The Export Processing Zone and Pioneer Status Enterprises

1st Quarter 2001

Introduction

This issue of the "Economic and Social Indicators" presents the findings of the Quarterly Survey of Employment carried out at the end of March 2001. Figures are given separately for the Export Processing Zone and Pioneer Status Enterprises. The latter are "small and medium" enterprises engaged mainly in activities involving the application of high technology.

Provisional figures on EPZ imports and exports for the first quarter 2001 as well as revised figures for the previous years are also given.

2. The Export Processing Zone (EPZ)

2.1 Number of enterprises

During the 1st quarter, 5 enterprises closed down and 14 new ones started operation, bringing the total number of EPZ enterprises at the end of the quarter to 527. The number of enterprises with fewer than 10 workers numbered 123 and represented nearly 23% of the total number of enterprises and less than 2% of the workforce.

The number of enterprises in "Wearing apparel", the most important group in the EPZ, stood at 251 compared to 248 at the end of December 2000 and 254 at the end of March 2000. The "Flowers" group was operating with 39 enterprises at the end of March 2001. Other details by product group are given in Table 1.2.

2.2 Employment evolution, 1st quarter 2001

At the end of March 2001, employment in the EPZ stood at 93,218, a growth of 2,536 compared to the previous quarter. The number of female employees grew by 1,450, from 60,985 to 62,435 whilst male employment increased by 1,086, from 29,697 to 30,783. The ratio of male to female employment in the EPZ workforce remains at approximately 1 to 2.

During the 1st quarter of 2001, a total of 4,296 jobs were created, of which 3,805 through expansion in 30 existing enterprises. The number of jobs created by the 14 new enterprises was 491. On the other hand, 1,760 jobs were lost: 1,644 through reduction in 16 existing enterprises and 116 following the closure of 5 enterprises (Table 1.5).

Employment in the "Wearing apparel" product group increased by 2,039 during the first quarter, bringing the number of employees to 77,666. Within the group, employment in "Other garments" increased by 1,731 and in "Pullovers" by 308. Details of other changes in employment by product group are shown in Table 1.7.

Foreign workers, who numbered 15,052 at the beginning of the quarter, rose by 508 to reach 15,560 at the end of March 2001. Female employment rose by 82 while among males, there was an increase of 426. Table 1.8 shows expatriate employment by product group and sex. It will be noted that the majority of foreign workers in the EPZ are employed in the "Wearing apparel" sector.

2.3 Employment evolution, March 2000 - March 2001

Comparison of March 2000 and March 2001 figures shows a net gain of 10 in the number of EPZ enterprises and an increase of 2,357 in the workforce.

In the group "Wearing apparel", employment increased by 1,486, from 76,180 to 77,666. Within this group, employment in "Other garments" rose by 1,646 while a decline of 160 was registered in "Pullovers".

2.4 Imports and exports

Provisional figures show that EPZ exports during the 1st quarter of 2001 amounted to Rs. 7,354 million, against Rs 8,799 million for the previous quarter.

Imports for the 1st quarter fell by 3% to reach Rs 3,844 million compared to Rs 3,943 million for the 4th quarter of 2000. This was mainly due to a fall of 43% in the bill of machinery and equipment while imports of raw materials remained more or less at the same level.

Net exports, i.e., exports minus imports, amounted to Rs. 3,510 million, which is 48% of total exports (Table 1.9).

Exports of manufactured articles of apparel and clothing went up from Rs. 5,205 million to Rs. 5,692 million, representing nearly 77% of EPZ exports.

The United Kingdom, France and the United States of America remained our principal EPZ markets with 69% of our total exports. An analysis by country of destination (Table 1.12) shows increases to the United States of America by 24% (from Rs. 1,943 million to Rs. 1,571 million) and France by 5% (from Rs. 1,516 million to Rs. 1,588 million).

3. The Pioneer Status Enterprises (PSE)

3.1 Number of enterprises

During the 1st quarter of 2001, 8 new enterprises started operation while 4 closed down, bringing the total number of PSE's to 240. Among these, 84 were operating with 10 or more workers. Further details are given in Table 2.1. The highest number of enterprises was in "Other support services" (49) followed by "Informatics" (42), and "Light engineering" (41).

3.2 Employment

The total workforce in the PSE sector at the end of March 2001 was 2,930 (2,179 males and 751 females), 91 more than the previous quarter (Table 2.3).

During the 1st quarter of 2001, 199 jobs were created: 38 by the 8 new enterprises and 161 following expansion in 47 existing enterprises. On the other hand, 108 jobs were lost due to reduction of 67 in existing enterprises and 41 following the closure of 4 enterprises (Table 2.4).

The number of expatriates employed as at the end of the 1st quarter 2001 stood at 137 (129 males and 8 females).
