EDUCATION STATISTICS 1995

Introduction

The Education statistics gathered in this report are obtained from the Annual Survey conducted in schools and supplemented by data from other sources.

1. BUDGET

Out of the government estimated recurrent expenditure of Rs 15,900 million for the financial year 1995-96, the share of the Ministry of Education, Science and Technology was Rs 2,262 million (or 14.2%) compared to Rs 2063 million (or 14.4%) for 1994-95. Of this budget, 43% was allocated to the secondary sector, 34.8% to primary, 10.5% to Post Secondary, 1.2 to Technical/Vocational, 0.3% to Pre-primary and the remaining 10.2% to other expenses (refer table 1).

2. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

2.1 Schools

It is estimated that there are about 1,000 pre-primary schools of which 817 schools (783 in the Island of Mauritius and 34 in the Island of Rodrigues) were registered with the Ministry of Education. Facilities to open pre-primary classes in primary schools are gradually being provided in all primary schools, with priority being given to low performing schools also known as schools in the Zone d'Education Prioritaire (ZEP). From the survey carried out in 1995 in schools, it was found that 110 pre-schools were operational in primary schools while the rest were privately run institutions

2.2 Enrolment

The total enrolment figure as per the 1995 survey was 31,542 (16,005 boys and 15,537 girls) in the pre-primary schools. This figure includes the enrolment for Rodrigues that consisted of 484 boys and 476 girls.

2.3 Personnel

The pre-schools were staffed by 2,240 persons, with the breakdown being 1,722 as teaching staff and the remaining 518 as non-teaching staff.

3. PRIMARY EDUCATION

3.1 Schools

Out of a total of 279 primary schools (267 in the Island of Mauritius and 12 in Rodrigues), 220 were administered by government, 51 by the Roman Catholic Education Authority (RCEA), 2 by the Hindu Education Authority and the remaining 6 were private unaided schools.

3.2 Enrolment

In 1995 the number of children enrolled in primary schools totalled 122,895 (62,300 boys and 60,595 girls). The percentage distribution showed that 51% were boys and 49% girls. Seventy six per cent of the pupils were in Government schools while the remaining 24% were enrolled in aided and non-aided schools (refer table 5). The highest number (25,918) was found in standard VI because of repeaters, trying to obtain better results and hoping therefore to increase their chances for access to secondary schools of their choice. However, the number of repeaters was on the decline: 6,933 in 1995 as against 8,087 in 1994. Pupils enrolled in 1995 for any one of the 7 Asian languages numbered 79,670 representing 68% of total enrolment in the Island of Mauritius.

3.3 Personnel

Employment in the Primary Education Sector numbered 8,292 of whom 5,137 (2,582 male, 2,555 female) were teaching staff (excluding Deputy Head Teachers). The remaining comprised 271 Head Teachers, 973 Deputy Head Teachers and 1,911 administrative staff and manual workers. The number of pupils per teacher was 33 as against 32 in 1994.

3.4 Certificate of Primary Education (CPE) Examination

School candidates who took part in the CPE Examination in November 1995 came up to a total figure of 27,733 (14,222 boys and 13,511 girls). Of these, 18,121 pupils (8,791 boys and 9,330 girls) passed the examination. The pass rate was 65.3% in 1995 against 61.2% in 1994. (See table 9)

4. SECONDARY EDUCATION

4.1 Schools

Out of 123 secondary schools (120 in the Island of Mauritius and 3 in Rodrigues), 23 were state and the remaining 100 were confessional and private schools.

4.2 Enrolment

The secondary school population numbered 91,104 with 44,270 boys and 46,834 girls. The comparative table (table 13) reflects an overall increase of 2% in enrolment. Twenty five per cent of the pupils were enrolled in state schools while the remaining were in private ones. The percentage distribution by gender remained the same as the previous year's, that is 51% for girls against 49% for boys.

4.3 Personnel

The number of persons employed in the secondary sector totalled 6,638 comprising 4,375 (or 66%) teaching staff and 2,263 (or 34%) administrative and other non-teaching staff. The state schools employed 25% of the teachers. The pupil/teacher ratio was same as for the year before, that is 21.

4.4 School Certificate and Higher School Certificate Examinations

In November 1995, 12,089 candidates (5,683 boys and 6,406 girls) were examined for the School Certificate Examination. Of these, 8,494 (70.3%) were successful. Comparing the performance with that of 1994, (table 16) a significant improvement of 4% is observed.

At the Higher School Certificate Examination, the pass rate went up to 66.3% (as against 63.3% for 1994) for a total number of 5,319 candidates (2,554 boys and 2,765 girls).

5. TERTIARY EDUCATION

5.1 University of Mauritius (UOM)

5.1.1 Enrolment

The University of Mauritius offers a variety of courses ranging from certificate level to higher degree. Some external award courses are also offered. The comparative figures (table 18) of 94/95 and 95/96 reflect an overall increase of 7% in enrolment at all levels and for all the five faculties.

Of a total enrolment of 2,344 students, 1,587 are engaged in full time academic pursuits and 757 attend courses on a part-time basis. While a significant decrease is observed for non-degree courses, the enrolment (1,188) for degree courses has gone up. This is in keeping with the policy to gradually phase out the certificate courses and develop the University primarily into a degree awarding institution.

5.1.2 Output

For the academic year 1993/94, the number of students who graduated from the University of Mauritius was 705, consisting of 431 male and 274 female students. There has been a perceptible increase in the number of passes (365) at diploma and (236) at degree level respectively.

5.2 Mauritius Institute of Education (MIE)

5.2.1 Enrolment

The Mauritius Institute of Education offers a series of different courses ranging from the Post Graduate Certificate in Education to the Teacher's Certificate. The clientele consists basically of those engaged (or are to be engaged) in teaching and educational administration.

Enrolment at all levels totalled 3,171 (1,585 male and 1,586 female students). The majority (2,554) of the students were following courses on a part time basis while 617 trainee teachers for the primary sector were on a full-time basis.

5.3 Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI)

5.3.1 Enrolment

The Mahatma Gandhi Institute which also comprises a secondary school with 971 students offers courses in 3 broad areas: the Performing Arts, Fine Arts and Indian Languages. These are classified under Certificate, Diploma and Joint Honours Degree. For 94/95, 417 were enrolled for the Performing Arts and 36 for the Fine Arts. As for the Indian Languages there was a total enrolment of 302 including 28 who followed full time Joint Honours Degree (with part attendance at the University of Mauritius). The highest enrolment figure was registered for the part-time Certificate in Indian Music and Dance (372) followed by the 3- year part- time Diploma in Indian Languages (109).
