

EDUCATION STATISTICS 1998

INTRODUCTION

This publication consists of data collected from the annual survey conducted in schools in 1998 as well as data from other sources for the Republic of Mauritius. The data presented relate to school infrastructure, enrolment, personnel and examination results.

1. EXPENDITURE

Government recurrent expenditure on education was estimated around Rs 3,284 million for the financial year 1998/99 as compared to Rs 3,137 million for the year 1997/98. This represents 15% of the total government recurrent budget of Rs 22,300 million for 1998/99.

The budget allocated to the Ministry of Education was Rs 3,102 million. Of this, 39.1% was distributed to the secondary education sector, 34% to primary, 12.4% to post-secondary, 2% to technical and vocational, 1.7% to pre-primary and the remaining 10.8% to other expenses (Table 1).

2. PRE-PRIMARY EDUCATION

2.1 *Schools*

In April 1998 a survey was conducted in 1,132 pre-primary schools, 1,099 in the Island of Mauritius and 33 in Rodrigues. Of these schools, 79% were privately run institutions, 16% were administered by the Parent Teacher Associations (PTA) and the other 5% by the Municipal and Village Councils (Table 2).

2.2 *Enrolment*

The population aged 3 years and over enrolled in these pre-primary schools numbered 42,279 (21,256 boys and 21,023 girls). The Gross Enrolment Ratio, that is the proportion of children in the respective age-group admitted in pre-schools increased from 96% in 1997 to 98% in 1998. This is mainly due to facilities being provided to pre-primary schools in terms of infrastructure and grants.

2.3 *Personnel*

The pre-schools were staffed by 3,240 persons: 2,551 teaching staff and 689 non-teaching staff (Table 3). Most of the teachers were female. The pupil / teacher ratio works out to 17.

3 PRIMARY EDUCATION

3.1 *Schools*

In 1998, there were 285 primary schools, 272 in the Island of Mauritius and 13 in Rodrigues. The majority of the schools (222) were run by government, 51 by the Roman Catholic Education Authority (RCEA), 2 by the Hindu Education Authority and the other 10 were private unaided schools (Table 4).

3.2 *Enrolment*

The primary school population in the Republic of Mauritius increased by 3%, from 127,109 in 1997 to 130,505 in 1998. Of this figure, 51% were boys and 49% girls. The government schools enrolled 76% of the overall primary school population while the aided and unaided schools had the other 24%.

The gradewise distribution (Table 5) shows the highest enrolment in grade VI with 23,453 pupils. This included 4,735 repeaters who were trying to improve their results. It is however to be noted that the number of repeaters in grade VI has again declined, this time from 5,161 in 1997 to 4,735 in 1998. The proportion of children attending primary schools compared to the total population aged (6 – 11) years was 105%.

Seven Asian languages are taught to primary school children in Mauritius. The number of pupils studying anyone of these languages totalled 84,107 or 67% of the total primary school population in the Island of Mauritius.

3.2 *Personnel*

The primary schools employed 8,182 persons (4,740 being male and 3,442 female). Of this number 5,065 were teaching staff (3,632 General Purpose Teachers and 1,433 Asian Language Teachers). The remaining 3,117 comprised 277 Head Teachers, 1,002 Deputy Head Teachers and 1,838 other administrative and manual workers (Table 7). The number of pupils per teacher increased to 36 against 34 in 1997.

3.3 *Certificate of Primary Education (CPE)*

Out of 24,804 school candidates examined at the CPE in November 1998, 16,622 or 67% were successful. The overall pass rate improved by 2% compared to that of 1997 (65%). This year again the overall performance of girls was better than that of the boys, which was 72% for girls and 62% for boys (Refer Table 9).

4. SECONDARY EDUCATION

4.1 General

4.1.1 Schools

In 1998, secondary education was dispensed in 133 schools, 130 in the Island of Mauritius and 3 in Rodrigues. Thirty one of these schools were administered by government, 102 were confessional, private aided and non-aided schools (Table 10).

