POPULATION AND VITAL STATISTICS,

REPUBLIC OF MAURITIUS - YEAR 2002

1. Population estimates, 31st December 2002

As at end 2002, the population of the Republic of Mauritius was estimated at 1,216,773 of whom 602,491 were males and 614,282 females, giving a sex ratio of 98.1. With an estimated population of 1,205,677 at the beginning of the year, the population growth rate works out to 0.9%.

The population of the Island of Mauritius grew at a rate of 0.9% from 1,169,303 at the beginning of 2002 to 1,180,178 by the end of the year. Over the same period, the population of Rodrigues increased from 36,085 to 36,306, at a rate of 0.6%. The population of the outer islands (Agalega and Saint Brandon) is estimated at around 289 (193 males and 96 females).

The Republic of Mauritius, with a total land area of 2,040 square kilometres, had a population density of around 596 persons per square kilometre at the end of 2002 (Table 1). Corresponding figures for the islands of Mauritius and Rodrigues were 633 and 349 respectively.

Table 2 shows comparative population estimates and selected indicators for the past three years.

2. Components of population growth

Table 3 shows the contribution of each component of population growth, namely natural increase and net international migration, to the population change during the year. In 2002, natural increase (the excess of live births over deaths) added 11,665 persons while net international migration subtracted 569 persons, resulting in an overall population increase of 11,096 (0.9%) during the year.

3. Population estimates by age-group and sex

Table 4 gives the estimated mid-year population of the Republic of Mauritius in 2001 and 2002 by age and sex. The proportion of the population aged 0-14 years fell from 25.6% in 2001 to 25.4% in 2002. In contrast, an increase was registered in the proportion aged 15-64 years, from 68.1% in 2001 to 68.2% in 2002. The proportion of the population aged 65+ years also increased, from 6.3% to 6.4% over the same period. As a result, the dependency ratio (ratio of the child population under 15 years of age and the elderly population aged 65+ years to the population aged 15-64 years) decreased from 469 in 2001 to 468 in 2002.

Figure 1 on page 7 shows a population pyramid depicting changes in the age structure between 1992 and 2002.

4. Vital statistics and rates

Tables 5(a) to 5(c) give a series of vital statistics and rates from 1993 to 2002 for the Republic of Mauritius, the Island of Mauritius and the Island of Rodrigues respectively.

4.1 Live births

In 2002, 19,995 live births were registered in the Republic of Mauritius, representing a 1.5% increase over the number registered in 2001 (19,696). The crude birth rate consequently rose from 16.4 to 16.5.

In the Island of Mauritius, 19,178 live births were registered in 2002 against 18,884 in 2001, that is a 1.6% increase. The crude birth rate thus rose from 16.2 in 2001 to 16.3 in 2002. The Island of Rodrigues also witnessed an increase in live births, from 812 in 2001 to 817 in 2002 though the crude birth rate remained at the level of 22.6.

4.2 Deaths

In the Republic of Mauritius, 8,330 deaths were registered in year 2002, showing a 4.3% increase over the number registered in 2001 (7,983). The crude death rate in 2002 consequently rose to

6.9 from 6.7 in 2001.

The Island of Mauritius registered a 4.4% increase in the number of deaths from 7,761 in 2001 to 8,101 in 2002, with the crude death rate rising from 6.7 to 6.9. The Island of Rodrigues also registered an increase in the number of deaths, from 222 (rate of 5.8) in 2001 to 229 (rate of 6.3) in 2002.

4.3 Infant deaths

A 3.5% increase in the number of infant deaths was noted in the Republic of Mauritius, from 282 in 2001 to 292 in 2002. The infant mortality rate consequently rose from 14.3 in 2001 to 14.6 in 2002.

In the Island of Mauritius, the number of infant deaths increased from 263 in 2001 to 272 in 2002. The infant mortality rate thus rose from 13.9 to 14.2. The number of infant deaths also increased in the Island of Rodrigues from 19 (rate of 22.6) in 2001 to 20 (rate of 24.5) in 2002.

4.4 Still Births

The number of still births registered in the Republic of Mauritius in 2002 was 201, which is 17.6% lower than that registered in 2001 (244). The still birth rate consequently fell from 12.2 in 2001 to 10.0 in 2002.

The Island of Mauritius registered 195 still births in 2002 against 234 in 2001 with the still birth rate falling from 12.2 in 2001 to 10.1 in 2002. The number of still births registered in Rodrigues similarly decreased from 10 (rate of 7.7) in 2001 to 6 (rate of 7.3) in 2002.

4.5 Marriages

There was a 1.6% decrease in the number of marriages registered in the Republic of Mauritius, from 10,635 in 2001 to 10,464 in 2002. The marriage rate consequently fell from 17.7 in 2001 to 17.3 in 2002.

The number of marriages registered in the Island of Mauritius decreased from 10,414 in 2001 to 10,235 in 2002 with the crude marriage rate falling from 17.9 to 17.4. In the Island of Rodrigues the number of marriages registered however increased from 221 (rate of 12.8) to 229 (rate of 12.7).


