# AGRICULTURAL AND FISH PRODUCTION

(January-June 2017)

### Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents data on agricultural and fish production for the Island of Mauritius for the first six months of 2017, as well as revised figures for year 2016. Table 1 shows area harvested and production in respect of the main agricultural crops while Table 2 shows production of the main agro-industrial products. Details on the sugar industry and food crops are given in Tables 3 and 5 respectively.

### 2. Sugar cane

At the end of June 2017 some 2,643 hectares under sugar cane were harvested, yielding 197,192 tonnes of sugar cane and 16,454 tonnes of sugar. The corresponding figures for the same period in 2016 were 3,745 hectares, 313,894 tonnes of sugar cane and 27,100 tonnes of sugar respectively. The average extraction rate as at end of June 2017 was 8.34% compared to 8.63% as at end of June 2016.

According to the Mauritius Chamber of Agriculture, production of sugar for the crop year 2017 will be around 350,000 tonnes, representing a decrease of 9.4% compared to 386,277 tonnes in 2016.

#### 3. Tea

At the end of June 2017, area under tea plantation was 622 hectares same as the figure for the corresponding period of 2016. The production of green tea leaves went up by 2.6%: 4,279 tonnes in first semester of 2017 as compared to 4,171 tonnes during the same period of 2016.

The production of manufactured tea increased by 4.4% from 781 tonnes in the first semester of 2016 to 815 tonnes in the same period of 2017. Further details on tea production are given in Table 4.

## 4. Food crops

Data on food crops (except paddy rice) production, are supplied by the Food and Agricultural Research and Extension Institute (FAREI). Figures are thereafter adjusted to take into account backyard production of banana, eddoes, manioc and sweet potato. Data on paddy rice was obtained from concerned establishment.

A total area of 3,332 hectares under food crops was harvested in the first semester of 2017 and the production was estimated at 41,989 tonnes. It is to be noted that area under rice cultivation harvested declined by 65.8% from 161 hectares in the first semester of 2016 to 55 hectares in the same period of 2017. The production of paddy rice went down by 55.7% from 352 tonnes to 156 tonnes during the same period.

#### 5. Livestock

Data on production of beef, goat meat, mutton and pork are supplied by the Mauritius Meat Authority. It is to be noted that these data represent only animals slaughtered by the Central Abattoir, including live animals imported from Rodrigues and other countries for slaughter.

During the first half of 2017, the production of beef from live cattle was 1,173 tonnes, as compared to 1,038 tonnes registered in the corresponding period of 2016. Beef production from the slaughter of imported cattle, accounting for 99.5% of the total production, increased by 16.9% from 998 tonnes to 1,167 tonnes. Local beef production went down by 85.0% from 40 tonnes to 6 tonnes.

The production of goat meat and mutton was 26 tonnes in 2017 same as in 2016. The share of local production, inclusive of Rodrigues stood at 88.5 %.

The production of pork decreased by 2.0% from 294 tonnes in the first semester of 2016 to 288 tonnes during the same period of 2017.

## 6. Poultry

The production of poultry increased by 2.2% from 23,000 tonnes in the first semester of 2016 to 23,500 tonnes during the same period of 2017.

### 7. Fish

Total fish production went up by 27.0% from 8,373 tonnes in the first six months of 2016 to 10,631 tonnes in the same period of 2017. This increase was attributable to an increase of 31.3% in the production of other catch (tuna, bank etc) from 7,422 tonnes to 9,747 tonnes in 2017, partly offset by a decrease of 7.0% in the production of fresh coastal fish catch from 951 tonnes in the first semester of 2016 to 884 tonnes during the same period of 2017.
