

## External Merchandise Trade Statistics – 3rd Quarter 2015

### 1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external merchandise trade statistics for the first three quarters of 2015 and for the years 2013 and 2014. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are at times revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department.

Thus, while revised figures for 2013 and 2014 are published in this indicator, those for 2015 are provisional and subject to revision as and when MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

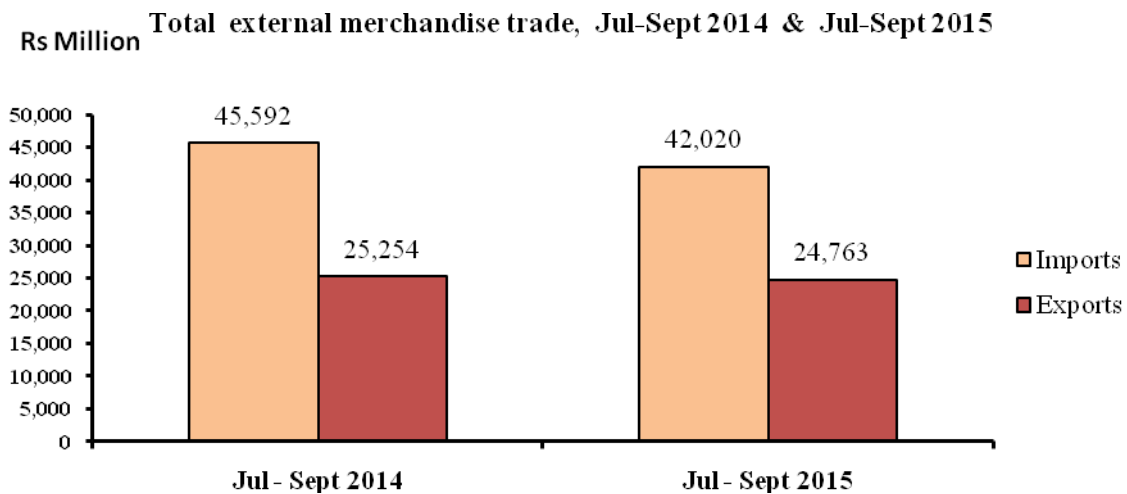
Data on external merchandise trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

It is to be noted that all exports of the Freeport are included in re-exports of Mauritius. It is estimated that for the third quarter of 2015 some 6% of Freeport exports were sourced locally.

### 2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total external merchandise trade for the third quarter of 2015 was valued at Rs 66,783 million, i.e. 1.9% lower than the previous quarter and 5.7% lower compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014.

During the third quarter of 2015, total exports were valued at Rs 24,763 million against imports of Rs 42,020 million. The resulting trade deficit worked out to Rs 17,257 million, 2.2% lower than the deficit of Rs 17,640 million of the previous quarter and 15.1% lower than the deficit of Rs 20,338 million of the corresponding quarter.



### 3. Exports

#### 3.1 Total exports (Tables 1 & 3) – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2015

Total export proceeds for the third quarter of 2015, including domestic exports<sup>1</sup>, re-exports<sup>2</sup> and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to Rs 24,763 million, showing a decrease of 1.8% compared to the previous quarter. This is mainly explained by decreases in the exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" (-25.3%), "Manufactured goods classified by materials" (-12.8%) and "Ships' stores & bunkers" (-4.3%), partly offset by increases in exports of "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (+11.6%) and "Food & live animals" (+5.0%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014, total exports for the third quarter of 2015 declined by 1.9%. This is mainly explained by decreases in "Ships' stores & bunkers" (-33.9%), "Machinery and transport equipment" (-18.4%), "Chemicals & related products" (-9.1%), partly offset by increases in "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (+17.8%) and "Manufactured goods classified by materials" (+6.1%).

Domestic exports, which accounted for 63.5% of total exports, increased by 3.1% from Rs 15,260 million in the previous quarter to Rs 15,727 million in the third quarter of 2015. Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014, domestic exports were higher by 6.1%.

In the third quarter of 2015, re-exports stood at Rs 6,836 million, i.e. lower by 10.7% compared to the previous quarter and by 3.8% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014. This is mainly due to decreases in the re-exports of "Telecommunications equipment & accessories" by 39.1% compared to the previous quarter and by 36.7% compared to the corresponding quarter.

#### 3.2 Exports by SITC section (Tables 1 & 3) – Jan to Sept 2015

Around 33.3% of total exports in the first nine months of 2015 consisted of "Miscellaneous manufactured goods" (Rs 24,238 million), 25.7% of "Food and live animals" (Rs 18,657 million) and 17.0% of "Machinery and transport equipment" (Rs 12,332 million). Compared to the first nine months of 2014, total exports rose by 3.6%. The main sections changed as follows:

"Machinery and transport equipment" increased by 59.4%, due to an increase in the re-exports of "Telecommunications equipment & accessories" (+61.9%).

"Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material", valued at Rs 6,831 million, rose by 9.4 %, mainly explained by higher exports of "Pearls, precious and semi-precious stones" (+23.9%)".

