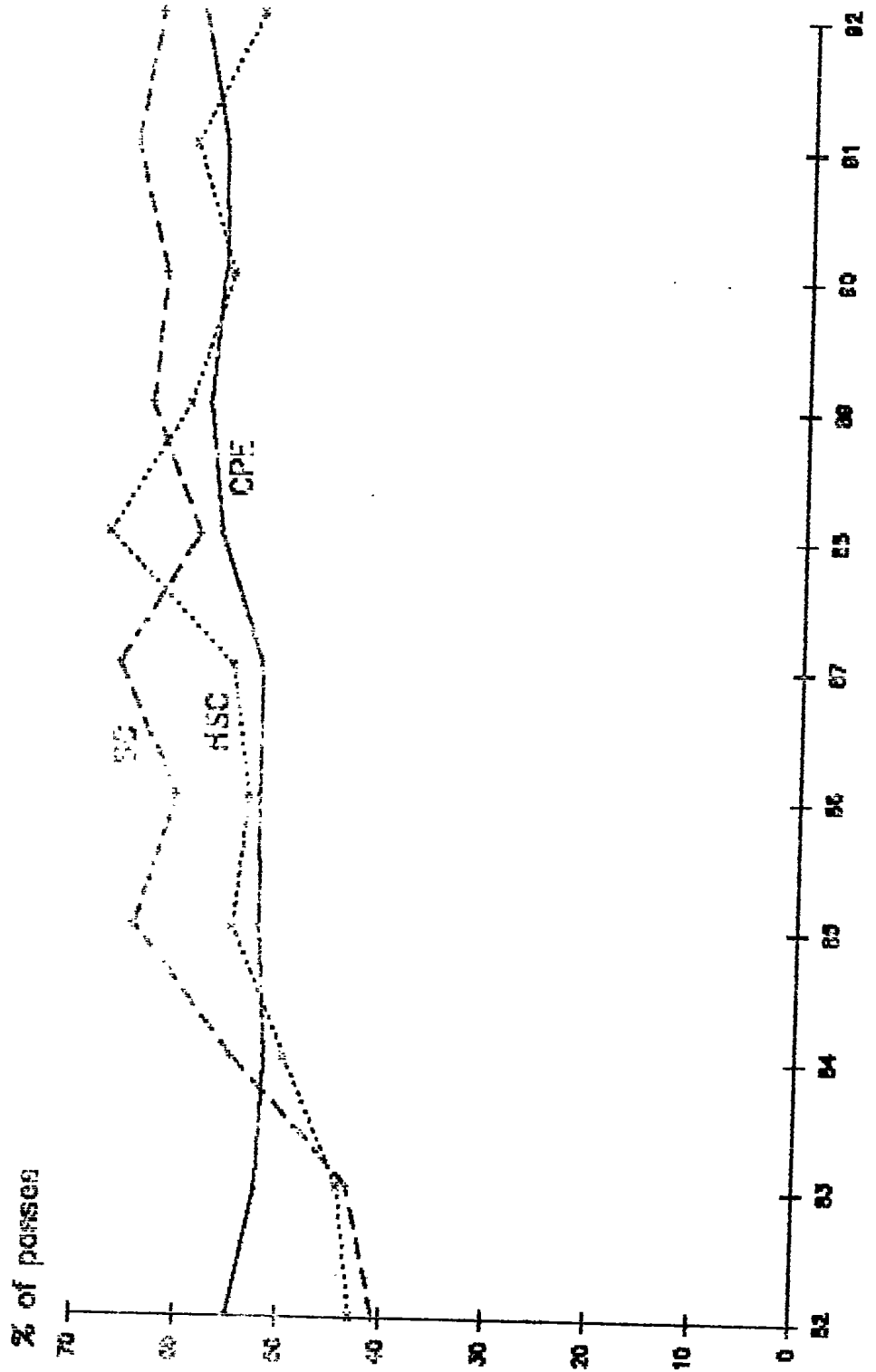


Fig.6—Certificate of Primary Education, School Certificate and Higher School Certificate Examination results, 1982—1992
