**(3rd Quarter 1990)**

**1. INTRODUCTION**

This issue of the Economic Indicators presents data on employment in the Export Processing Zone as at September 1990. A forecast of EPZ exports and imports for the year 1990 is also given.

**2. EMPLOYMENT EVOLUTION DURING THE 3RD QUARTER**

During the 3rd quarter 1990, 18 new enterprises started operation whilst 10 closed down bringing the total number operating as at September 1990 to 574. Contrary to the previous two quarters when almost no growth in employment was reported, the 3rd quarter witnessed a net loss of nearly 2,000 workers, of whom the majority (1,500) were female workers.

EPZ workforce as at September 1990 therefore stood at 88,300 of whom nearly 60,400 were female workers and 27,900 male workers.

A detailed analysis of employment evolution by enterprise shows the high turnover of workers in the EPZ enterprises : a total of 3,300 additional jobs was created of which 900 resulted from the setting up of the 18 new enterprises and 2,400 by enterprises which were expanding their activities. During the same period, a loss of 5,300 jobs was reported. Some 4,000 workers left some 50 enterprises whilst 1,300 were laid off by the 10 companies which ceased operation. The sectoral distribution of the net loss of 2,000 jobs was as follows: 'Pullover manufacturing' (-750), 'Other garments' (-800), 'Watches' (-100) and 'Jewellery' (-250).

**3. EMPLOYMENT AS AT SEPTEMBER 1990**

After reaching the high peak of 91,600 in June 88, employment in the EPZ sector has been oscillating between the 88,000 - 90,000 mark during the past two years.

During the 12 months period Sept. 89 - Sept. 90, the EPZ sector lost some 1,400 workers mainly resulting from contraction in the activities of the Pullover Sector (-2,400) and the Jewellery Sector (-300). The 'Other Garments' Sector has on the other hand registered increases of around 700 workers.

Sectors which have been steadily expanding are: 'Food manufacturing', which consists mainly of tuna production, 'Flowers' and 'Electric & Other Electronic Products' (Tables 7 & 8 refer). Employment evolution in these sectors clearly indicate a sign of diversification although there is still a strong reliance on the textile sector which employs nearly 90% or 79,000 of the workforce.

#### 4. EXPORTS & IMPORTS

It is estimated that EPZ exports during the 3rd quarter amounted to Rs 3,000 million bringing total exports for the first nine months of 1990 to Rs 8,300 million compared to Rs 6,800 million last year. On this trend, the total for the year will exceed Rs 11,000 million. Imports are estimated to reach around Rs 8,600 million resulting in net export earnings of Rs 2,400 million representing 22% of exports compared to 17% last year.
