

# EDUCATION STATISTICS 2004

## Introduction

This issue of the 'Economic and Social Indicators' presents data which have been compiled on the basis of information collected through the annual survey conducted in schools in March 2004, together with data from other sources. The tables relate to pre-primary, primary and secondary (academic and pre-vocational) education for the Republic of Mauritius.

## 1. Expenditure

Government recurrent expenditure on education was estimated around Rs 5,354 million for the financial year 2003/2004. This represents 15.4% of the government total recurrent expenditure of Rs 34,709 million for 2003/2004, compared to 14.5% in financial year 2002/2003.

About 36% of the budget was allocated to the secondary education sector, 26% to primary, 13% to post secondary, 2% to technical and vocational, 1% to pre-primary and the remaining 22 % to other expenses (Table 1).

## 2. Pre-primary Education

### 2.1 *Schools*

In March 2004, there were 1,070 schools providing pre-primary services: 1,039 in the Island of Mauritius and 31 in Rodrigues. Of these schools, 77% were privately run institutions; 17% were administered by the Pre-School Trust Fund (PSTF) on primary school premises and the remaining 6% by the Roman Catholic Education Authority (RCEA) and Municipal and Village Councils (Table 2).

### 2.2 *Enrolment*

The population aged 3 years and over, enrolled in these pre-primary schools, numbered 37,483 of whom 19,120 were boys and 18,363 girls (Table 3). The Gross Enrolment Ratio (pre-primary enrolment as a percentage of the population aged 4 and 5 years) worked out to 96% in 2004 against 99% in 2003.

### **2.3 Personnel**

The pre-primary schools employed 3,352 persons, of whom 2,474 were teachers and 878 non-teaching staff. Most (99.3%) of the teachers were women. The average number of pupils per teacher worked out to 15.

## **3 Primary Education**

### **3.1 Schools**

In March 2004, there were 289 schools providing primary education, 276 in the Island of Mauritius and 13 in Rodrigues. The majority (220) of the schools was run by government, 51 by the Roman Catholic Education Authority (RCEA), two by the Hindu Education Authority and the other 16 were private non-aided schools (Table 4).

### **3.2 Enrolment**

The primary school population in the Republic of Mauritius decreased by about 3% from 129,616 in 2003 to 126,226 in 2004. Boys represented 51% of the total school population. Around 75% of the primary school population was enrolled in government schools while the remaining 25% were in aided and non-aided schools (Table 6).

The highest enrolment was registered in grade VI with 27,314 pupils including 6,087 repeaters. The Gross Enrolment Ratio (primary enrolment as a percentage of the population aged 6 to 11 years) worked out to 102%, same as last year.

### **3.3 Personnel**

Employment in primary schools stood at 8,476 persons (4,012 men and 4,464 women). Of this number, 5,741 were teaching staff: 4,340 General Purpose Teachers and 1,401 Oriental Language Teachers. The remaining 2,735 comprised 289 Head Teachers, 821 Deputy Head Teachers and 1,625 administrative and other workers (Table 7). The pupil/teacher ratio in primary schools worked out to 29.

### **3.4 Certificate of Primary Education (CPE)**

In 2003, the number of school candidates who took part in the CPE examination stood at 27,510 (14,252 boys and 13,258 girls). Of this number, 17,219 or 63% succeeded. A comparison by sex showed a success rate of 69% for girls against 57% for boys (Table 8).

## **4 Secondary and Pre-vocational Education**

### **4.1 General**

At March 2004, secondary and pre-vocational education was offered in 189 schools: 183 in the Island of Mauritius and 6 in Rodrigues. Of these schools, 63 were offering secondary academic education only, 13 pre-vocational education only and 113 both secondary academic and pre-vocational education.

### **4.2 Secondary education (Academic only)**

#### **4.2.1 Schools**

Out of the 176 schools dispensing secondary education, 170 were found in the Island of Mauritius and six in Rodrigues. State administered schools numbered 67 (51 Form I – V and 16 Form VI), while the other 109 were confessional, private aided and non-aided schools (Table 9).

#### **4.2.2 Enrolment**

Secondary education enrolment increased by about 2% from 103,847 in 2003 to 105,827 in 2004. An analysis by sex showed that 52% (55,164) were girls. The state schools catered for 32% of secondary school population while the confessional and private (aided and unaided) schools made up for the rest (68%). The Gross Enrolment Ratio (secondary education enrolment as a percentage of the population aged 12 to 19 years) kept its level of 2003, that is 66%.

## **4.3 Pre-Vocational Education**

### **4.3.1 Schools**

At March 2004, 126 schools were offering pre-vocational education: 121 in the Island of Mauritius and 5 in Rodrigues. Fifty seven of these schools were state schools while the remaining 69 were confessional or private (aided and unaided) schools.

### **4.3.2 Enrolment**

In 2004, pre-vocational education enrolment was 8,488 comprising 5,457 boys and 3,031 girls (Table 14). The state schools accounted for 40 % of the total population enrolled in pre-vocational schools.

#### **4.4 Personnel**

Total number of persons employed in schools offering secondary and pre-vocational education was 9,970.

The secondary education teaching staff in the academic stream was 6,396 (2,994 men and 3,402 women), giving an average of 17 pupils per teacher. On the other hand, the pre-vocational education teaching staff stood at 578 (224 men and 354 women), giving an average of 15 pupils per teacher. The non-teaching staff in both streams together was 2,996 and consisted of 273 at senior management level, 904 administrative staff and 1,819 other workers (Table 12,13 & 14).

#### **4.5 Cambridge School Certificate (SC)**

In 2003, out of 14,579 candidates (6,765 boys and 7,814 girls) who took part in the Cambridge School Certificate examination, 76% (11,007) were successful. A comparison by sex showed a higher pass rate of 78% for girls as compared to 73% for boys. A summary of the results is given in Table 15.

#### **4.6 Cambridge Higher School Certificate(HSC)**

The number of students taking part in the Cambridge Higher School Certificate examination in 2003 totalled 7,205 (3,307 boys and 3,898 girls). The overall pass rate was 75%, with a greater achievement among girls (79%) than among boys (71%).
