# Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter and Year 2011

### 1. Introduction

This issue of "Economic and Social Indicators" (ESI) presents the results of the "Quarterly Survey of Employment" among the Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE), conducted by Statistics Mauritius at the end of December 2011.

It also includes provisional figures on EOE imports and exports for the year 2011 as well as revised figures for previous years. Table 1.1 shows the main indicators of the EOE sector for the period 1998 to 2011.

EOE consist of enterprises formerly holding an EPZ certificate as well as enterprises manufacturing goods for export and holding a registration certificate issued by the Board of Investment.

## 2. Enterprises

The number of export-oriented enterprises decreased to 356 at the end of the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2011 from 361 at the end of September 2011. This was the result of 5 closures of which 1 was in "Wearing apparel", the most important group in EOE, 1 in "Textile yarn and fabrics", 2 in "Jewellery and related articles" and 1 in "Food" product group.

Over the year 2011, there was a net decreased of 16 EOEs since 31 enterprises closed down and 15 new ones came into operation. During the same period the number of EOEs manufacturing "Wearing apparel" declined marginally from 144 to 143. The distribution of enterprises by product group is given in Table 1.2.

# 3. Employment

# 3.1 Employment – 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2011

During the fourth quarter of 2011, employment in EOE decreased by 90 (-0.2%) from 55,740 (23,168 males and 32,572 females) at the end of September 2011 to 55,650 (23,221 males and 32,429 females) at the end of December 2011. Male employment increased by 53 while female employment decreased by 143 (Table 1.4).

During the same period, a total of 701 jobs were created through the expansion of existing enterprises. On the other hand, 791 jobs were lost: 765 due to the contraction of workforce of existing enterprises and 26 through the closure of 5 enterprises (Table 1.5).

Employment in the "Wearing apparel" group decreased by 25 (-0.1%) from 37,480 at the end of the previous quarter to 37,455 at the end of December and that in the "Textile yarn and fabrics" group decreased by 18 (-0.4%) from 4,218 to 4,200. Within the "Wearing apparel" group, employment decreased by 43 in "Pullovers" while that in "Other garments" increased by 18, mostly in the manufacture of ready made garments. Details of employment by product group are shown in Tables 1.6 and 1.7.

Foreign workers increased by 397 (+2.2%) from 18,163 at the end of September 2011 to 18,560 at the end of December 2011 (Table 1.4). Employment increased by 217 among males and 180 among females. Nearly 79% (14,743) of foreign workers were engaged in the "Wearing apparel" group (Table 1.8).

#### 3.2 Evolution of employment during last 12 months, December 2010 to December 2011

From December 2010 to December 2011, total employment decreased by 178 (-0.3%) from 55,828 to 55,650. Male employment increased by 30 and female employment decreased by 208. Employment of foreign workers increased by 806 (Tables 1.4 and 1.8).

Employment in "Textile yarn and fabrics", decreased by 91 (-2.1%) from 4,291 to 4,200 and in "Wearing apparel" by 454 (-1.2%) from 37,909 to 37,455. Within the group, employment fell by 468 in "Pullovers" and increased by 14 in "Other garments", mostly in the manufacture of

ready made garments. Details of changes in employment by product group are given in Table 1.7.

# 4. Exports and Imports

Statistics on imports and exports are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are, at times, revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department. Thus, while figures for 2010 are final, those for the year 2011 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

# 4.1 Exports and Imports – 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter 2011

#### 4.1.1 Exports

Provisional figures show that EOE exports during the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2011 amounted to Rs. 11,113 million, that is Rs. 424 million or 3.7% lower compared to the previous quarter of 2011 and Rs. 305 million or 2.7% lower compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010 (Table 1.12).

Exports of manufactured articles of apparel and clothing, which accounts for more than half of exports in the EOE, decreased by 7.0% or Rs. 442 million during the fourth quarter of 2011 to reach Rs. 5,904 million. Increases were registered in: "Toys, games and sporting goods" (+Rs. 15 million or +30.0%), "Fish and fish preparation" (+Rs. 151 million or +7.4%) and "Jewellery, goldsmith and silversmiths wares" (+Rs. 17 million or +4.2%). On the other hand, decreases were noted in "Pearl, precious and semi-precious stones" (-Rs. 86 million or -18.0%), "Optical goods" (-Rs.10 million or -15.6%), "Watches and clocks" (-Rs 28 million or -12.5%) and "Textile yarn, fabrics and made up articles" (-Rs. 48 million or -6.9%). Other details of EOE exports by section are shown in Table 1.13.

