

External Trade – 2nd Quarter 2013

1. Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents external trade statistics for the first and second quarters of 2013 and for the years 2011 and 2012. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus while revised figures for 2011 are published in this indicator, those for 2012 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

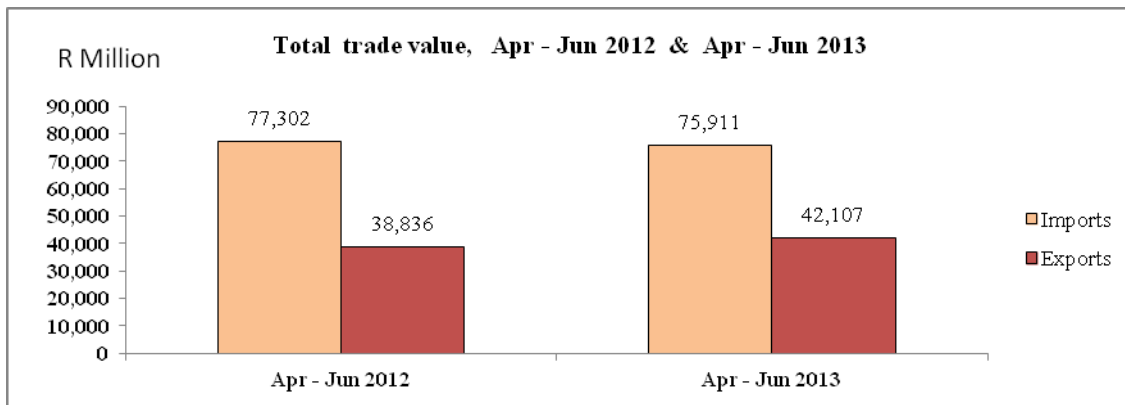
Data on international trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius. It is estimated that for the second quarter of 2013 some 20% of freeport exports were sourced locally.

2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total international trade for the second quarter of 2013 was valued at R 60,386 million. It is higher by 4.8% when compared to the previous quarter and slightly lower by 0.7% when compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012.

During the second quarter of 2013, total exports stood at R 21,746 million against imports of R 38,640 million. The resulting trade deficit for the second quarter of 2013 worked out to R 16,894 million; 0.1% lower than the previous quarter and 15.2 % lower compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012.



3. Exports

3.1 Total exports (2nd Quarter 2013)

Total export proceeds, (including domestic exports¹, re-exports² and ships' stores and bunkers) for the second quarter of 2013 amounted to R 21,746 million, showing an increase of 6.8% compared to the previous quarter. This increase is mainly explained by rises in the exports of 'Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material' (+19.7%), "Ship's stores and bunkers" (+8.3%), " Chemicals & related products" (+17.8%), "Fish & fish preparations" (+8.0%), "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" (+7.6%) partly offset by a decrease in "Cane sugar" (-3.3%).

Compared the corresponding quarter of 2012, total exports for second quarter rose by 6.4%, mainly explained by increases in exports of "Cane sugar (+45.5%), " Chemicals & related products" (+21.0%), 'Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material' (+16.1%) and "Fish & fish preparations" (+10.2%) partly offset by a drop in "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (-5.9%).

Domestic exports, which accounted for 69.1% of total exports, went up by 9.0% from R 13,799 million in the previous quarter to R 15,036 million in the second quarter of 2013. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012, domestic exports were higher by 9.4% for the second quarter of 2013. Re-exports for the second quarter of 2013 stood at R 2,517 million, lower by 6.5% and 21.1% compared to the previous quarter of 2013 and the corresponding quarter of 2012 respectively.

Total exports for the first semester of 2013 were R 42,107 million, showing an increase of 8.4% over the first semester of 2012. During this period of 2013, 33.1% of exports consisted of articles of apparel and clothing accessories (R 11,267 million), 20.8% of "fish and fish preparations" (R 7,092 million) and 14.6% of sugar (R 4,962 million).

3.2 Exports by SITC section (Table 3) - First semester 2013

Exports of "Food and live animals" for the first semester of 2013 amounted to R 13,442 million, showing an increase of 17.7% over the first semester of 2012. This is mostly explained by increases in exports of "Cane sugar" and "Fish and fish preparations" which went up by 36.4% and 13.6% respectively.

For the first semester of 2013, exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" were valued at R 3,355 million, showing an increase of 9.9% when compared to exports of R 3,053 million for the first six months of 2012. The 9.9% increase is explained by higher exports of "Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones" (+42.7%) and "Textile yarn, fabrics, made-up articles" (+16.4%) .

Export proceeds for the first semester of 2013 from "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" decreased by 6.1% compared to the corresponding period of 2012 from R 14,942 million to R 14,027 million. Exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories", representing 80.3% of exports of this section decreased by 4.6% compared to the first semester of 2012.

