EDUCATION STATISTICS 2001

Introduction

This issue of the 'Economic and Social Indicators' presents data collected from the annual survey conducted in schools in March 2001 together with data from other sources for the Republic of Mauritius. The data presented relate to public expenditure on education, school infrastructure, enrolment, personnel and examination results.

1. Expenditure

Government recurrent expenditure on education was estimated around Rs 4,274 million rupees for the financial year 2001/2002. This represents 15.3% of the government total recurrent expenditure of Rs 27,996 million for 2001/2002. For the financial year 2000/2001, government recurrent expenditure on education was Rs 3,907 million and government total recurrent expenditure was Rs 26,252 million.

Of the budget allocated to the Ministry of Education, 39.9% was disbursed to the secondary education sector, 31.8% to primary, 16.2% to post secondary, 1.9% to technical and vocational, 1.5% to pre-primary and the remaining 8.7% to other expenses (Table 1).

2. Pre-primary Education

2.1 Schools

In March 2001 a survey was conducted in 1,090 pre-primary schools: 1,059 in the Island of Mauritius and 31 in Rodrigues. Of these schools, 79% were privately run institutions, 17%, found on primary school premises, were administered by the Parent Teacher Associations (PTA) and the other 4% were administered by the Municipal and Village Councils (Table 2).

2.2 Enrolment

The population aged 3 years and over, enrolled in these pre-primary schools, numbered 38,340 (19,290 boys and 19,050 girls). The Gross Enrolment Ratio (children attending pre-primary schools as a percentage of the total number of children in the age group 4 to 5 years in the population) was 96% (Table 3).

2.3 Personnel

The pre-primary schools employed 3,184 persons, of whom 2,441 were teachers and 743 non-teaching staff (Table 3). Most (99.9%) of the teachers were women. The average number of pupils per teacher works out to 16.

3 Primary Education

3.1 Schools

In March 2001, there were 293 schools providing primary education, 280 in the Island of Mauritius and 13 in Rodrigues. The majority (225) of the schools were run by government, 51 by the Roman Catholic Education Authority (RCEA), 2 by the Hindu Education Authority and the other 15 were private non-aided schools (Table 4).

3.2 Enrolment

The primary school population in the Republic of Mauritius decreased slightly from 135,237 in 2000 to 134,085 in 2001. Boys represented 51% of the total school population. Around 76% of the primary school population were enrolled in government schools while the remaining 24% were in aided and non-aided schools (Tables 5 & 6).

The distribution by grade shows the highest number of pupils in grade VI with 27,316 pupils. This number included 5,791 repeaters who were trying to improve their results. The Gross Enrolment Ratio, which relates the total children attending primary schools to the population aged 6 to 11 years, works out to 104%.

The education system provides for instruction in seven Asian languages. The number of pupils studying anyone of these languages totalled 87,189 or 65% of the total primary school population in the Republic of Mauritius.

3.3 Personnel

Some 8,331 persons (4,422 male and 3,909 female) staffed the primary schools. Of this number 5,379 were teaching staff: 3,981 General Purpose Teachers and 1,398 Asian Language Teachers. The remaining 2,952 comprised 289 Head Teachers, 852 Deputy Head Teachers and 1,811 other administrative and manual workers (Table 7). The pupil/teacher ratio at the primary level works out to 34.

3.4 Certificate of Primary Education (CPE)

In 2000, the number of school candidates who took part in the CPE examination totalled 28,058 (14,444 boys and 13,614 girls). Of this number, 18,617 or 66% succeeded. Genderwise comparison shows a success rate of 72% for girls against 61% for boys (Table 8).

4. Secondary Education

4.1 General

4.1.1 Schools

As at March 2001, secondary education was dispensed in 136 schools: 132 in the Island of Mauritius and 4 in Rodrigues. Thirty-four of these schools were state administered while the other 102 were confessional, private aided and non-aided schools (Table 9).

4.1.2 Enrolment

During the reference year, enrolment in the secondary schools numbered 97,647 of whom 47,392 were boys and 50,255 girls (Table 11). The percentage distribution by gender was the same as the previous year with 51% for girls and 49% for boys. The state schools catered for 27% of secondary school population while the confessional and private schools made up for the rest (73%). The Gross Enrolment Ratio (children attending secondary schools as a percentage to the population aged 12 to 19 years) works out to 63% against 60% in 2000.

4.1.3 Personnel

The secondary education sector employed 7,976 persons (4,338 male and 3,638 female). Of these, 5,302 were teaching staff (2,692 male and 2,610 female). The remaining staff consisted of 211 at senior management level, 764 administrative and 1,699 manual workers (Table 12 & 13). The average number of pupils per teacher in secondary schools was 18.

4.1.4 Cambridge School Certificate (SC)

In 2000, out of 14,648 candidates who took part in the Cambridge School Certificate examination, 11,218 or 77% were successful. A comparison by gender showed a pass rate of 78% for girls as compared to 75% for boys. A summary of the results is given in Table 14.

4.1.5 Cambridge Higher School Certificate(HSC)

The number of students taking part in the Cambridge Higher School Certificate examination totalled 6,502 (3,152 boys and 3,350 girls). Of this number 4,703 or 72% were successful. The girls scored a pass rate of 77% as compared to 67% for boys (Table 15).

4.2 Technical and Vocational Education

4.2.1 Schools

As from this year, 41 secondary institutions are offering both academic and vocational education. Thus, in March 2001 the total number of schools offering technical and vocational education numbered 59 (56 in the Island of Mauritius and 3 in Rodrigues). Fourteen of these schools were state schools while the other 45 were confessional or private (aided and unaided) schools.

4.2.2 Enrolment

In 2001, 4,919 students were attending the technical and vocational schools. This number comprised 3,370 boys and 1,549 girls (Table 16). The state schools accounted for 53% of the total enrolment.

4.2.3 Personnel

The technical and vocational schools had a teaching force of 305, of whom 153 were male and 152 female teachers. The number of pupils per teacher averaged 16.
