

External Trade – 2nd Quarter 2010

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first and second quarters of 2010 and for the years 2008 and 2009. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2008 published in this indicator are final, those for 2010 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

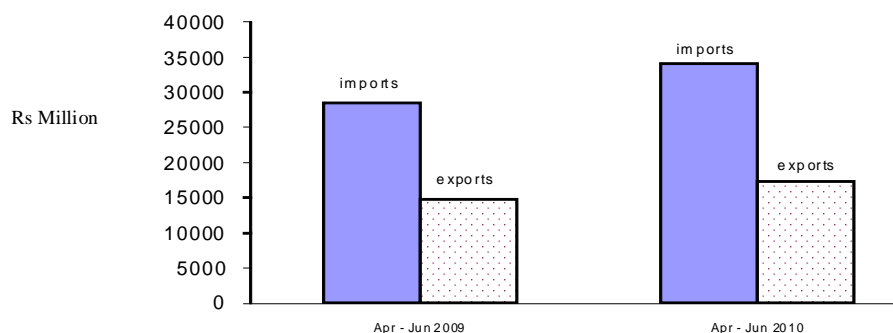
Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the second quarter of 2010 some 29% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the second quarter of 2010 was valued at Rs 51,275 million, i.e 19.4% higher than the previous quarter and 18.7% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2009.

During the second quarter of 2010, total exports were valued at Rs 17,304 million against imports of Rs 33,971 million. This resulted in a trade deficit of Rs 16,667 million, compared to deficits of Rs 14,646 million (+13.8%) for the previous quarter and Rs 13,784 million (+20.9%) for the corresponding quarter of 2009.



Based on data for the first semester of 2010 and past trends, total exports for the year 2010 are expected to be of the order of Rs 63,000 million, against Rs 130,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around Rs 67,000 million.

2. Exports

2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the second quarter of 2010, including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ships' stores and bunkers, amounted to Rs 17,304 million, showing increases of 22.2% over the previous quarter and 17.6% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 75.6% of total exports, went up by 33.6% from Rs 9,795 million in the previous quarter to Rs 13,086 million in the second quarter of 2010. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009, domestic exports were higher by 19.2%. For the second quarter of 2010 re-exports stood at Rs 2,559 million, i.e lower by 4.2% compared to the previous quarter. However, compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009 the figures were lower by 0.6%.

Total exports for the first semester of 2010 was Rs 31,461 million, showing an increase of 8.6% over the first semester of 2009.

2.2 Exports by SITC section - (First semester 2010)

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first semester of 2010 amounted to Rs 8,632 million, showing an increase of 5.3% over the first semester of 2009. Exports of sugar and "fish and fish preparations", the major components of this section, went up by 10.1% and 3.6% respectively (Table 3).

For the first semester of 2010, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at Rs 2,785 million, higher by 9.8% compared to exports of Rs 2,536 million for the first six months of 2009.

Total exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" for the first semester of 2010 increased by 59.9% from Rs 506 million to Rs 809 million in first semester 2009 when compared to the corresponding semester of 2009.

Export proceeds for first semester 2010 from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 49.9% of total exports increased by 1.5% compared to the corresponding period of 2009 to reach Rs 14,014 million. Exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" representing 80.0% of exports of this section showed a decrease of 6.1% compared to the first semester of 2009.

2.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) - (First semester 2010)

During the first semester of 2010, exports of the EOE amounted to Rs 18,683 million showing an increase of 6.4% compared to the corresponding period of 2009 (Table 1). Details on exports of these enterprises will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises, which will be released on 22 September 2010.

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

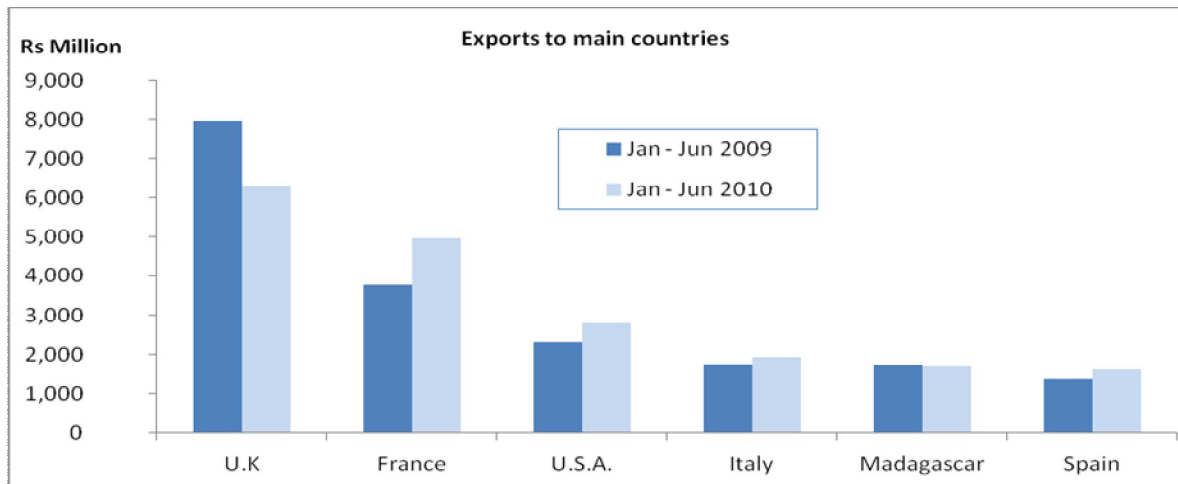
2.4 Exports by Country of destination - (First semester 2010)

