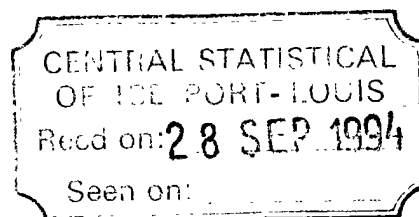

EXTERNAL TRADE

2nd QUARTER 1994

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

During the second quarter of 1994, total international trade for the Country was valued at around Rs 13,400 million, almost the same level as that of the corresponding quarter of 1993 but 11 percent above that of the previous quarter.

With exports worth of Rs 5,650 million and imports, Rs 7,700 million, the balance of visible trade for the second quarter of 1994 registered a deficit of nearly Rs 2,100 million compared to Rs 2,300 million in the corresponding quarter of 1993 and Rs 2,000 million in the previous quarter.

Total exports for the first six months of the year 1994 therefore amounted to Rs 10,700 million and imports, Rs 14,700 million leaving a deficit of Rs 4,000 million .

On this trend, total exports for the year 1994 are expected to attain Rs 26,700 million and imports, Rs 35,700 million. It is worth pointing out that the net result would be a relatively larger deficit of around Rs 9,000 million as import figures include an aircraft worth some Rs 2,000 million. However, exclusive of this irregular item ,the 1994 trade deficit would be around Rs 7,000 million about the same level as that of 1993 (Rs 6,800 million).

2. Terms of trade (Base year 1992 = 100)

During the second quarter the terms of trade index (which shows price movements of exports relative to imports), improved by 7 percentage points from 92 in the first quarter of 1994 to 99. This favourable movement was the result of an 8 percent increase in export prices whilst import prices remained at the same level.

However, price movements during the first semester of 1994 relative to the corresponding period of 1993 show that import prices were rising at a higher rate of 8 percent while export prices lagged behind at 5 per cent only. Details on price changes in imported goods (Table 3b) show increases ranging between 3 and 30 percent in all product groups with the exception of fuel which registered a drop of 10 percent.

3. Exports

Total export proceeds for the second quarter of the year 1994, stood at Rs 5,650 million about 4 percent above the 1993 corresponding period level of Rs 5,400 million .

Cummulative exports for the first six months of 1994 therefore totalled Rs 10,700 million, some 7 percent above last year's corresponding figure of Rs 10,000 million. After allowing for price increases of around 5 percent, exports grew in real terms by 2 percent. EPZ exports fetched Rs 7,400 million compared to Rs 7,000 million a year ago. Sugar maintained more or less the same level at Rs 2,046 million compared to Rs 2,086 million for the previous year.

The table below summarises the main changes in exports between the first semester 1993 and 1994 .

During the first semester, the Country's main buyers remained the European Economic Community (EEC) which purchased 69 percent of our exports. The US market maintained its share of 18 percent of the total.

4. Imports

The import bill for the second quarter of 1994 remained at 1993 level and amounted to Rs 7,700 million. But, on a six monthly basis, the total imports for January-June 1994 (Rs 14,700 million) represents a 5 percent nominal increase over 1993 corresponding figure, explained by an 8 percent increase in price but a contraction in volume by around 3 percent. Increases in the volume of food (+7%), fuel (+4%) and manufactured goods (+3%) were offset by decreases in that of chemicals (-8%) and machinery (-20%).

The table below gives comparative import figures for the first semester of 1993 and 1994.

As shown in the above table with the exception of fuel, down 6 percent and machinery and equipment down 12 percent, all product groups have recorded increases ranging from 7 percent to 16 percent. EPZ companies purchase of raw materials was up by 11 percent whilst that of machinery and equipment fell by 16%.

Table 8 on imports by country of origin shows that during the first semester of 1994, the country's main source of imports remained the EEC which accounted for 32 per cent of the total with France obtaining 38 percent of the European share. On an individual country basis, the Republic of South Africa remained the main supplier accounting for 15 percent, followed by India, 7%, Hong Kong and Japan, 5%, each.

5. The EPZ Sector

During the second quarter of 1994, the EPZ enterprises exported Rs 4,200 million worth of goods yielding a total for the first semester of around Rs 7,400 million. This figure represents a nominal increase of 5 percent over last year's achievement (Rs 7,000 million) resulting from the effects of higher prices and a slight decrease in the volume of exports.

From January-June 1994, EPZ companies imported Rs 4,800 million compared to Rs 4,500 million in the same period last year. Purchases of raw materials were up by Rs 400 million to Rs 4,400 million (+11%) whilst machinery and equipment fell by Rs 100 million to Rs 450 million.

Consequently, net EPZ exports for the first six months of the year yielded Rs 2,500 million, the same level as that of the corresponding period last year but its ratio to exports fell slightly to 34% from 36% .

On the basis of EPZ exports performance during the first six months of the year, the total for the year is estimated at Rs 18,000 million against Rs 15,800 million last year.
