<u> International Travel and Tourism - 1st Quarter 1993</u>

Passenger traffic

During the first quarter of 1993, some 117,500 arrivals and 131,200 departures were recorded in the Island of Mauritius, yielding a total volume of passenger traffic of 248,700 handled at the airport.

Compared to the corresponding period in 1992, the figures showed an increase of about 8% in arrivals, 9 % in departures and about 9% in the overall volume of passenger traffic.

Tourist arrivals

Some 86,500 tourists visited the country during the first quarter, representing an increase of 9% over the corresponding quarter of 1992.

More than a quarter (27%) of the tourists came from Reunion Island which remains the most important shorthaul market for Mauritius. The traditional European markets contributed 45% (38,500). Another 12% (10,500) tourists came from the Republic of South Africa, our major medium-haul market. Of the remaining, 1,800 came from the Malagasy Republic, 1,100 from Australia and an equal number from India, and 800 from Japan.

Nearly half of the European tourists (19,500) came from France, 7,400 (19%) from Germany, 5,000 (13%) from United Kingdom and the remaining 18% mainly from Italy, Switzerland and Belgium.

Tourist nights

The number of tourist nights spent during the first quarter of 1993 is estimated to be around 1,038,000, that is an increase of 7% over the figure for the same period last year.

Occupancy rates

At the end of the period under review there were 84 hotels licensed in the Island of Mauritius with a total room capacity of 5,271 and 10,917 bedplaces. The number of hotel rooms available for tourists has thus increased by 125 over the first quarter of 1992, with a corresponding increase of 271 in number of bedplaces.

The overall room occupancy rate for the first three months of 1993 was 55.3%, an improvement over the figure of 52.0% registered for the corresponding period of last year. Similarly, the bed occupancy rate rose from 46.0% to 49.3%.

Tourist receipts

Gross tourist receipts for the period is estimated at around 1,320 million rupees, that is an increase of some 5% over the figures for the first quarter of last year.

Forecasts for 1993

It is estimated that 360,000 tourists will visit the country during the year 1993 and total receipts from tourism will amount to 5,200 million rupees.

Employment

It is estimated that in March 1993 about 11,660 persons were employed in tourism establishments engaging 10 persons or more. This represents an increase of 4% over the corresponding figure for March 1992. Of these persons, 68% were employed in hotels, 26% in travel and tourism establishments and the remaining 6% in restaurants.
