

Business Activity Statistics, July 1999 to June 2000

Introduction

Business Activity Statistics are compiled mainly from the administrative records of the local authorities and government departments responsible for the delivery of licence permits and registration certificates. Only licensed and registered activities are therefore covered. All illegal activities as well as those the conduct of which do not require any licensing or registration are excluded. Currently, all agricultural related activities are also not covered.

It must also be pointed out that the statistics on business activity refer to the total number of licensed or registered activities and not to the total number of operation units or establishments. For example, a general retailer holding three licences: one for trading in foodstuffs, a second for tobacco and a third for liquor will be assigned three activities.

2. Concepts

An operator is required to obtain a licence from the Municipal or District Councils for each type of activity carried out at any location within their respective boundaries. In some cases, an operator with a valid licence may also be registered with a particular Ministry or organisation. To avoid double counting, such activities have been accounted for in registrations only. Tables 1 and 2 present licence statistics as compiled from information obtained from the local authorities, adjusted licences and registration figures are given in tables 4 to 5.7.

3. Data sources

Data for the compilation of business activity statistics are obtained from the following:

- Licences:** - Municipalities and District Councils
- Registrations:** - Ministry of Commerce and Industry - (EPZ, ESZ & Pioneer)
- National Transport Authority - Public transport
- Ministry of Education - Private pre-primary and other schools
- Ministry of Social Security – National Pension Fund's register of employers
- Medical/Bar Council – Medical practitioners and lawyers
- Mauritius Freeport Authority
- Mauritius Offshore Business Activities Authority
- The Commissioner of Police – Driving schools

4. Classification and presentation of data

To cater for the wide range and diverse business activities and for classification purposes, each activity has been assigned an activity code according to the National Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities, NSIC, which is an adapted version of the International Standard Industrial Classification (ISIC), Rev. 3, 1990. Details on level of classification are given at Annex.

Tables 1 to 5.1 present data by main section headings. Detailed data by activity level (2-5 digit level) are given in Tables 5.2 to 5.7. Time series data for the last five years are given in tables 6 and 7.

5. Analysis of data

5.1 Licence issues and cessations as at June, 2000

Between July 1999 and June 2000, a total of 4,398 new licences were issued as follows: 'Wholesale & Retail Trade', 2,829; 'Other community, social & personal services', 327; 'Transport, storage & communications', 321; 'Hotels & restaurants', 331; and 'Manufacturing', 233. During the same period, 1,549 licences were cancelled, so the net increase works out to 2,849. The total number of licences as at June 2000 therefore stood at 62,891 which compared to (60,042) as at June 1999 represents an increase of 4.7% (Table 1).

5.2 Licences and registrations as at June, 2000

The number of licensed and registered business activities as at June 2000 totalled 79,128 which, compared to 75,842 at the end of June 1999, shows a net addition of 3,286 or 4.3%.

5.3 Licences and registrations by industrial activity

'Wholesale and retail trade' with 42,000 activities representing 53.1% of the total, constituted the largest percentage of activities, followed by 'Transport, storage & communications', 14,448 or 18.3%. The activities in the other groups were: 'Hotels and restaurants', 6,689 or 8.4%; 'Manufacturing', 4,839 or 6.1%; 'Real estate, renting and business activities', 3,465 or 4.4% and 'Other community, social & personal service activities', 2,550 or 3.2%.

The highest increase over the previous year is noted in the construction activity, which was up by 15.1%, and in 'Other community, social and personal services', 11.9%, whereas registration in private education went down by 7.1%. More details are given in Table 4.

5.3 Distribution by rural and urban region

Activities within the Municipal and District Council areas grouped into rural & urban region is given in Table 5.1

Of the 79,128 licence and registered activities, there were 40,539 or 51.2% in the rural areas against 38,589 in the urban ones. Analysis of the data at activity (Section) level shows the predominance of mining and quarrying and hotels & restaurants activities in the rural areas because such activities are mainly carried out in the coastal regions. Transport and some other social & personal services associated with tourist activities followed the same pattern.

Annex**National Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities (NSIC)****Structure of the NSIC:**

The National Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities, NSIC, is an adapted version of the International Standard Classification (ISIC) Revision 3, 1990. The ISIC of all economic activities is a classification of productive economic activities according to kind of economic activity on basis of the principal category of goods produced or services rendered.

Structure and coding system of the NSIC:-

The NSIC consists of 5 levels of classification namely:

- Level 1: **Section** (17 Sections) identified by one of the letters A to Q
- Level 2: **Division** (56 divisions) identified by the first 2 digits
- Level 3: **Group** (151 groups) identified by the first 3 digits
- Level 4: **Classes** (302 classes) identified by the first 4 digits
- Level 5: **Sub class** (546 sub classes) identified by the 5 digits

An example of the NSIC code for the “Manufacture of bread” is given below:

The code for Manufacture of Bread is 15411 where,

- First 2 digits - 15 Indicate the Division - Manufacture of food products and beverages.
- First 3 digits - 154 - Indicate the Group - Manufacture of other food products.
- First 4 digits - 1541 - Indicate the Class - Manufacture of bakery products.
- The 5 digits - 15411 - Indicate the Sub-class - Manufacture of bread.
