

External Trade – 3rd Quarter 2010

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first three quarters of 2010 and for the years 2008 and 2009. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while figures for 2009 published in this indicator are final, those for 2010 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to the Central Statistics Office.

Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for. However, it was not possible prior to 2002 to include Freeport transactions in our general trade statistics because of different processing systems at the Customs Department and at the Mauritius Freeport Authority. Since mid-October 2001, transactions of the Freeport are being lodged through the Customs Management System (CMS), thus making it possible to integrate data of the Freeport zone with those of Customs.

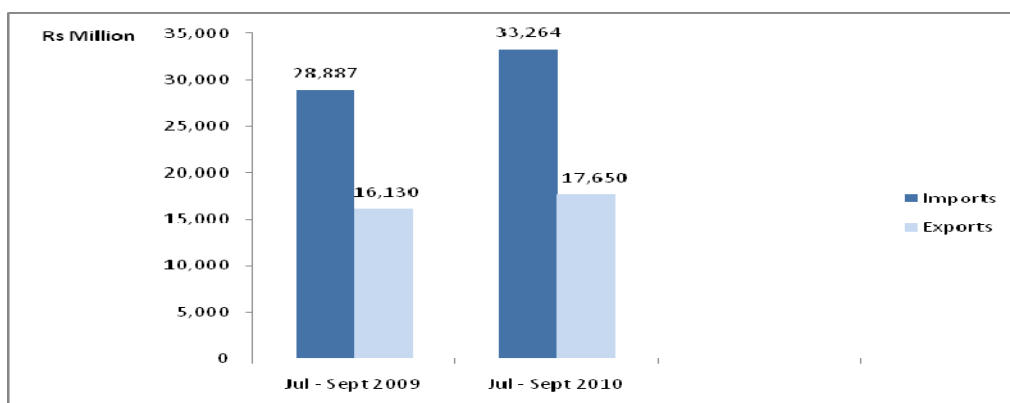
Hence, as from 2002, data on imports and exports include transactions through the Mauritius Freeport. It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius because it is not possible to distinguish between domestic exports and re-exports of freeport licensees. It is estimated that for the third quarter of 2010 some 26% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

1. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the third quarter of 2010 was valued at Rs 50,914 million, i.e 0.8% lower than the previous quarter and 13.1% higher than the corresponding quarter of 2009.

During the third quarter of 2010, total exports were valued at Rs 17,650 million against imports of Rs 33,264 million resulting in a trade deficit of Rs 15,614 million. Compared to the previous quarter the deficit was lower by 6.6% and higher by 22.9% with respect to the corresponding quarter of 2009.

Based on past trends, total exports for the year 2010 are expected to be of the order of Rs 66,500 million, against Rs 136,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around Rs 69,500 million.

2. Exports

2.1 Total exports (Table 1)

Total export proceeds for the third quarter of 2010, comprising domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ships' stores and bunkers amounted to Rs 17,650 million, showing increases of 2.0% compared to the previous quarter and 9.4% with respect to the corresponding period of 2009.

Domestic exports, which accounted for 76.7% of total exports, went up by 3.4% from Rs 13,086 million in the previous quarter to Rs 13,537 million in the third quarter of 2010. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009, domestic exports were higher by 9.9%. For the third quarter of 2010 re-exports stood at Rs 2,694 million, i.e higher by 5.3% compared to the previous quarter and by 0.6% as regard to the corresponding quarter of 2009 respectively.

Total exports for the first nine months of 2010 reached Rs 49,111 million, showing an increase of 8.8% over the first nine months of 2009.

2.2 Exports by SITC section - (First nine months 2010)

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first nine months of 2010 amounted to Rs 14,356 million showing a rise of 2.1% over the corresponding period of 2009 (Table 3).

For the first nine months of 2010, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at Rs 4,340 million, higher by 15.5% when compared to exports for the first nine months of 2009, valued at Rs 3,757 million.

Total exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" for the first nine months of 2010 rose by 39.1% compared to the corresponding nine months of 2009 as a result of increases in re-exports of waste and scrap of cast iron, medicaments, articles for conveyance or packing of goods and mobile phones.

