External Trade – 1st Quarter 2009

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first quarter of 2009 and for the years 2007 and 2008. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2007 published in this indicator are final, those for 2008 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.


Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the first quarter of 2009 some 39% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the first quarter of 2009 was valued at Rs 39,654 million, i.e 28.2% lower than the previous quarter and 12.1% lower than the corresponding quarter of 2008.

During the first quarter of 2009, total exports were valued at Rs 14,262 million against imports of Rs 25,392 million. This results in a trade deficit of Rs 11,130 million, compared to deficits of Rs 15,394 million (-27.7%) for the previous quarter and Rs 16,465 million (-32.4%) for the corresponding quarter of 2008.



Based on past trends, total exports for the year 2009 are expected to be of the order of Rs 63,000 million, against Rs 118,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around Rs 55,000 million.

2. Exports

2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the first quarter of 2009, including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 14,262 million, showing decreases of 28.4% and 0.3% compared to the previous quarter and the corresponding quarter of 2008 respectively.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 75.3% of total exports, went down by 23.2% from Rs 13,971 million in the previous quarter to Rs 10,735 million in the first quarter of 2009. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008, domestic exports were higher by 4.4%. For the first quarter of 2009 re-exports stood at Rs 2,271 million, going down by 29.1% compared to the previous quarter and by 14.1% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008.

2.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3)

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first quarter of 2009 amounted to Rs 4,758 million showing a decrease of 26.4% over the previous quarter. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008, total exports of this section registered an increase of 20.1% mostly explained by rises of 23.6% in the exports of "Fish and fish preparations" and 18.4% in the exports of sugar.

During the first quarter of 2009, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at Rs 1,156 million, showing decreases of 12.8% compared to the previous quarter and a slight increase of 0.4% compared to its corresponding quarter of 2008.

Export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 47.9% of total exports, decreased by 17.7% compared to the fourth quarter of 2008 to reach Rs 6,227 million. With respect to the first quarter of 2008, exports of this section registered a decrease of 2.3%, mainly attributable to a decrease in the exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" representing 86.6% of exports of this section.

Total exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" dropped by 71.8% compared to the previous quarter and by 68.8% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008 as a result of a substantial fall in the re-exports of mobile phones by freeport operators.

2.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (Table 1)

During the first quarter of 2009 exports of the EOE amounted to Rs 7,829 million showing a decrease of 16.9% compared to the previous quarter and an increase of 1.8% compared to the corresponding period of 2008. Details on exports of these enterprises will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises, which will be released on 26 June 2009.

Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

2.4 Exports by Country of destination (Table 7)

Analysis by country of destination for the first quarter of 2009 shows that the European countries purchased some 70.4% of our exports for an amount of Rs 9,159 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with Rs 4,522 million, or 34.8% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (12.2%), U.S.A (8.0%), Italy (7.5%), Madagascar (5.5%), and Spain (5.4%).

Compared to the first quarter of 2008, total exports to our major markets namely UK and USA went up by 0.2% and 15.6% respectively. It is to be noted that exports to Italy and Spain increased substantially due to higher exports of "Fish and fish preparations". On the other hand, exports to France and Madagascar fell by 17.7% and 9.8% respectively. A significant drop of 88.1% is recorded in total exports to the United Arab Emirates as a consequence of the decrease in re-exports of cellular phones to this country. Further details are given in Table 7.



3. Imports

3.1 Total imports (Table 1)

Total imports for the first quarter of 2009 reached Rs 25,392 million, showing a decrease of 28.1% over the previous quarter and 17.5% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008.

3.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10)

Imports of "Food and live animals" for the first quarter of 2009 were valued at Rs 4,995 million showing decreases of 13.6% over the previous quarter and 26.1% over the corresponding quarter of 2008. It is to be noted that imports of "Fish and fish preparations" registered decreases of 2.1% compared to the previous quarter and 31.3% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008. Imports of dairy products also fell by 13.5% with respect to the previous quarter and by 29.2% in comparison with the first quarter of 2008.

The import bill of "Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products" stood at Rs 4,288 million for the first quarter of 2009 representing decreases of 27.4% over the previous quarter and 34.8% compared to the corresponding quarter of last year.


Imports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" declined by 32.9% compared to the previous quarter and by 12.7% compared to the first quarter of 2008. All divisions falling under this section registered decreases ranging from 17.0% to 56.5% except "Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones" which showed an increase of 10% over the previous quarter.

For the first quarter of 2009, imports of "Machinery & transport equipment" stood at Rs 5,610 million. Compared to the previous quarter imports of this section dropped by 25.5% whereas with respect to the corresponding quarter of 2008, an increase of 6.6% is noted.

3.3 Imports by country of origin (Table 13)

During the first quarter of 2009, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 12,458 million with a share of 49.1% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (19.7%), China (11.2%), France (9.3%), South Africa (9.3%), Malaysia (3.4%), Japan (3.2%), Australia (3.0%) USA (2.8%), Spain (2.7%), Thailand (2.4%) and Argentina (1.3%). The high share of India in our import bill is explained by the fact that India is our main supplier of petroleum products since the last quarter of 2006. It is to be noted that imports from Japan dropped by 19.2% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008 due to lower imports of road vehicles.



4. Trade with Regional Organisations (Tables 14-16)

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first quarter of 2009 stood at Rs 1,718 million, against imports of Rs 3,289 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 1,571 million.

During the first quarter of 2009 our exports to COMESA countries attained Rs 1,023 million, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 797 million resulting in a positive trade balance of Rs 226 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 69.6%. The main products exported to Madagascar were cotton fabrics and preparations used in animal feeding. Our main suppliers were Kenya (30.2%), Egypt (21.7%), Madagascar (16.1%) and Seychelles (11.6%). The main products imported from Kenya were iron bars and preparations for cleaning or disinfecting constituted the main products imported from Egypt.

Trade with SADC countries for the first quarter of 2009 showed a deficit of Rs 1,462 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 2,829 million and exports worth Rs 1,367 million. The main supplier was South Africa (83.0%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (52.0%) and South Africa (45.3%). It can be noted that imports from South Africa increased by 10.4% in the first quarter of 2009 compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008 on account of an increase in imports of coal, excluding anthracite and bituminous.

5. Trade in Freeport Zone (Table 2)

During the first quarter of 2009, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 1,293 million, a figure which is lower by 4.9% compared to the previous quarter and higher by 8.5% compared to the first quarter of 2008. The main items imported through the Freeport were "Fish and fish preparations" and "Chemicals & related products" (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs1,628 million, showing decreases of 25.0% and 15.4% when compared to the previous quarter and the corresponding quarter of 2008 respectively. The main items re-exported by the Freeport were "Fish and fish preparations" and "Articles of apparel and clothing accessories" sourced mainly from Export Oriented Enterprises (Table 6).

It is worth noting that trade carried out by the freeport has contracted significantly on account of a decrease in trade of mobile phones by freeport operators.

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2002). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 3) or SITC Rev. 3. The HS and the SITC Rev. 3 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
