AGRICULTURAL AND FISH PRODUCTION

Year 2017

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents data on agricultural and fish production for the Island of Mauritius for year 2017, as well as revised figures for year 2016. Table 1 shows area harvested and production in respect of the main agricultural crops, while Table 2 shows production of the main agro-industrial products. Details on the sugar industry and food crops are given in Tables 3 and 5 respectively.

2. Sugar cane

The production of sugar cane went down by 2.2% from 3,798,448 tonnes in 2016 to 3,713,331 tonnes in 2017. The area harvested decreased by 2.9% from 51,476 hectares in 2016 to 49,973 hectares in 2017. The average yield has increased by 0.7% from 73.79 tonnes per hectare in 2016 to 74.31 in 2017.

The production of sugar went down by 8.0% from 386,277 tonnes in 2016 to 355,213 tonnes in 2017. Compared to 10.18% in 2016, the average extraction rate was 9.57% in 2017, representing a decrease of 6.0% mainly due to unfavourable climatic conditions.

3. Tea

The area under tea plantation in 2017 was 622 hectares same as in 2016. The production of green tea leaves went up by 0.1% from 7,301 tonnes in 2016 to 7,309 tonnes in 2017.

Production of manufactured tea increased by 1.9% from 1,353 tonnes in 2016 to 1,379 tonnes in 2017. Further details on tea production are given in Table 4.

4. Food crops

Data on food crops (except paddy rice) production, are supplied by the Food and Agricultural Research and Extension Institute (FAREI). Figures are, thereafter, adjusted to take into account backyard production of banana, eddoes, manioc and sweet potato. Data on paddy rice was obtained from concerned establishment.

The area under foodcrops harvested increased by 0.2% from 7,766 hectares in 2016 to 7,780 hectares in 2017. Production of foodcrops increased by 0.3% from 106,271 tonnes to 106,621 tonnes in 2017. It is to be noted that area under rice cultivation harvested declined by 65.2% from 161 hectares in 2016 to 56 hectares in 2017. The production of paddy rice went down by 54.5% from 352 tonnes to 160 tonnes during the same period.

5. Livestock

Data on production of beef, goat meat, mutton and pork are supplied by the Mauritius Meat Authority. It is to be noted that these data represent only animals slaughtered by the Central Abattoir, including live animals imported from Rodrigues and other countries for slaughter.

In 2017, the production of beef from live cattle was 2,078 tonnes, which is 6.2% higher than the figure of 1,956 tonnes registered in 2016. Beef production from the slaughter of imported cattle, accounting for 95.9% of the total production, increased by 4.7% from 1,902 tonnes to 1,992 tonnes. Local beef production went up by 59.3% from 54 tonnes to 86 tonnes.

The production of goat meat and mutton went up by 33.3% from 42 tonnes in 2016 to 56 tonnes in 2017. The share of local production, inclusive of Rodrigues stood at 85.7%.

The production of pork decreased by 4.1% from 632 tonnes in 2016 to 606 tonnes in 2017.

6. Poultry

The production of poultry increased by 3.7% from 45,800 tonnes in 2016 to 47,500 tonnes in 2017.

7. Fish

Total fish production went up by 36.1% from 16,698 tonnes in 2016 to 22,732 tonnes in 2017. This increase was attributable to a rise of 40.8% in the production of other catch (tuna, bank etc) from 14,895 tonnes in 2016 to 20,974 tonnes in 2017, partly offset by a decrease of 2.6% in the production of fresh coastal fish catch from 1,804 tonnes in 2016 to 1,758 tonnes in 2017.