The United Kingdom (UK), France and the United States of America (USA) remain the principal EOE markets, accounting for Rs. 6,393 million or around 58% of total exports. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010, exports to USA increased by Rs. 71 million (+5.1%), to France decreased by Rs. 361 million (-15.8%) and that to UK by Rs. 339 million (-10.2%) respectively. During the same period, exports to the Republic of South Africa increased by Rs. 178 million (+17.0%) from Rs. 1,045 million to Rs. 1,223 million and that to the Malagasy Republic increased by Rs. 65 million (+15.2%) from Rs. 429 million to Rs. 494 million (Table 1.15).

## 4.1.2 *Imports*

EOE imports for the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2011 were estimated at Rs. 7,940 million. This represents an increase of Rs. 1,878 million (+31.0%) over the previous quarter and an increase of Rs. 1,595 million (+25.1%) compared to the corresponding quarter of 2010. Imports of raw materials rose by Rs. 1,938 million (+33.5%) from Rs. 5,790 million to Rs. 7,728 million while those of machinery and equipment decreased by Rs. 60 million (-22.1%) from Rs. 272 million to Rs. 212 million compared to the third quarter of 2011 (Tables 1.12 and 1.16).

#### 4.1.3 Balance of Visible Trade

Net exports, i.e. exports minus imports, amounted to Rs. 3,173 million in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2011 and its ratio to total exports works out to around 29% compared to 44% in the corresponding quarter of 2010 (Table 1.12).

#### 4.2 Exports and Imports, December 2010 to December 2011

### 4.2.1 Exports

Total EOE exports in 2011 amounted to Rs. 44,985 million. Compared to 2010, this represents an increase of Rs. 3,363 million or (+8.1%) as shown in Table 1.12.

Exports of manufactured articles of apparel and clothing increased by Rs. 2,123 million or (+9.5%) in 2011 compared to 2010. During the same period, increases of Rs. 242 million in

the exports of "Watches and clocks" (+48.7%), Rs. 866 million in "Textile yarn, fabrics, made up articles" (+42.3%), Rs. 57 million in "Optical goods" (+28.2%), Rs 19 million in "Toys, games and sporting goods" (+10.4%) and Rs. 21 million in "Fish and fish preparations" (+0.3%) were registered compared to the corresponding period of 2010. Other details of EOE exports by section are shown in Table 1.13.

The United Kingdom (UK), France and the United States of America (USA) remain the principal EOE markets, accounting for Rs. 26,283 million or around 58% of total exports. Compared to the corresponding period of 2010, exports to USA increased by Rs. 466 million or (+8.0%), to France by Rs. 240 million or (+3.0%) and to UK by Rs. 109 million or (+0.9%). Exports to the Republic of South Africa went up by 46.1% from Rs. 3,156 million to Rs. 4,611 million and that to the Malagasy Republic 26.8% from Rs. 1,614 million to Rs. 2,047 million (Table 1.15).

## 4.2.2 Imports

EOE imports in 2011 amounted to Rs. 26,979 million compared to Rs. 23,007 million for the corresponding period of 2010, representing an increase of Rs. 3,972 million or 17.3% (Table1.14).

Imports of raw materials increased by Rs. 3,874 million (+17.5%) from Rs. 22,081 million to Rs. 25,955 million and those of machinery and equipment by Rs. 98 million (+10.6%) from Rs. 926 million to Rs. 1024 million (Table 1.12).

# 4.2.3 Balance of Visible Trade

Net exports, i.e. exports minus imports, amounted to Rs. 18,006 million in 2011 and its ratio to total exports works out to around 40% compared to 45% in 2010 (Table 1.12).

It is to be noted that the above figures do not include transactions of the EOE with the Freeport. EOE sales to the Freeport are considered as local sales. It was valued at Rs. 465 million in 2011 compared to Rs. 858 million in 2010. These sales are included in exports of Freeport, as and when the goods leave the country.