Export proceeds from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles", contributing 48.5% of total exports from January to September 2010, increased by 4.7% compared to the first nine months of 2009 to reach Rs 21,495 million. The major component of this section; "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" representing 81.0% of exports of this section slightly decreased by 0.4%.

2.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) - (First nine months 2010)

During the first nine months of 2010, exports of the EOE amounted to Rs 29,202 million showing an increase of 9.2% compared to the corresponding period of 2009 (Table 1). Details on exports of these enterprises will be presented in the Economic and Social Indicators on the Export Oriented Enterprises will be released by the Statistics Unit based at the Ministry of Industry on 16 December 2010 on website.

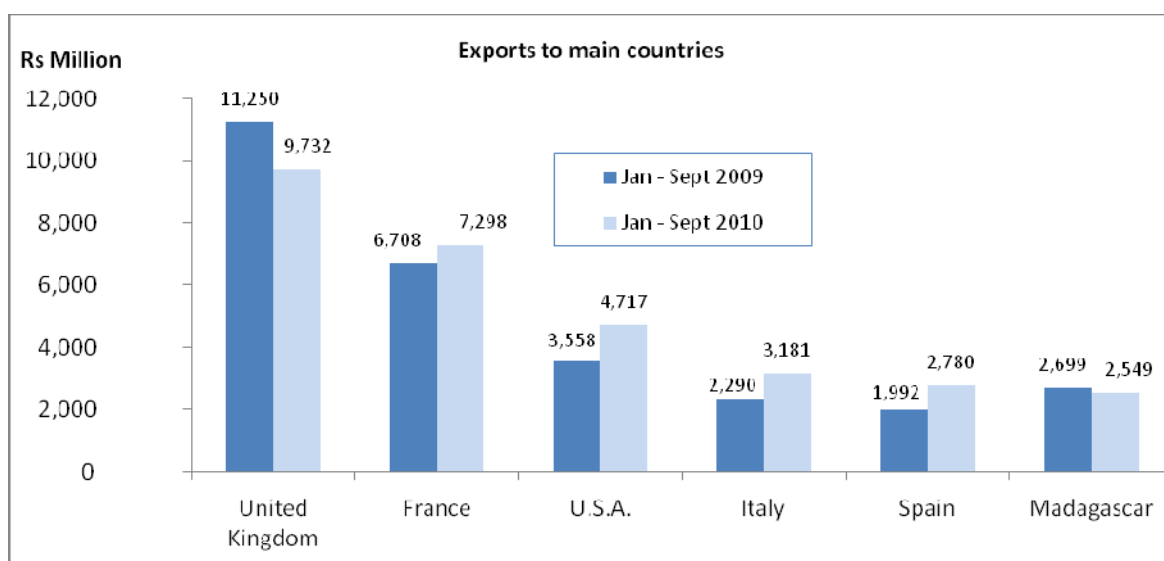

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

2.4 Exports by Country of destination - (First nine months 2010)

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the first nine months of 2010 shows that the European countries purchased some 63.3% of our exports for an amount of Rs 28,050 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with Rs 9,732 million, 21.9% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (16.5%), U.S.A (10.6%), Italy (7.2%), Spain (6.3%), Madagascar (5.7%) and South Africa (5.5%) - (Table 7).

Compared to the first nine months of 2009, total exports to UK fell by 13.5% while those from Spain, Italy, U.S.A and South Africa went up by 39.6%, 38.9%, 32.6% and 30.3% respectively.



3. Imports

3.1 Total imports - (Table 1)

Total imports for the third quarter of 2010 reached Rs 33,264 million, showing a decrease of 2.2% over the previous quarter but an increase of 15.2% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2009.

Total imports for the first nine months of 2010 amounted to Rs 96,085 million, showing an increase of 16.1% with respect to the corresponding period of 2009.

3.2 Imports by SITC section - (First nine months 2010)

Imports of “*Food and live animals*” for the first nine months of 2010 were valued at Rs 17,799 million, i.e 7.8% higher than those of the corresponding period of last year. The most significant increases were noted in imports of meat and meat preparations (22.4%), dairy products (16.4%), vegetable and fruits (10.8%) and fish and fish preparations (6.5%) – (Table 10).