"Miscellaneous manufactured goods" went up by 6.2% due to rise in the exports of "Articles of apparel & clothing accessories" (+5.5%).

"Food and live animals" showed a decrease of 3.3%. Within the section, exports of "Live Primates", "Cane Sugar" and "Fish and fish preparations" fell by 10.1%, 9.3% and 3.8% respectively.

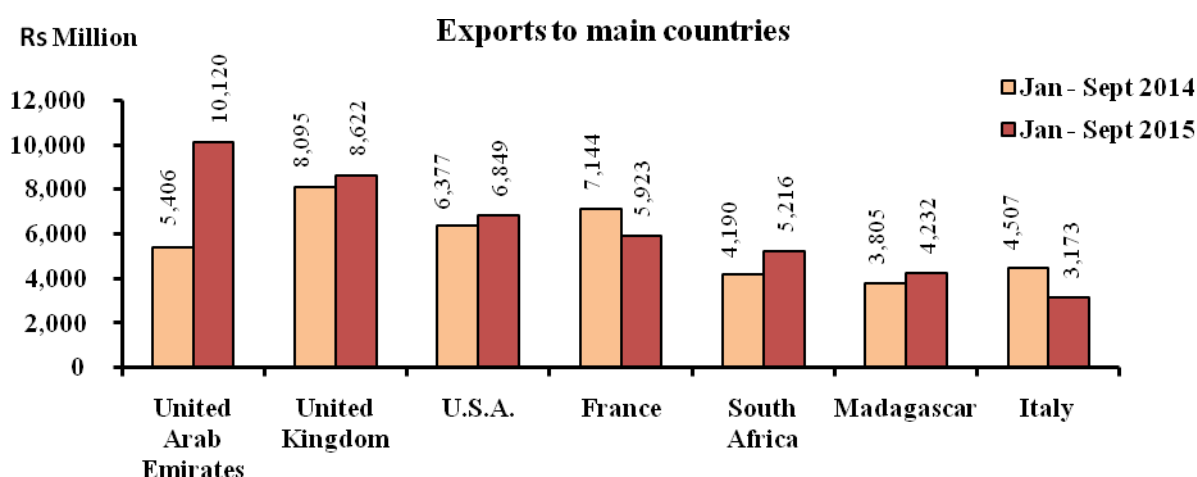
### 3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) – Jan to Sept 2015

During the first nine months of 2015, exports of EOE amounted to Rs 37,163 million, compared to Rs 37,131 million in the corresponding period of 2014 (Table 1). Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 22 December 2015.

### 3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) – Jan to Sept 2015

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the first nine months of 2015 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 41.6% of our exports for a value of Rs 27,465 million. The major destinations for our exports were U.A.E (15.3%), U.K (13.1%), U.S.A (10.4%), France (9.0%), South Africa (7.9%), Madagascar (6.4%) and Italy (4.8%).

Compared to corresponding period of 2014, total exports to U.A.E went up by 87.2% comprising mainly re-exports of “Telecommunication equipment and accessories”. Exports to South Africa, Madagascar, U.S.A and United Kingdom went up by 24.5%, 11.2%, 7.4% and 6.5% respectively. On the other hand, exports to Italy and France fell by 29.6% and 17.1% respectively.



## 4. Imports

### 4.1 Total imports (Table 10) – 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2015

Total imports for the third quarter of 2015 amounted to Rs 42,020 million, showing a decrease of 1.9% over the previous quarter. This is mainly due to decreases in imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (-16.2%) and “Machinery and transport equipment” (-12.6%), partly offset by an increase of 13.7% in “Food and live animals”.

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2014, imports in the third quarter of 2015 fell by 7.8%. This decline is mainly due to decreases in imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related products” (-32.8%) and “Machinery and transport equipment” (-18.2%), partly offset by increases in the imports of “Chemicals & related products” (+9.7%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” (+6.9%) and “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (+5.7%).

## 4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) – Jan to Sept 2015

Around 25.2% of imports in the first nine months of 2015 consisted of “Machinery and transport equipment” (Rs 31,133 million), 18.9% of “Food and live animals” (Rs 23,333 million), 18.2% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by materials” (Rs 22,532 million) and 15.5% of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (Rs 19,176 million). Compared to the first nine months of 2014, total imports increased by 0.5%, changes of the main sections are as follows:

“Food and live animals” increased by 3.3%, due to higher imports of “Vegetable and fruits” (+18.8%) and “Meat and meat preparations” (+17.1%), partly offset by decreases in “Dairy products and bird’s eggs” (-14.3%) and “Fish and fish preparations” (-5.8%).

“Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” decreased by 24.3%, mainly due to a drop of 29.1% in the imports of “Refined petroleum products”.