¹ Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin

² Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

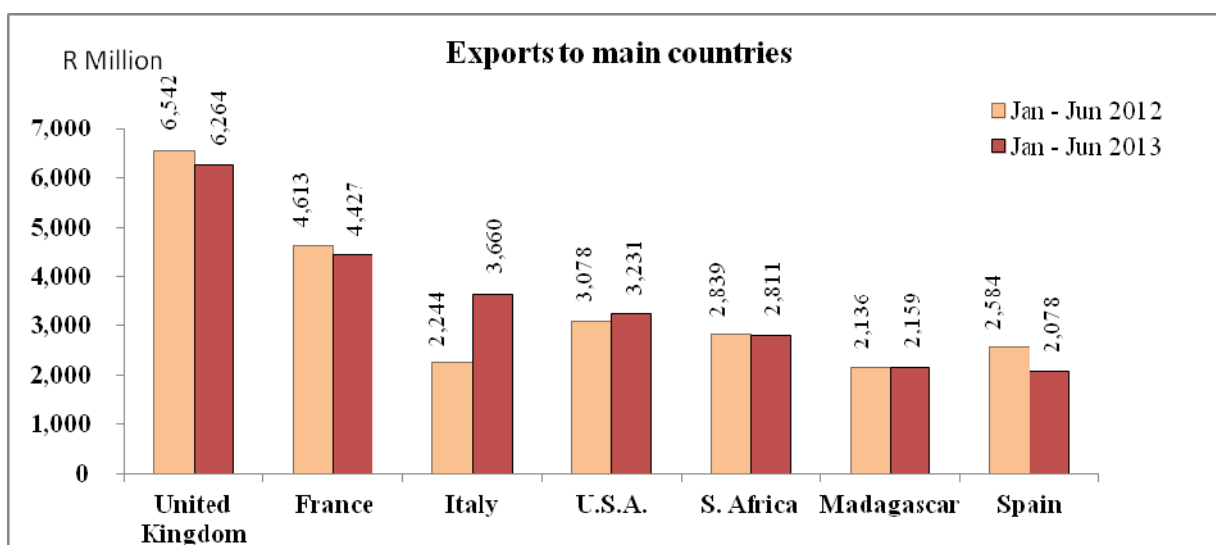
3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) - First semester 2013

During the first semester of 2013, exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) amounted to R 23,017 million showing an increase of 2.3% compared to the corresponding period of 2012 (Table 1). Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of Economic and Social Indicators on EOE, to be released on 23 September 2013.

3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) - First semester 2013

Analysis of export figures by country of destination for the first semester of 2013 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 60.6% of our exports for a value of R 20,634 million. The United Kingdom remained our main market with R 6,264 million, or 18.4% of total exports. The other major destinations for our exports were France (13.0%), Italy (10.8%), U.S.A (9.5%), South Africa (8.3%), Madagascar (6.3%) and Spain (6.1%).

Compared to the first six months of 2012, total exports to Italy and U.S.A went up by 63.1% and 5.0% respectively while exports to Spain, UK and France fell by 19.6%, 4.2% and 4.0% respectively.



4. Imports

4.1 Total imports - (2nd Quarter 2013)

Total imports for the second quarter of 2013 reached R 38,640 million, showing an increase of 3.7% and a decrease of 4.2% compared to the previous quarter of 2013 and the corresponding quarter of 2012 respectively.

Around 24.4% of imports comprised of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (R 18,555 million), 17.2% of “Machinery and transport equipment” (R 13,070 million) and 17.1% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” (R 12,993 million).

The increase in imports over the previous quarter is mainly due to rise in imports of “Machinery & equipments (+24.8%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+23.0%) and

“Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (+13.3%) partly offset by a decrease of 13.8% in “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials”.

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2012, imports in the second quarter of 2013 declined due to decreases in imports of “Machinery & equipments” (-14.7%), “Mineral fuels, lubricants & related products” (-7.6%) and “Food and live animals” (-2.6%).

4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) - First semester 2013

Total imports for the first semester of 2013 which amounted to R 75,911 million, decreased by 1.8 % over the corresponding semester of 2012.

Imports of “Food and live animals” for the first semester of 2013 were valued at R 14,482 million, higher by 6.7 % compared to the corresponding period of last year. Main increases were noted in imports of “Fruits and vegetables” (+21.0%), “Fish and fish preparations” (+16.1%), and “Cereals preparations” (+13.8%).

The import bill of “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” stood at R 18,555 million, representing an increase of 2.4% over the corresponding semester of last year.