The import bill of “*Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products*” stood at Rs 18,363 million, representing an increase of 44.6% over the corresponding nine months of last year.

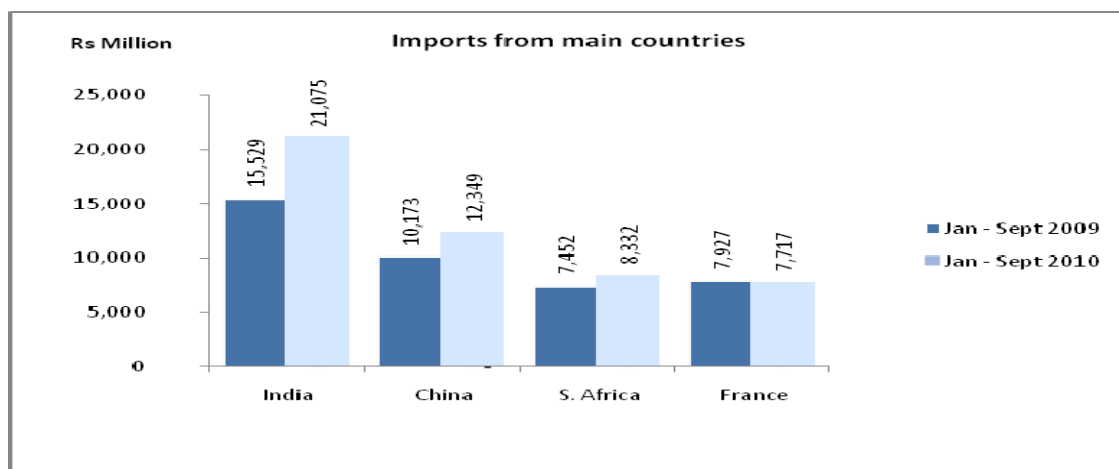
Imports of “*Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material*” for the first nine months rose by 16.4% to reach Rs 18,079 million.

For the first nine months of 2010, imports of “*Machinery & transport equipment*” which were valued at Rs 19,692 million went up by 9.3%, the main increases being in “*Power generating machinery and equipment*” (174.4%) and “*Telecommunications and sound recording and reproducing apparatus and equipment*” (24.3%) .

3.3 Imports by country of origin – (First nine months 2010)

During the first nine months of 2010, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 50,374 million with a share of 52.4%.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (21.9%), China (12.9%), South Africa (8.7%), France (8.0%) - (Table 13).



4. Trade with Regional Organisations – (First nine months 2010)

Total exports to African, Carribean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first nine months of 2010 stood at Rs 6,391 million, against imports of Rs 11,414 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 5,023 million.

During the first nine months of 2010 our exports to COMESA member states attained Rs 3,539 million, while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 2,819 million resulting in a favourable trade balance of Rs 720 million in favour of Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 72.0%. The main products exported to Madagascar were yarn of carded wool and wheat or meslin flour. Our main suppliers were Kenya (35.5%), Egypt (22.6%), Madagascar (14.7%) and Seychelles (12.6%). Our imports from Kenya consisted mainly of cigarettes and tobacco and live bovine animals other than pure-bred breeding animals while iron bars and armoured underground electric cables constituted the main imports from Egypt.

Trade with SADC countries for the first nine months of 2010 showed a deficit of Rs 4,052 million, resulting from imports value of Rs 9,802 million against exports worth Rs 5,750 million. The main supplier was South Africa (85.0%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (44.3%) and South Africa (42.3%).

5. Trade in Freeport Zone - (First nine months 2010)

During the first nine months of 2010, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 4,204 million, a figure which is higher by 0.3% compared to the corresponding period of last year. The main items imported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations” and “Chemicals and related products” (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets which were valued at Rs 5,391 million, moved up by 2.1% when compared to the first nine months of 2009. The main items re-exported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Chemicals and related products” and “Articles of apparel and clothing accessories” (Table 6).

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2007). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
