This report, on External Trade Statistics used to be published every quarter since 1985. In 1987 and 1988, only one single annual report consolidating the four quarterly data was published and as from 1989, it is being published on a semester basis.

This issue contains quarterly data on exports and imports relating to the year 1993. The figures are provisional and are liable to revision in the next issue.

The basic data for the preparation of this publication are obtained from the Bills of Entry filed in at the Customs & Excise Department and from the Mauritius Sugar Syndicate and the State Trading Corporation which provide supplementary information. The Central Information Systems Division (CISD) of the Ministry of Finance is responsible for the processing of the data. Grateful acknowledgement is expressed here to all these departments for their continued cooperation.

It is hoped that data given in this report proves useful to the public in general and to all those in the field of external trade.

During the first semester, the Country's main buyers remained the European Economic Community (EEC) which purchased 74 percent of our exports. The United States absorbed another 17 percent of the total.

4. Imports

The import bill for the second quarter of 1993 amounted to Rs 7,700 million compared to Rs 6,340 million (+21%) million in the corresponding quarter of 1992 and Rs 6,250 million (+23%) in the previous quarter.

Total imports for the period January-June 1993 increased by 16 percent, reaching Rs 12,900 million from Rs 12,000 million in the corresponding period of last year. As import prices between these two periods are estimated to have gone up by 7 percent, in volume terms, imports grew by around 8 percent.

As shown in the comparative table below, all product groups have recorded increases. Major increases were however noted in bill for food products (+24%) and machinery (+27%). EPZ companies purchase of raw materials was up by 18 percent and that of machinery and equipment, by 50%. The substantial rise in import of food products is partly explained by bulk purchases of rice and higher imports of intermediate goods for further processing before exports.

Table 7 on imports by country of origin shows that during the first semester of 1993, the major suppliers were: the EEC (35%), Republic of South Africa (13%), Japan (6%) and India and Hong Kong (5%) each.

5. The EPZ Sector

During the second quarter of 1993, the EPZ enterprises exported Rs 4,200 million worth of goods yielding a total for the first semester of around Rs 7,000 million against Rs 6,000 a year earlier. This figure represents a nominal increase of 16 percent over last year's achievement and is explained by about 9 percent increase in price and 7 percent in quantity.

Likewise, imports also registered a significant increase of 21 percent to Rs 4,500 million from Rs 3,700 million in the same period last year. Purchases of raw materials were up by Rs 600 million (+18%) and an additional Rs 182 million was spent on import of machinery and equipment.

-- (iv) -

Consequently, net EPZ exports for the first six months of the year yielded Rs 2,500 million, 8 percent above the Rs 2,300 million earned in the corresponding period last year. The ratio of net exports to exports works out to 36%, slightly lower than that of the same period last year.

On this trend, total EPZ exports in 1993 will most likely attain Rs 15,000 million against Rs 13,100 million last year.
