## Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2017

## 1. Introduction

This issue of "Economic and Social Indicators" (ESI) presents the results of the Quarterly Survey of Employment among Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE), conducted by Statistics Mauritius at the end of March 2017.

It also includes provisional figures on EOE imports and exports for the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter of 2017 as well as figures for the years 2015 and 2016. Table 1 shows the main indicators of the EOE sector for the period 2008 to 2016.

EOE consist of enterprises formerly holding an EPZ certificate as well as enterprises manufacturing goods for export and holding a registration certificate issued by the Board of Investment.

## 2. Employment

## 2.1 Employment – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2017

Compared to the fourth quarter of 2016, employment in EOE decreased by 357 (-0.7%) from 52,311 to 51,954. Male employment decreased by 88 from 25,642 to 25,554 and female employment decreased by 269 from 26,669 to 26,400 (Table 2).

The number of Mauritians employed in the EOE sector went up by 11 from 29,493 to 29,504 whereas the number of foreign workers decreased by 368 (-1.6%) from 22,818 at the end of December 2016 to 22,450 at the end of March 2017 (Table 2).

The decrease of 357 in employment during the first quarter of 2017 is the net result of 1,094 job losses and creation of 737 new jobs in existing enterprises.

## 2.2 Evolution of employment from March 2016 to March 2017

From March 2016 to March 2017, total employment in EOE decreased by 772 (-1.5%) from 52,726 to 51,954. The number of Mauritian workers decreased by 471 (-304 males and -167 females). Employment of foreign workers decreased by 301 (+506 males and -807 females) (Tables 2 and 5).

Job losses occurred mainly in enterprises engaged in the manufacture of "Wearing Apparel" with decrease of 345 jobs. On the other hand, new jobs were created mainly in "Food" with an increase of 108 jobs.

Details of employment by product group and sex are given in Table 3 whereas changes in employment by product group are given in Table 4.

## **3.** Exports and Imports

Statistics on imports and exports are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are, at times, revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department. Thus, while figures for 2015 are final, those for 2016 and 1<sup>st</sup> quarter 2017 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

## 3.1 Exports and Imports – 1<sup>st</sup> Quarter 2017

### 3.1.1 Exports (f.o.b)

Provisional figures show that EOE exports during the  $1^{st}$  quarter of 2017 amounted to R 9,397 million, that is, R 1,801 million (-16.1%) lower compared to the fourth quarter of 2016 (Table 6). That was mainly the result of decreases of R 1,166 million (-21.6%) in the exports of "Articles of apparel and clothing" and R 585 million (-20.7%) in "Fish and fish preparations", partly offset by an increase of R 122 million (+17.2%) in "Textile yarn, fabrics, made up articles".

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2016, EOE exports decreased by R 1,131 million (-10.7%).

Details on EOE exports by section are given in Table 7.

United Kingdom (UK), France and United States of America (USA) and the republic of South Africa remain the principal EOE markets, together accounting for R 5,096 million (54.2%) of total EOE exports. Italy, Madagascar, Spain and Netherlands are among the other main destinations of EOE exports (Table 9). The table below highlights the changes in our main EOE exports markets.

### EOE exports by main country of destination

Compared to the previous quarter, EOE exports to all our main markets showed decreases: United Kingdom (-22.6%), France (-14.5%), USA (-22.5%), South Africa (-18.0%), Italy (-24.8%), Madagascar (-0.8%), Spain (-13.8%) and Netherlands (-30.3%).

When compared to the first quarter of 2016, decreases were observed for: United Kingdom (-22.4%), France (-5.7%), USA (-25.4%), South Africa (-24.8%), Italy (-28.5%) and Madagascar (-14.8%). On the other hand, increases were noted for Spain (+59.9%) and Netherlands (+33.2%).

Further details are given in Table 9.

### 3.1.2 Imports (c.i.f)

EOE imports during the  $1^{st}$  quarter of 2017 were estimated at R 5,778 million, representing a decrease of R 349 million (-5.7%) compared to the fourth quarter of 2016 (Table 8). This decrease is mainly due to lower imports of raw materials by R 401 million (-6.9%) and partly offset by higher imports of machinery by R 52 million (+16.7%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2016, imports decreased by R 645 million (-10.0%), mainly due to falls in imports of "Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones" by R 258 million (-33.0%) and "Textile yarn and fabrics" by R 226 million (-17.3 %), partly offset by an increase in imports of "Fish and fish preparations" of R 203 million (+14.8%). Details on EOE imports by section are given in Table 8.

### 3.1.3 Net exports

Net exports, i.e. exports minus imports, amounted to R 3,619 million in the first quarter of 2017 and its ratio to total exports worked out to 38.5% compared to 39.0% in the corresponding quarter of 2016 (Table 6).

It is to be noted that the above exports and imports figures do not include transactions of the EOE with the Freeport. EOE sales to the Freeport, considered as local sales, were valued at R 61 million in the first quarter of 2017 compared to R 91 million in the first quarter of 2016. These sales are included in exports of Freeport, as and when the goods leave the country.
