It is hoped that the data herewith assembled will prove useful to the public in general and to policy makers, planners and research workers in particular.

The statistical tables presented here are based on the embarkation/disembarkation cards filled in by passengers as they leave or enter the country in the course of their travel. The statistical data have been estimated on the basis of a 10% sample of these cards.

Statistical data on International Travel and Tourism are constantly updated as more reliable information become available, necessitating minor changes over previous issues of this publication. The figures published in this issue therefore supersede those of all previous issues.

The publication of this report has been made possible by the co-operation obtained from the Immigration and Passport Office, the Mauritius Government Tourist Office and the Data Processing Division of the Ministry of Finance. Their co-operation is herewith gratefully acknowledged.

Fig. 1(a) - Passenger Traffic: Total Arrivals by sex, 1974-1990




Fig. 1(b) - Passenger Traffic: Total Departures by sex, 1974-1990




Fig. 1c- Total arrivals and departures  
1980-1990



## IV - TOURISM

### Definition and notes

#### 1. Definition of tourist

- (a) prior to 1964, a tourist has been defined as a non-resident staying in Mauritius for more than 24 hours but less than 6 months.
- (b) as from 1964, a tourist is defined as a non-resident staying in the island for more than 24 hours but less than a year.

The figures for the two periods are nevertheless comparable because of the small number of tourists staying for more than 6 months.

#### 2. Visitors include the following:

- (a) tourists as defined above; and
- (b) non-residents who stay in the country for less than a day, other than those who do not leave the airport.

#### 3. Method of compilation

Certain data on tourism (such as type of visitor, tourist arrivals by month of arrival, tourist arrivals by country of residence and mode of transport) are compiled from disembarkation (arrival) cards which all passengers have to fill in when they arrive in this country. However, information on duration of stay of visitors can be compiled only from the embarkation (departure) cards which they fill in when they leave the country.

As from January 1979 figures are based on a 10% sample. Data on "visitor arrivals" are compiled both from embarkation and disembarkation cards. Since the compilation has been done on a sample basis the figures of "visitor arrivals" obtained when working with records of arrivals do not tally with those obtained when working with records of departures. The figures in the latter case have been prorated to the totals obtained when working with records of arrivals.

#### 4. Tourist nights

Table 35, 41 and 42 show the number of nights spent by tourists who were present in the country during the period under review. Thus the number of tourist nights for 1990 include:

- (a) the nights spent during 1990 by tourists who arrived prior to 1st January 1990; and
- (b) the nights spent during 1990 by tourists who arrived during the same year.

However, nights spent after 31st December 1990 by tourists who arrived in 1990 are excluded.

#### 5. Visitor nights

The concept of visitor nights is different from that of tourist nights. Here, an attempt is made to find how many nights have been spent by the total number of visitors who arrived during the period (year) under review. For instance, the total number of visitor nights for 1990 should refer to the total number of nights spent by all visitors who arrived during the year 1990. To get this figure it is necessary to wait until all visitors who came in 1990 have left the country. However, since in principle, a visitor can stay up to one year, it is not possible to wait for so long before compiling the data. Thus, the figures for the year 1990 actually refer to the total number of nights spent as at the end of February 1991. Hence, a visitor who arrived in November 1990 and who left in March 1991 will unfortunately not be recorded in the given figures. However, because of the very small number of visitors who stay for more than two months, the errors should probably not be very significant.

6. Mauritians settled abroad are excluded from figures of tourists and visitors. Data referring to them are shown separately in tables 53.- 55. Table 53 shows the total nights spent by Mauritians settled abroad who arrived during the period under review and who have left by a given date after the end of the period. Thus the figure for 1990 include nights spent in January - February 1991 by Mauritians settled abroad who arrived in 1990. Table 55 shows the nights spent during the period under review only. Thus the figures for 1990 include nights spent in 1990 by Mauritians settled abroad, who arrived in 1989 or prior but exclude nights spent in January - February 1991 by those who arrived in 1990.

Fig. 2 - Tourist arrivals by month of arrival, 1986 - 1990



Fig. 3 - Percentage distribution of tourist arrivals by country of residence, 1990



Fig. 4 - Total arrivals and tourist arrivals, 1980-1990




Fig. 5 - Tourist nights and visitor nights, 1980 - 1990