4.1.2 Enrolment

During the reference year, the secondary schools have admitted 94,364 pupils, of whom 45,982 were boys and 48,382 girls. The percentage distribution by gender remained the same as the previous year with 51% for girls and 49% for boys. The state schools catered for 25% of secondary school population while the rest (75%) was taken by the confessional and private schools (Tables 11 & 12). The proportion of children enrolled in the secondary schools compared to the population aged (12 - 19) years works out to 56% against 55% in 1997.

4.1.3 Personnel

Employment in secondary education sector totalled 7,359 (4,203 male and 3,156 female staff). Of these, 4,820 were teaching staff, 207 were at senior management level, 751 other administrative staff and the remaining 1,581 were manual workers (Table 13 & 14).

The number of teachers working in state schools represented 28% of the overall teaching force. The number of pupils per teacher in secondary schools remained 20, same as last year.

4.2 Technical and Vocational Education

4.2.1 Schools

In 1998, 34 schools (32 in the Island of Mauritius and 2 in Rodrigues), offered technical and vocational education to pupils not attending the general secondary schools. Of these schools 20 were state schools and the other 14 were confessional or private schools.

4.2.2 Enrolment

The number of students attending the technical and vocational schools numbered 4,641 (3,261 boys and 1,380 girls). Seventy percent of the pupils enrolled were in state schools (Refer Table 15).

4.2.3 Personnel

The technical and vocational schools had a teaching force of 270, of whom 143 were male and 127 female teachers. The pupil / teacher ratio works out to 17 .

5. POST SECONDARY

5.1 University of Mauritius

5.1.1 Enrolment

The University of Mauritius offers a variety of courses ranging from Certificate Level to Higher Degree with more emphasis being put on Degree and Higher Degree courses. For the academic year 1998/99, the number of students (3,718) attending the University of Mauritius increased by 19% in comparison with the year 1997/98. Of that number, 2,050 were male and 1,668 female students (Table 16).

Seventy-three percent of students were attending courses on a full-time basis. As more emphasis is being put on degree and higher degree courses, it is noted that 67% were admitted for the degree course, 25% for diploma and diploma/degree, 6% for higher degree and 2% for the Certificate course. Genderwise distribution showed that the male students represented 55% of the total students.

5.1.2 Output

For the academic year 1997/98, 896 students (474 male and 422 female students) graduated from the University of Mauritius. The highest number of graduates (405) was from the degree course , followed by (403) for the diploma , (60) higher degree and (28) certificate .

5.2 Mauritius Institute of Education (MIE)

5.2.1 Enrolment

The MIE offers courses, ranging from Teacher's Certificate to Post Graduate Certificate in Education, for those engaged (or to be engaged) in teaching and educational administration.

For the reference year, the students' population at all levels totalled 2,434 of whom 1,149 were male and 1,285 female students. Those engaged in part-time academic pursuits numbered 2,124 while the other 310 trainee primary teachers were on a full-time basis (Table 19).

5.3 Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI)

5.3.1 Enrolment

The MGI, which also comprises a secondary school with 799 students, offers courses in the following broad areas: the Performing Arts, Fine Arts and Indian Languages. These are at diploma and degree level. The total number of students attending one of those courses was 277, of whom 45% was enrolled for the degree course, 55% for the diploma and diploma/degree (Table 20).

5.4 Polytechnics

5.4.1 Enrolment

Higher technical education was further dispensed in the three polytechnics namely Lycee Polytechnique Sir Guy Forget, Droopnath Ramphul Polytechnic and the Institut Polytechnique de Rose Hill. The courses offered are mainly related to Automechanics, Electro Technique, Business Studies, Information Technology and Civil and Mechanical Engineering. The student population in all the three polytechnical institutions numbered 720, made up of 583 male and 137 female students (Refer Table 21).
