The Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE)

1st Quarter 2009

1. Introduction

Following the repeal of various industrial enactments in the Finance Act 2006, all industrial certificates including the export certificate (EPZ) lapsed on 1 October 2006. To have consistent data series on enterprises involved in manufacturing activities for export, in addition to enterprises formerly holding an EPZ certificate, enterprises manufacturing goods for export and holding a registration certificate issued by the Board of Investment as from 1 October 2006 are also being surveyed. These manufacturing enterprises are now classified as "Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE)".

This issue of "Economic and Social Indicators" presents the results of the "Quarterly Survey of Employment" among the EOE conducted by the Central Statistics Office at the end of March 2009. It aims at providing up-to-date data on the evolution of the workforce in enterprises involved in manufacturing activities for export by industrial sub-group.

The Indicator also includes provisional figures on EOE imports and exports for the first quarter of 2009 as well as revised figures for previous years. Table 1.1 shows the main indicators of the EOE sector for the period 1996 to 2008.

2. Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE)

2.1 Number of enterprises

The number of export-oriented enterprises at the end of the first quarter of 2009 stood at 406 compared to 412 at the end of December 2008 and 402 a year ago. (Table 1.2)

During the first quarter of 2009, 12 enterprises closed down of which 5 in "Wearing apparel" and 4 in "Jewellery and related articles". (Table 1.3)

In "Wearing apparel", the most important group in the EOE, the number of enterprises at the end of March 2009 stood at 165 compared to 169 at the end of December 2008 and 174 a year ago. The distribution of enterprises by product group is given in Table 1.2.

2.2 Employment evolution, 1st quarter 2009

During the first quarter of 2009, employment in the EOE decreased by 3,597 from 62,276 (25,894 males and 36,382 females) at the end of December 2008 to 58,679 (24,944 males and 33,735 females) at the end of March 2009. Female employment fell by 2,647 as well as male employment by 950 (Table 1.4).

A total of 458 jobs were created through expansion in existing enterprises. On the other hand, 4,185 jobs were lost: 1,927 through reduction in existing enterprises and 2,258 following the closure of 12 enterprises (Table 1.5).

Employment in the "Wearing apparel" group decreased by 2,661 from 44,318 at the end of the previous quarter to 41,657 at the end of March 2009 and that in the "Textile yarn and fabrics" group also fell by 636 from 5,169 to 4,533. Within the "Wearing apparel" group, employment

decreased by 21 in "Pullovers" and by 2,640 in "Other garments". Details of employment by product group are shown in Tables 1.6 and 1.7.

Foreign workers decreased by 1,025 from 18,050 at the end of December 2008 to 17,025 at the end of March 2009 (Table 1.4). Employment contracted by 257 among males and by 768 among females. Nearly 82% of foreign workers were engaged in the "Wearing apparel" group. Table 1.8 shows expatriate employment by product group and sex.

2.3 Employment evolution, March 2008 – March 2009

Comparison of March 2008 and March 2009, figures show an increase of 4 in the number of enterprises and a decrease of 8,280 in the EOE workforce. Male employment decreased by 2,312 and female employment by 5,968. Expatriate employment fell by 1,423 (Tables 1.4 and 1.8).

In the "Wearing apparel" group, employment contracted by 7,380 from 49,037 to 41,657. Within the group, employment fell by 1,048 in "Pullovers" and by 6,332 in "Other garments". Details of changes in employment by product group are given in Table 1.7.

2.4 Exports and Imports, 1st quarter 2009

Statistics on imports and exports are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are, at times, revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA)-Customs Department. Thus while figures for 2006 and 2007 are final, those for the year 2008 and 1st quarter 2009 are subject to revision as and when the MRA-Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Provisional figures show that EOE exports during the first quarter of 2009 amounted to Rs. 7,829 million, that is Rs 1,593 million or 16.9% lower compared to the 4th quarter of 2008 and Rs 136 million or 1.8% higher compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008 (Table 1.9).

Exports of manufactured articles of apparel and clothing went down significantly by 18.5% or Rs 1,109 million during the first quarter 2009 to reach Rs. 4,870 million. Other significant decreases were registered in: "Jewellery, goldsmiths and silversmiths wares" (-Rs. 86 million or 41.7%) and "Toys, games and sporting goods" (-Rs. 17 million or 39.5%). Other details of EOE exports by section are shown in Table 1.10.

The United Kingdom, France and the United States of America remain our principal EOE markets, accounting for Rs. 4,646 million or around 59% of total exports. Compared to the corresponding quarter 2008, exports to the United Kingdom decreased by Rs. 334 million (-11.7%) and to France by Rs. 195 million (-13.6%). On the other hand, export to United States of America rose by Rs 162 million (+21.9%). During the same period, exports towards the Republic of South Africa increased by Rs. 196 million (+58.7%) from Rs. 334 million to Rs. 530 million and those to the Malagasy Republic decreased by Rs. 20 million (-7.4%) from Rs. 272 million to Rs. 252 million (Table 1.12).

EOE imports for the first quarter of 2009 were estimated at Rs 3,784 million. This represents a decline of Rs 836 million or 18.1% over the previous quarter and of Rs 2,050 million or 35.1% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2008. Compared to the first quarter of 2008, imports of raw materials decreased by Rs. 1,868 (-34.0%) from Rs. 5,494 million to Rs. 3,626 million and that of machinery and equipment decreased by Rs. 182 million (-53.5%) from Rs. 340 million to Rs. 158 million. (Table 1.9)

Net exports, i.e. exports minus imports, amounted to Rs. 4,045 million and its ratio to total exports works out to around 52% compared to 24% in the corresponding quarter of 2008 (Table 1.9).

It is to be noted that the above figures do not include transactions of the EOE with the Freeport. EOE sales to the Freeport are considered as local sales. It was valued at Rs. 475 million for the 1st quarter in 2009 compared to Rs. 418 million for the previous quarter and Rs. 554 million for the corresponding period of 2008. These sales are included in exports of Freeport, as and when the goods leave the country.