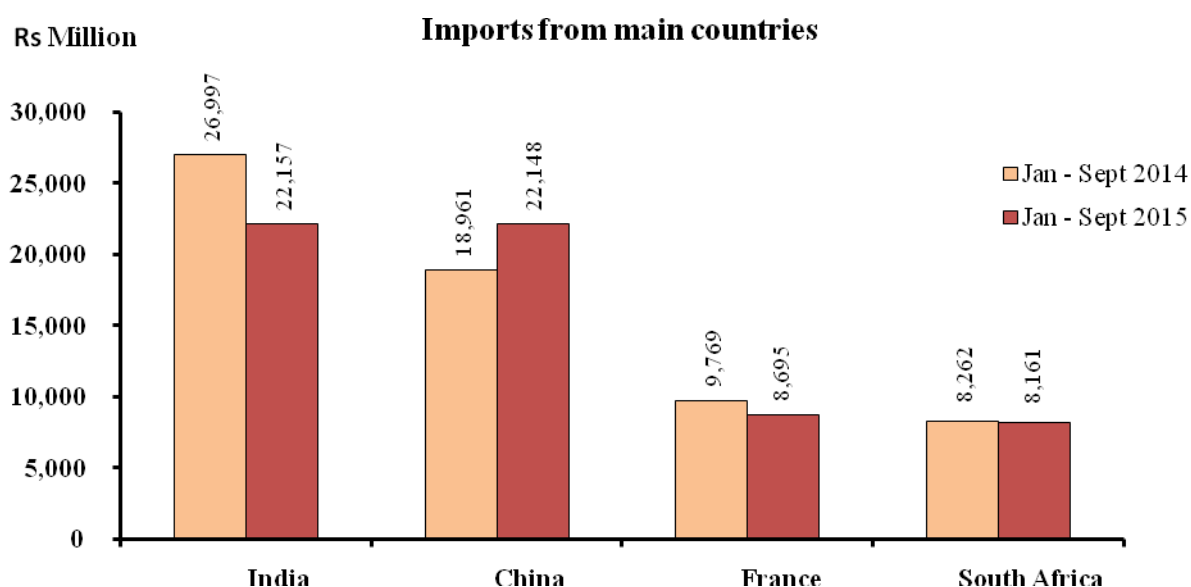
“Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” rose by 12.3%, mainly due to increases in the imports of “Iron and steel” (+47.3%), “Cotton fabrics” (+16.7%) and “Pearls & precious stones” (+13.5%).

“Machinery & transport equipment” increased by 9.6%, mainly due to an increase in imports of “Telecommunications & other equipment” (+32.8%).

## 4.3 Imports by country of origin – Jan to Sept 2015

During the first nine months of 2015, imports from the Asian continent, our major supplier, amounted to Rs 69,847 million, representing 56.4% of total imports. Our imports originated mainly from the following countries: India (17.9%), China (17.9%), France (7.0%) and South Africa (6.6%) - (Table 13).

Compared to the corresponding period of 2014, total imports from China rose by 16.8% while those from India and France declined by 17.9% and 11.0% respectively.



## 5. Trade with Regional Organisations – Jan to Sept 2015

Total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States during the first nine months of 2015 stood at Rs 11,920 million against imports of Rs 13,564 million (Table 14). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 1,644 million.

During the first nine months of 2015, exports to COMESA member states attained Rs 6,040 million while imports from these countries amounted to Rs 4,489 million, resulting in a trade surplus of Rs 1,551 million. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 70.1%. Our main suppliers were Seychelles (29.1%) and Madagascar (27.1%) - (Table 15).

Trade with SADC countries for the first nine months of 2015 showed a deficit of Rs 1,237 million, resulting from imports value of Rs 11,808 million against exports worth Rs 10,571 million. The main supplier was South Africa (69.1%) and our main buyers were South Africa (49.3%) and Madagascar (40.0%) - (Table 16).

## 6. Trade in Freeport Zone – Jan to Sept 2015

During the first nine months of 2015, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 17,846 million, higher by 44.5% compared to the corresponding period of 2014 – (Table 12). Re-exports to overseas market were valued at Rs 18,026 million, representing an increase of 39.2% over the same period of 2014 (Table 6). The main item imported and re-exported was “Telecommunications equipment & accessories”.

## 7. Forecast 2015

Based on data for the first nine months, total exports for 2015 would be around Rs 97,000 million and imports Rs 176,000 million. Trade deficit for 2015 is therefore expected to be around Rs 79,000 million.

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## Notes

### (1) Scope and coverage

**External merchandise trade statistics** are compiled according to the General Trade System as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

**Imports** include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses.

**Exports** cover:

- Domestic exports defined as goods of national origin, that is goods produced in the exporting country.
- Re-exports which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged and include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses.
- Ship's Stores and Bunkers (SSB) are included in total exports and are shown separately.

Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports.

### (2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free on Board) basis.

Cost, Insurance and Freight (C.I.F) value is the value of a country's imports of goods, including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft unless it is borne by the carrier.

Free on Board (F.O.B) value is the value of a country's exports of goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the customs frontier, export duties.

### (3) Classification of commodities

Commodities are coded according to the **Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS2012)**. However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to **the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) (SITC Rev. 4)**. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six and five digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
