# EDUCATION STATISTICS 1999

## Introduction

This publication consists of data collected from the annual survey conducted in schools in 1999 as well as data from other sources for the Republic of Mauritius. The data presented relate to school infrastructure, enrolment and personnel.

### 1. Expenditure

Public recurrent expenditure on education was estimated around 3,669 million rupees for the financial year 1999/2000 as compared to 3,432 million rupees for the year 1998/99. This represents 14% of the government's total recurrent budget of 25,700 million rupees for 1999/2000.

The Ministry of Education and Scientific Research was allocated 3,537 million rupees from the government's budget for the current financial year. The distribution of the Ministry of Education's recurrent budget for 1999/2000 was as follows: secondary education sector, 38%; primary, 35%; post-secondary, 13%; technical and vocational, 2%; pre-primary, 2%; and the remaining 10% to other expenses (Table 1).

### 2. Pre-primary Education

#### 2.1 *Schools*

In April 1999 a survey was conducted in 1,153 pre-primary schools: 1,120 in the Island of Mauritius and 33 in Rodrigues. Of these schools, 80% were privately run institutions, 15% were schools found on primary school premises and administered by the Parent Teacher Associations (PTA) and the other 5% by the Municipal and Village Councils (Table 2).

#### 2.2 *Enrolment*

The population aged 3 years and over enrolled in these pre-primary schools numbered 41,711 (21,023 boys and 20,688 girls). The Gross Enrolment Ratio (ie children in the pre-primary schools compared to children in the age group 4-5 years) was 99%.

### **2.3 Personnel**

The pre-schools were staffed by 3,336 persons: 2,548 teaching staff and 788 non-teaching staff (Table 3). Most of the teachers were female. The pupil / teacher ratio works out to 16.

## **3 Primary Education**

### **3.1 Schools**

In March 1999, there were 287 schools providing primary education, 274 in the Island of Mauritius and 13 in Rodrigues. The majority (223) of the schools were run by government, 51 by the Roman Catholic Education Authority (RCEA), 2 by the Hindu Education Authority and the other 11 were private unaided schools (Table 4).

### **3.2 Enrolment**

The primary school population in the Republic of Mauritius increased by 2%, from 130,505 in 1998 to 133,489 in 1999. Boys represented 51% of the total school population. Around 76% of the overall primary school population were enrolled in government schools while the remaining 24% were in aided and unaided schools.

The gradewise distribution (Table 5) shows the highest enrolment in grade VI with 25,184 pupils. This number included 5,058 repeaters who were trying to improve their results. The Gross Enrolment Ratio, which relates the total children attending primary schools to the population aged (6–11) years, works out to 105%.

The education system provides for instruction in seven Asian languages. The number of pupils studying anyone of these languages totalled 85,921 or 67% of the total primary school population in the Island of Mauritius.

### **3.3 Personnel**

The primary schools employed 8,216 persons (4,642 being male and 3,574 female). Of this number 5,107 were teaching staff: 3,692 General Purpose Teachers and 1,415 Asian Language Teachers. The remaining 3,109 comprised 272 Head Teachers, 970 Deputy Head Teachers and 1,867 other administrative and manual workers (Table 7). The overall teacher/pupil ratio works out to 36, same as the previous year.

## **4. Secondary Education**

### **4.1 General**

#### **4.1.1 Schools**

As at March 1999, secondary education was dispensed in 135 schools, 132 in the Island of Mauritius and 3 in Rodrigues. Thirty-one of these schools were state administered while the other 104 were confessional, private aided and non-aided schools (Table 8).

#### **4.1.2 Enrolment**

During the reference year, the secondary schools enrolled 95,187 pupils, of whom 46,253 were boys and 48,934 girls. The percentage distribution by gender remained the same as the previous year with 51% for girls and 49% for boys. The state schools catered for 25% of secondary school population while the confessional and private schools had the rest (75%). The Gross Enrolment Ratio (ie children attending secondary schools compared to the population aged 12 – 19) years, works out to 58% against 56% in 1998.

