The Export Processing Zone and Pioneer Status Enterprises

2nd Quarter 2002

Introduction

This issue of the "Economic and Social Indicators" presents the findings of the Quarterly Survey of Employment carried out at the end of June 2002. Figures are given separately for the Export Processing Zone and the Pioneer Status Enterprises. The latter are "small and medium" enterprises engaged mainly in activities involving the application of high technology.

Provisional figures on EPZ imports and exports for the second quarter 2002 as well as revised figures for the previous years are also given. Table 1.1 shows the main indicators for the EPZ sector for the period 1991 to 2001.

2. The Export Processing Zone (EPZ)

2.1 Number of enterprises

During the 2nd quarter 2002, 5 enterprises closed down bringing the total number of EPZ enterprises to 509 at the end of June 2002. The number of enterprises with fewer than 10 workers remained at 134 as in the previous quarter and represented 26% of the total number of enterprises but employed less than 1% of the workforce.

The number of enterprises in "Wearing apparel", the most important group in the EPZ, stood at 231 compared to 234 at the end of March 2002 and 242 a year ago. In "Textile yarn and fabrics" there were 44 enterprises whilst the "Flowers" group, the only non-manufacturing group in the EPZ, was operating with 39 enterprises at the end of June 2002. Other details on the number of enterprises by product group are given in Table 1.2.

2.2 Employment evolution, 2nd quarter 2002

At the end of June 2002, employment in the EPZ stood at 86,987 (57,812 females and 29,175 males), representing a slight increase of 122 over the previous quarter. The number of female employees rose by 284 whilst male employment fell by 162. The ratio of male to female employment in the EPZ workforce remained at approximately 1 to 2.

During the 2nd quarter of 2002, a total of 2,349 jobs were created through expansion in 22 existing enterprises. On the other hand, 2,227 jobs were lost: 1,650 through reduction in 17 existing enterprises and 577 following the closure of the 5 enterprises (Table 1.5).

An analysis of employment by product group shows increases ranging from 33 in "Wood and paper products" to 265 in the "Other" category. Decreases were noted in a few

product groups, the main ones being "Textile yarn and fabrics" (-191) and "Wearing apparel" (-49). Within the latter group, employment in "Pullovers" fell by 84 but there was an increase of 35 in "Other garments". Details of other changes in employment by product group are shown in Table 1.7.

Foreign workers, who numbered 15,761 at the beginning of the quarter, declined by 179 to 15,582 at the end of June 2002. Male employment fell by 95 and, among females, there was a decrease of 84. Table 1.8 shows expatriate employment by product group and sex. It will be noted that the majority of foreign workers in the EPZ are employed in the "Wearing apparel" sector.

2.3 Employment evolution, June 2001 - June 2002

Comparison of June 2002 figures with June 2001 shows a drop of 5,979 in total EPZ employment. Female employment went down by 4,474 and among males the decrease was 1,505. As shown in Table 1.4, during the same period the number of foreign workers also decreased by 419.

In "Wearing apparel", employment declined by 5,774 from 77,111 to 71,337. Within this group, employment in "Other garments" fell by 4,949 and that in "Pullovers" witnessed a decline of 825. Significant decreases were also registered in "Textile yarn and fabrics" (-514) and "Electric and electronic products" (-105). On the other hand, moderate increases were noted in the "Other" category (+417) and in "Jewellery and related articles" (+126). Details of changes in employment by product group are given in Table 1.7.

2.4 Imports and exports, 1st semester 2002

Provisional figures show that EPZ exports during the 2nd quarter of 2002 amounted to Rs. 8,728 million, about the same level (Rs 8,731 million) as that of the corresponding quarter of 2001. Total exports for the 1st semester attained Rs 15,663 million, that is around 3% lower than the figure of Rs 16,085 million registered in the corresponding semester of 2001.

Imports for the 1st semester 2002 totalled Rs 8,190 million against to Rs 8,545 million for the 1st semester of 2001. Imports of raw materials fell by around 3% to Rs 7,637 million whilst imports of machinery went down by 13% from Rs 633 million to Rs 553 million.

Net exports, i.e., exports minus imports, amounted to Rs. 7,473 million and its ratio to total exports works out to 48% (Table 1.9).

Exports of manufactured articles of apparel and clothing, which represent around 75% of total EPZ exports went down by Rs 709 million to Rs. 11,609 million. On the other hand, increases are noted in "Fish and fish preparations" (+ Rs. 253 million) and "Jewellery, goldsmiths and silversmiths wares" (Rs 201 million). Other details of EPZ exports by section are shown in Table 1.10.

The United Kingdom, France and the United States of America remained our principal EPZ markets with 75% of our total exports. An analysis by country of destination (Table 1.12) shows increases of 7.6% in exports to the United States of America (from Rs 4,030 million to Rs 4,335 million), and of 8% to the United Kingdom (from Rs 3,404 million to Rs 3,677 million). Exports to France remained at almost the same level (Rs 3,779 million).

It is to be noted that the above figures do not include the sales of EPZ products to Freeport operators. These goods, valued at Rs 679 million for the 1st semester 2002 and Rs 512 million for the 1st semester 2001, are only included in external trade statistics as exports of the Freeport, as and when they are exported by the Freeport licensees.

3. The Pioneer Status Enterprises (PSE)

3.1 **Number of enterprises**

During the 2nd quarter of 2002, 7 new enterprises started operation while 3 existing enterprises closed down, bringing the total number of PSE's to 252. Among these, 84 were operating with 10 or more workers. The highest number of enterprises was in "Other support services" (61) followed by "Light engineering" (41) and "Informatics" (39). Further details are given in Table 2.1

3.2 **Employment**

The total workforce in the PSE sector at the end of June 2002 was 3,236 (2,397 males and 839 females) showing an increase of 133 compared to the previous quarter (Table 2.3).

During the 2nd quarter 2002, 314 jobs were created: 60 by the 7 new enterprises and 254 following expansion in 43 existing enterprises. On the other hand, 181 jobs were lost due to reductions of 171 in 51 existing enterprises and 10 following the closure of the 3 enterprises (Table 2.4) The number of expatriates employed as at the end of the 2nd quarter 2002 stood at 199 (186 males and 13 females).