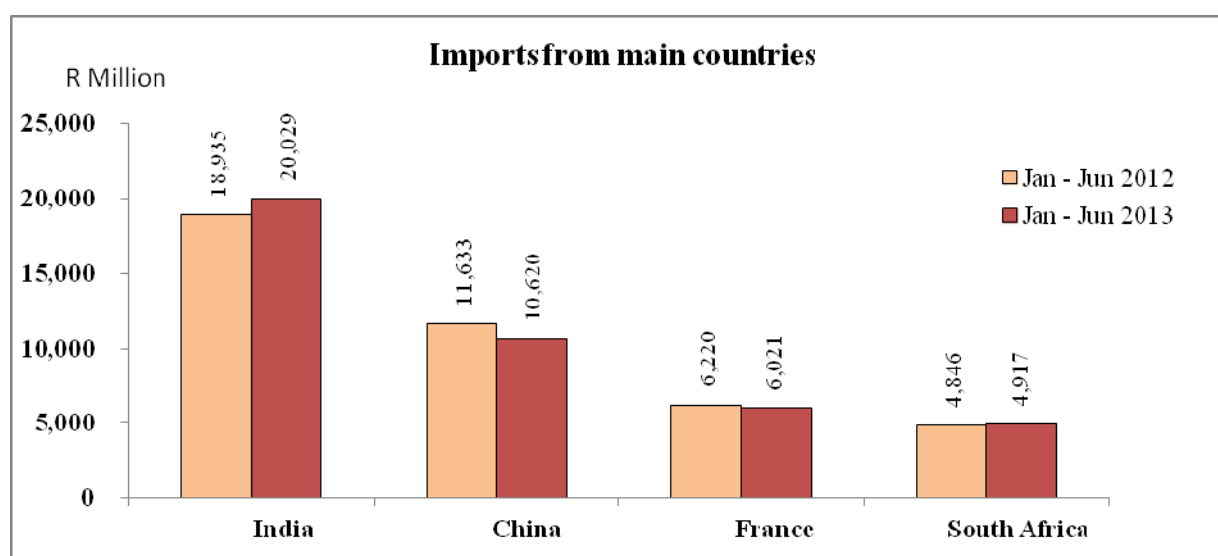
Imports of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” for the first semester rose slightly by 0.9% to R 12,993 million. Increases were noted in imports of “Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones” (+43.0%), “Cotton fabrics” (+20.1%), “Textile yarn” (+13.7%) and “Paper, paperboard & articles thereof ” (+9.4%).

For the first semester of 2013, imports of “Machinery & transport equipment” which were valued at R 13,070 million decreased by 22.4% compared to the same period of last year.

4.3 Imports by country of origin (Table 13) – First semester 2013

During the first semester of 2013, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier representing 55.9% of total imports, amounted to R 42,403 million.

Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (26.4%), China (14.0%), France (7.9%) and South Africa (6.5%). India is our main supplier for petroleum products (Table 13).



5. Trade with Regional Organisations (Tables 14 -16) – First semester 2013

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first semester of 2013 stood at R 6,184 million, against imports of R 7,995 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to R 1,811 million.

During the first semester of 2013, our exports to COMESA countries attained R 3,068 million while imports from these countries amounted to R 2,600 million resulting in a favourable trade balance of R 468 million for Mauritius. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 70.3%. Our main suppliers were Seychelles (27.7%) and Kenya (25.6%) (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the first semester of 2013 showed a deficit of R 1,259 million, resulting from imports of a value of R 6,839 million and exports worth R 5,580 million. The main supplier was South Africa (71.9%) and our main buyers were South Africa (50.4%) and Madagascar (38.7%) (Table 16).

6. Trade in Freeport Zone - First semester 2013

During the first semester of 2013, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at R 3,516 million, lower by 30.4% compared to the corresponding period of last year (R 5,051 million). The main items imported through the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Machinery and transport equipment” and “Chemicals & related products”. (Table 12).

Re-exports to overseas markets valued at R 3,360 million, decreased by 6.6% when compared to the first semester of 2012 (R 3,598 million). The main items re-exported by the Freeport were “Fish and fish preparations”, “Chemicals & related products” and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (Table 6).

7. Forecast 2013

Based on recent past trends and indicative information from various sources, total exports (including ship’s stores & bunkers) for the year 2013 are expected to be of the order of R 87,000 million against R 175,000 million for imports. The trade deficit would be around R 88,000 million.

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Notes

(1) Coverage

Trade figures are compiled according to the **General Trade System** as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

- Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses
- Exports cover domestic exports and re-exports which include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses. Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin. Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.
- Ships stores and bunkers are included in total exports and are shown separately.
- Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free On Board) basis.

C.I.F. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her imports of merchandise, other goods, etc. including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft etc. unless it is borne by the carrier.

F.O.B. value is the value in the market at the Customs frontier of a country of her exports of merchandise and other goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the Customs frontier, export duties and the cost of loading the goods on to the carrier unless the latter cost is borne by the carrier.

(3) Classification

(i) Commodity Code

Commodities are coded according to the Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2012). However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) or SITC Rev. 4. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
