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

Introduction

This issue of the "Economic Indicators" presents the results of the "Quarterly Survey of Employment" carried out at the end of June 1994. Provisional figures on EPZ Exports and Imports are also included.

Employment evolution, 2nd quarter 1994

At the end of June 1994, employment in the EPZ remained at the previous quarter's level of around 83,900 with practically no change in the sex composition as well, that is, 59,600 females (71%) and 24,250 males (29%). This occurred in a situation where the number of enterprises decreased by 11 from 520 in the 1st quarter as a result of 19 closures and the coming into operation of 8 new enterprises. Total employment lost, 4,800 of which 2,100 due to closures, was almost entirely absorbed by expansion in the workforce of around 30 existing enterprises.

At the end of the 2nd quarter 1994, the number of foreign workers stood at 5,076: an increase of nearly 600 over the 1st quarter.

Employment evolution, June 93 - June 94

Over the 12-month period ending June 1994, the EPZ sector registered a net decrease of 41 enterprises and employment dropped by around 2,200. The "Wearing apparel" group suffered a loss of 2,800 in its workforce whilst there was an aggregate increase of nearly 600 in the other groups. Within "Wearing apparel", a total loss of 3,600 in "Pullovers" was partly offset by an increase of around 800 in "Other garments".

EPZ exports and imports

Exports in the EPZ during the 2nd quarter amounted to nearly Rs 4,200 million, almost the same level as that reported during the corresponding period last year. For the first semester, the figure works out to Rs 7,360 million

compared to Rs 6,995 million, that is, an increase of 5% or Rs 365 million of which Rs 164 million towards the U.S.A.

EPZ enterprises imported for Rs 2,546 million worth of goods during the 2nd quarter yielding a total of Rs 4,840 million for the 1st semester against Rs 4,495 million in the corresponding period last year. Imports of raw materials went up by nearly 11% to reach Rs 4,384 million whilst machinery and other equipment dropped to Rs 456 million from Rs 543 million.

Net exports yielded a little over Rs 2,520 million during the 1st semester representing 34% of total exports as against 36% last year.

On this trend, total EPZ exports would probably reach Rs 18,000 million this year compared to Rs 15,821 million in 1993.
