Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE)

1st Quarter 2010

1. Introduction

Following the repeal of various industrial enactments in the Finance Act 2006, all industrial certificates including the export certificate (EPZ) lapsed on 1 October 2006. To have consistent data series on enterprises involved in manufacturing activities for export, in addition to enterprises formerly holding an EPZ certificate, enterprises manufacturing goods for export and holding a registration certificate issued by the Board of Investment as from 1 October 2006 are also being surveyed. These manufacturing enterprises are now classified as "Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE)".

This issue of "Economic and Social Indicators" presents the results of the "Quarterly Survey of Employment" among the EOE conducted by the Central Statistics Office at the end of March 2010. It aims at providing up-to-date data on the evolution of the workforce in enterprises involved in manufacturing activities for export by industrial sub-group.

The Indicator also includes provisional figures on EOE imports and exports for the 1st quarter of 2010 as well as revised figures for previous years. Table 1.1 shows the main indicators of the EOE sector for the period 1997 to 2009.

2. Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE)

2.1 Number of enterprises

The number of export-oriented enterprises at the end of the 1st quarter of 2010 stood at 398 compared to 413 at the end of December 2009 and 406 at the end of March 2009 (Table 1.2).

During the 1st quarter of 2010, 2 enterprises started operation and 17 enterprises closed down of which 3 in "Wearing apparel", 8 in "Other" product group and 3 in "Flowers" (Table 1.3).

In "Wearing apparel", the most important group in EOE, the number of enterprises at the end of March 2010 stood at 155 compared to 158 at the end of December 2009 and 165 at the end of March 2009. The distribution of enterprises by product group is given in Table 1.2.

2.2 Employment evolution, 1st quarter 2010

During the 1st quarter of 2010, employment in the EOE decreased by 185 from 58,566 (24,501 males and 34,065 females) at the end of December 2009 to 58,381 (24,326 males and 34,055 females) at the end of March 2010. Male and female employment decreased by 175 and 10 respectively (Table 1.4).

A total of 1,097 jobs were created during the quarter: 1,066 through the expansion of existing enterprises and 31 through the creation of 2 new enterprises. On the other hand, 1,282 jobs were lost: 1,188 through reduction in existing enterprises and 94 following the closure of 17 enterprises (Table 1.5).

Employment in the "Wearing apparel" group decreased by 442 from 41,540 at the end of the previous quarter to 41,098 at the end of March 2010 and that in the "Textile yarn and fabrics"

group also fell by 140 from 4,265 to 4,125. Within the "Wearing apparel" group, employment decreased by 79 in "Pullovers" and by 363 in "Other garments". Details of employment by product group are shown in Tables 1.6 and 1.7.

Foreign workers decreased by 358 from 18,453 at the end of December 2009 to 18,095 at the end of March 2010 (Table 1.4). Employment contracted by 173 among males and by 185 among females. Some 15,058 (83%) foreign workers were engaged in the "Wearing apparel" group. Table 1.8 shows expatriate employment by product group and sex.

2.3 Employment evolution, March 2009 – March 2010

From March 2009 to March 2010, total employment decreased by 298 from 58,679 to 58,381. Male employment decreased by 618 while female employment went up by 320. Expatriate employment increased by 1,070 (Tables 1.4 and 1.8).

Employment in "Textile yarn and fabrics" fell by 408 from 4,533 to 4,125 and in the "Wearing apparel" group, it decreased by 559 from 41,657 to 41,098. Within the "Wearing apparel" group, employment fell by 683 in "Pullovers" and increased by 124 in "Other garments". Details of changes in employment by product group are given in Table 1.7.

2.4 Exports and Imports, 1st quarter 2010

Statistics on imports and exports are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are, at times, revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department. Thus, while figures for 2007 and 2008 are final, those for the year 2009 and 1st quarter 2010 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Provisional figures show that EOE exports during the 1st quarter of 2010 amounted to Rs. 8,477 million, that is Rs 934 million or 9.9% lower compared to the 4th quarter of 2009 and Rs 592 million or 7.5% higher compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009 (Table 1.9).

Exports of manufactured articles of apparel and clothing decreased by Rs. 753 million or 13.5% during the first quarter 2010 to reach Rs. 4,816 million. Other decreases were registered in: "Fish and fish preparations" (-Rs. 95 million or -5.5%) and "Toys, games and sporting goods" (-Rs. 11 million or -22.9%). Other details of EOE exports by section are shown in Table 1.10.

The United Kingdom, France and the United States of America remain our principal EOE markets, accounting for Rs. 5,309 million or around 63% of total exports. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009, exports to the United Kingdom increased by Rs. 50 million (+2.0%), to France by Rs. 295 million (+23.6%) and to United States of America by Rs. 299 million (+33.1%). During the same period, exports to the Malagasy Republic increased by Rs. 51 million (+20.2%) from Rs. 253 million to Rs. 304 million while that towards the Republic of South Africa decreased by Rs. 40 million (-7.5%) from Rs. 532 million to Rs. 492 million (Table 1.12).

EOE imports for the 1st quarter of 2010 amounted to Rs 4,626 million. This represents a decrease of Rs. 615 million or 11.7% over the previous quarter and an increase of Rs. 842 million or 22.3% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009. Compared to the first quarter of 2009, imports of raw materials increased by Rs. 823 million (+22.7%) from Rs. 3,626 million to Rs. 4,449 million and machinery and equipment by Rs. 19 million (+12.0%) from Rs. 158 million to Rs. 177 million (Table 1.9).

Net exports, i.e. exports minus imports, amounted to Rs. 3,851 million and its ratio to total exports works out to around 45% compared to 52% in the corresponding quarter of 2009 (Table 1.9).

It is to be noted that the above figures do not include transactions of the EOE with the Freeport. EOE sales to the Freeport are considered as local sales. It was valued at Rs. 330 million for the 1st quarter in 2010 compared to Rs. 358 million for the previous quarter and Rs. 475 million for the corresponding period of 2009. These sales are included in exports of Freeport, as and when the goods leave the country.