#### **4.1.3 Personnel**

The secondary education sector employed 7,657 persons (4,325 male and 3,332 female staff). Of these, 5,014 were teaching staff (2,649 male and 2,365 female). The remaining staff consisted of 222 at senior management level, 768 administrative and 1,653 manual (Table 11 & 12). The number of pupils per teacher in secondary schools was 19.

## **4.2 Technical and Vocational Education**

### **4.2.1 Schools**

In March 1999, 30 schools (29 in the Island of Mauritius and 1 in Rodrigues), offered technical and vocational education to pupils not attending the general secondary schools. Sixteen of these schools were state schools while the other 14 were confessional or private schools.

### **4.2.2 Enrolment**

There were 4,489 pupils attending the technical and vocational schools. This number comprised 3,149 boys and 1,340 girls (Refer Table 13). Seventy five percent of the pupils were enrolled in state schools.

### **4.2.3 Personnel**

The technical and vocational schools had a teaching force of 305, of whom 157 were male and 148 female teachers. The number of pupils per teacher averages 15.

## **5. Post Secondary**

### **5.1 University of Mauritius**

#### **5.1.1 Enrolment**

The University of Mauritius offers a variety of courses ranging from Certificate Level to Higher Degree with more emphasis being put on Degree and Higher Degree courses. For the academic year 1999/2000, the number of students (4,266) attending the University of Mauritius increased by 15% in comparison with the year 1998/99. Male students represented 55% of the overall student population (Table 14).

Seventy-five percent of students were attending courses on a full-time basis. As more emphasis is being put on degree and higher degree courses, it is noted that the highest number of students (77%) was admitted for the degree course compared to 13% for diploma/degree and diploma, 7% for master and higher degree and 3% for the Certificate course.

#### **5.1.2 Output**

For the academic year 1998/99, 802 students (400 male and 402 female students) graduated from the University of Mauritius. The highest number of graduates (459) was from the degree course, followed by 286 for the diploma, 16 for higher degree and 41 for certificate.

### **5.2 Mauritius Institute of Education (MIE)**

#### **5.2.1 Enrolment**

The MIE offers courses, ranging from Teacher's Certificate to Post Graduate Certificate in Education, for those engaged (or to be engaged) in teaching and educational administration.

For the reference year, the students' population for all levels totalled 2,309 of whom 1,193 were male and 1,116 female students. Those engaged in part-time academic pursuits numbered 2,009 while the other 300 trainee primary teachers were on a full-time basis (Table 16).

### **5.3 Mahatma Gandhi Institute (MGI)**

#### **5.3.1 Enrolment**

The MGI, which also comprises a secondary school with 821 students, offers courses in the following broad areas: the Performing Arts, Fine Arts and Indian Languages. These were at diploma and degree level. Students attending one of those courses numbered 436; of whom 68% were enrolled for the degree course (run jointly with the University of Mauritius) and 32% for the diploma/degree and diploma (Table 17).

### **5.4 Mauritius College of the Air (MCA)**

#### **5.4.1 Enrolment**

The main activity of the Mauritius College of the Air is the production of educational programme for the formal education at primary, secondary and tertiary level for broadcast. It also provides educational materials for the non-formal education. Another important activity of the MCA is the provision for distance education. The courses offered for distance education range from diploma to certificate level. In 1999, students enrolled numbered 575: 286 male and 289 female.

### **5.5 Polytechnics**

#### **5.5.1 Enrolment**

Higher technical education was further dispensed in the three polytechnics namely Lycee Polytechnique Sir Guy Forget, Droopnath Ramphul Polytechnic and the Institut Polytechnique de Rose Hill. The courses offered are mainly related to Automechanics, Electro Technique, Business Studies, Information Technology and Civil and Mechanical Engineering. The three polytechnics had a student population of 917, made up of 689 male and 228 female students (Refer Table 18).