Analysis by country of destination for the first semester of 2010 shows that the European countries purchased some 63.8% of our exports for an amount of Rs 17,934 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with Rs 6,293 million, or 22.4% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (17.7%), U.S.A (9.9%), Italy (6.9%), Madagascar (6.0%) and Spain (5.7%) - (Table 7).

Compared to the first six months of 2009, total exports to UK and Madagascar went down by 21.1% and 2.1% respectively. However exports to France, USA, Spain and Italy rose by 32.0%, 21.1%, 17.4% and 9.6% respectively.

3. Imports

3.1 Total imports - (Table 1)

Total imports for the second quarter of 2010 reached Rs 33,971 million, showing increases of 18.7% over the previous quarter and 19.2% over the corresponding quarter of 2009.

Total imports for the first semester of 2010 amounted to Rs 62,774 million, showing an increase of 16.5% over the corresponding semester of 2009.

3.2 Imports by SITC section - (First semester 2010)

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the first semester of 2010 were valued at Rs 11,389 million, i.e 4.5% higher than those of the corresponding period of last year. The most significant increases were noted in imports of meat and meat preparation (+42.3%), dairy products (+18.2%) and vegetables and fruits (+13.0%). On the other hand, imports of wheat decreased by 26.2% (Table 10).

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 12,348 million representing an increase of 48.3% over the corresponding semester of last year.

Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” for the first semester rose by 12.8% to reach Rs 11,456 million. The main increases being in “*Pearls, precious & semi precious stones*” (39.3%), “*Paper, paperboard & articles thereof*” (23.1%) and “*Iron & steel*”(15.2%) ,

For the first semester of 2010, imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” which were valued at Rs 13,255 million went up by 11.7%, the most important increase being in “*Power generating machinery & equipment & machine parts*” (180.7%).

3.3 Imports by country of origin – (First semester 2010)

During the first semester of 2010, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 33,257 million with a share of 52.8% of total imports.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (22.9%), China (12.5%), France (8.8%), South Africa (8.5%), Japan (3.6%), Australia (3.2%), Malaysia (2.8%), USA (2.7%), Germany (2.5%), Thailand (2.4%) and Spain (2.3%). The high share of India in our import bill is explained by the fact that India is our main supplier of petroleum products (Table 13).

4. Trade with Regional Organisations – (First semester 2010)

Total exports to African, Carribean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first semester of 2010 stood at Rs 3,983 million, against imports of Rs 7,073 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 3,090 million.

During the first semester of 2010, our exports to COMESA countries attained Rs 2,403 million while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 1,618 million resulting in a favourable trade balance of Rs 785 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 70.2%. The main products exported to Madagascar were yarn of carded wool

and wheat or meslin flour. Our main suppliers were Kenya (40.9%), Egypt (18.0%) and Madagascar (17.0%). The main products imported from Kenya were cigarettes containing tobacco while iron rods constituted the main products imported from Egypt. Our imports from Madagascar consisted mainly of dried broadbeans and dyed plain cotton weave. (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the first semester of 2010 showed a deficit of Rs 2,658 million, resulting from imports of a value of Rs 6,175 million and exports worth Rs 3,517 million. The main supplier was South Africa (86.4%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (48.0%) and South Africa (36.9%). It can be noted that imports from Malawi increased significantly in the first semester of 2010 on account of imports of cotton (Table 16).

5. Trade in Freeport Zone - (First semester 2010)

During the first semester of 2010, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 2,574 million, a figure which is higher by 0.9% compared to the corresponding period of last year. The main items imported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations” “Chemicals and related products & accessories etc.” and “Textile yarns, fabrics, and made up articles” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets were valued at Rs 3,558 million, showing an increase of 5.6% when compared to the first semester of 2009. The main items re-exported by the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations” and “Articles of apparel and clothing accessories” (Table 6). Items falling under “Articles of apparel and clothing accessories” were sourced mainly from Export Oriented Enterprises.

Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2007). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
