

Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) 3rd Quarter 2016

1. Introduction

This issue of “Economic and Social Indicators” (ESI) presents the results of the Quarterly Survey of Employment among Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE), conducted by Statistics Mauritius at the end of September 2016.

It also includes provisional figures on EOE imports and exports for the 3rd quarter of 2016 as well as figures for the years 2014 and 2015. Table 1 shows the main indicators of the EOE sector for the period 2007 to 2015.

EOE consist of enterprises formerly holding an EPZ certificate as well as enterprises manufacturing goods for export and holding a registration certificate issued by the Board of Investment.

2. Employment

2.1 Employment – 3rd Quarter 2016

Compared to the second quarter of 2016, employment in EOE decreased by 200 (-0.4%) from 52,593 to 52,393. Male employment increased by 173 to reach 25,579 and female employment decreased by 373 from 27,187 to 26,814 (Table 2).

The number of Mauritians employed in the EOE sector went down by 277 (-0.9%) from 29,880 to 29,603 whereas the number of foreign workers increased by 77 (+0.3%) from 22,713 at the end of June 2016 to 22,790 at the end of September 2016 (Tables 2 and 5).

The decrease of 200 in employment during the third quarter of 2016 is the net result of 774 job losses and creation of 574 new jobs in existing enterprises.

2.2 Evolution of employment from September 2015 to September 2016

From September 2015 to September 2016, total employment in EOE decreased by 1,495 (-2.8%) from 53,888 to 52,393. The number of Mauritian workers decreased by 1,607 (-382 males and -1,225 females). Employment of foreign workers increased by 112 (+561 males and -449 females) (Tables 2 and 5).

Job losses occurred mainly in enterprises engaged in the manufacture of “Textile yarn and fabrics” and “Pullovers” with decreases of 1,358 and 462 jobs respectively. On the other hand, new jobs were created mainly in “Other garments” with an increase of 1,024 jobs.

Details of changes in employment by product group are given in tables 3, 4 and 5.

3. Exports and Imports

Statistics on imports and exports are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are, at times, revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department. Thus, while figures for 2014 and 2015 are final, those for 1st quarter, 2nd quarter and 3rd quarter 2016 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

3.1 Exports and Imports – 3rd Quarter 2016

3.1.1 Exports (f.o.b)

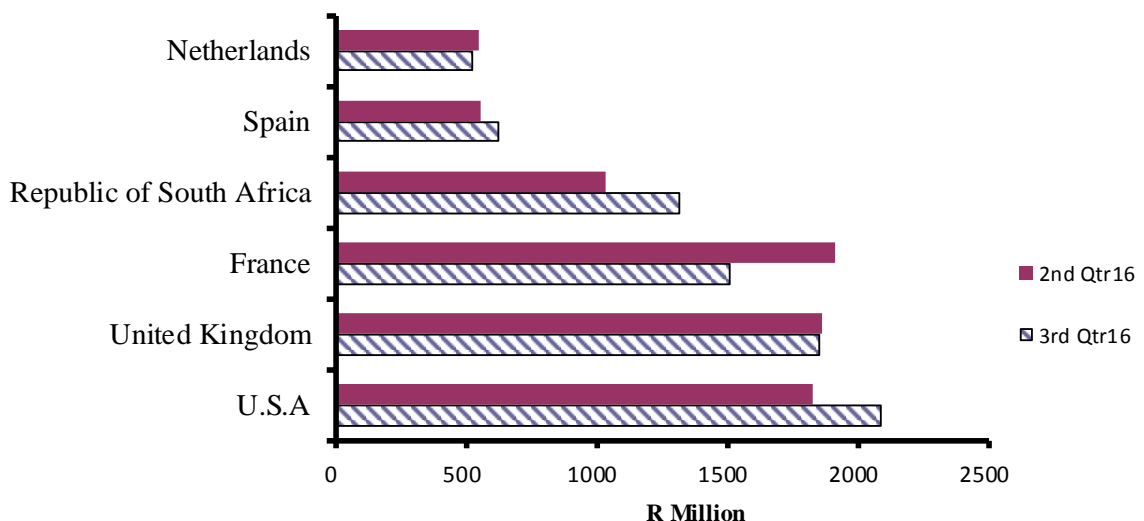
Provisional figures show that EOE exports during the 3rd quarter of 2016 amounted to R 11,178 million, that is, R 515 million (-4.4%) lower compared to the second quarter of 2016 (Table 6). That was mainly the result of decreases of R 214 million (-26.9%) in the exports of “Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones” and R 213 million (-48.5%) in “Jewellery, goldsmiths & silversmiths wares”, partly offset by an increase of R 423 million (+7.9%) in “Articles of apparel and clothing”.

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2015, EOE exports decreased by R 1,443 million (-11.4%).

Details on EOE exports by section are given in Table 7.

United States of America (USA), United Kingdom (UK) and France remain the principal EOE markets, together accounting for R 5,443 million (48.7%) of total EOE exports. The Republic of South Africa, Spain and Netherlands are among the other main destinations of EOE exports (Table 9).

Compared to the previous quarter, main changes in exports were as follows:

Exports went down for:

- France by R 404 million (-21.2%) and;
- Italy by R 251 million (-36.7%)

Exports went up for:

- Republic of South Africa by R 279 million (+27.0%); and
- U.S.A by R 266 million (+14.6%).

Further details are given in Table 9.

3.1.2 Imports (c.i.f)

EOE imports during the 3rd quarter of 2016 were estimated at R 6,285 million, representing a decrease of R 561 million (-8.2%) compared to the second quarter of 2016 (Table 6). This decrease is due to lower imports of raw materials by R 627 million (-9.6%), partly offset by an increase of R 66 million (+23.5%) in imports of machinery.

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2015, imports decreased by R 357 million (-5.4%), mainly due to falls in imports of “Pearls, precious and semi-precious stones” by R 321 million (-34.1 %) and “Cotton” by R 145 million (-34.5%), partly offset by an increase in imports of “Fish and fish preparations” of R 263 million (+18.8%). Details on EOE imports by section are given in Table 8.

3.1.3 Net exports

Net exports, i.e. exports minus imports, amounted to R 4,893 million in the third quarter of 2016 and its ratio to total exports worked out to 43.8% compared to 47.4% in the corresponding quarter of 2015 (Table 6).

It is to be noted that the above exports and imports figures do not include transactions of the EOE with the Freeport. EOE sales to the Freeport considered as local sales were valued at R 84 million in the third quarter of 2016 compared to R 60 million in the third quarter of 2015. These sales are included in exports of Freeport, as and when the goods leave the country.
