## PRODUCER PRICE I NDEX - MANUFACTURI NG (PPI-M)

## 3rd Quarter 2002

## 1. Introduction

The Producer Price Index (PPI-M) measures changes in the effective selling prices received by producers for that part of their output, which is sold on the domestic market. It reflects the price trends of a constant basket of goods, which represents the output of the selected industries.

The Central Statistics Office first published a Producer Price Index for the Manufacturing sector in March 1994, with 1993 as reference period, but the coverage was then limited to the "Manufacture of food, beverages and tobacco". The scope of the index has now been extended to cover all relevant industry groups of the Non-EPZ manufacturing sector.

This issue of the "Economic and Social Indicators" presents the Producer Price Indices for the whole manufacturing sector from 1998 up to the third quarter of 2002, broken down by 14 Divisions (2-digits level of the NSIC). Producer Price Indices for the Divisions 15 and 16, "Manufacture of food products, beverages and tobacco", have been further subdivided by product group level and are given separately in Tables 5 to 8 . The methodology used for the calculation of the index is given as an annex to this document.

## 2. Producer Price Index: 3rd Quarter 2002 (1998=100)

### 2.1 Monthly index

At the end of September 2002 the overall Producer Price Index for Manufacturing stood at 116.0 following increases of $1.3 \%$ and $0.2 \%$ in July and August respectively and a slight decrease of $0.1 \%$ in September 2002.

The index moved up in July mainly due to price increases in the following industry groups: "Manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products" ( $+5.4 \%$ ), "Tanning, dressing of leather, etc." ( $+2.7 \%$ ), "Manufacture of wood and wood products" ( $+2.6 \%$ ), "Manufacture of furniture, etc." ( $+1.7 \%$ ) and "Manufacture of chemicals and chemical products" ( $+1.5 \%$ ). Prices in "Food products, beverages and tobacco", which carries $48.7 \%$ of the total weight, rose by $0.7 \%$ following increases of $0.2 \%$ in "Food" and $1.4 \%$ in "Beverages and tobacco". A closer look at the "Food" sector shows an increase of $14.8 \%$ in the index for "Manufacture of cocoa, chocolate and sugar confectionary". Other changes by NSIC group are given in Tables 1 and 5.

In August 2002, prices fell by 10.9\% in "Manufacture of wood and wood products". The index for the "Food products, beverages and tobacco" sector moved up by $0.6 \%$ explained mainly by the effect of a $5.5 \%$ increase in the prices of cooking oils. In September, the $0.1 \%$ fall in the overall index was entirely due to price decreases in "Publishing, printing and reproduction of recorded media".

The evolution of the monthly index by NSIC group for the period 1998 to 2001 is shown in Tables 2 and 3.

### 2.2 Quarterly Index

Table 4 gives the evolution of the Producer Price Index for Manufacturing on a quarterly basis, the quarterly index being computed as the arithmetic mean of the monthly indices. The index, which stood at 114.4 in the second quarter of 2002, rose to 116.0 during the third quarter. This $1.4 \%$ growth was mostly the overall effect of price changes in the following main industry groups: "Manufacture of non-metallic mineral products" $(+5.4 \%)$, "Tanning, dressing of leather, etc." $(+2.2 \%)$, "Manufacture of chemicals and chemical products" $(+1.8 \%)$, "Manufacture of furniture, etc." $(+1.7 \%)$, "Manufacture of food products, beverages and tobacco" ( $+1.2 \%$ ), "Manufacture of paper and paper products" ( $+1.2 \%$ ) and "Manufacture of wood and wood products" (-4.9\%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2001, the overall index for the third quarter of 2002 went up by $4.2 \%$, with increases in almost all the sectors with the exception of "Manufacture of wood and wood products" where there was a decrease of $4.9 \%$ and the two sectors - "Manufacture of rubber and plastic products" and "Manufacture of electrical machinery and apparatus", where no change was registered. Producer prices for the "Manufacture of textiles" went up by $15.9 \%$ but it is to be noted that this Division represents only $1.3 \%$ of the total weight. Those Divisions with significant weights and which witnessed high price increases are
"Manufacture of non-metallic mineral products" (+8.3\%), "Manufacture of furniture, etc." (8.3\%) and "Manufacture of chemicals and chemical products" $(+4.5 \%)$. "Food, beverages and tobacco" went up by $3.7 \%$. Within this group, there were increases of $3.2 \%$ and $4.3 \%$ in "Manufacture of food products" and "Manufacture of beverages and tobacco" respectively. Other details on changes that have occurred during that period are given in Tables 4 and 8.

ANNEX Methodology used in the computation of the Producer Price Index (PPI-M)


## 1 Scope

The PPI-M covers all large establishments (that is those employing 10 or more persons) whose output is mainly sold on the domestic market, that is divisions 15 to 37 of the National Standard Industrial Classification of Economic Activities (NSIC).

## 2 Weighting Scheme

The weights have been calculated from the gross output figures derived from the 1997 Census of Economic Activities. Gross output is valued at basic prices, and thus excludes all taxes on products, namely excise duties and value added tax. The weight of a product group represents the share of its gross output out of the total output of the manufacturing sector.

In the case of sugar, only the sale on the local market has been taken into consideration in establishing the weights.

## 3 Reference Year

The reference year for the calculation of price relatives is 1998. The base price for a particular product is the arithmetic mean of the 12 monthly prices in 1998.

## 4 I ndex Calculation

The PPI-M is calculated at the 5 -digits level of NSIC. Indices at the Division level ( 2 digits NSIC) are then derived as a weighted average of the indices of the products falling within each division. Finally, the overall index for manufacturing is obtained as a weighted average of the Division indices.

The PPI is calculated according to a modified Laspeyre's formula, which is the weighted average of price relatives.
