AGRICULTURAL AND FISH PRODUCTION

(January-June 2019)

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents data on agricultural and fish production for the Island of Mauritius for the first six months of 2019, as well as revised figures for year 2018. Table 1 shows area harvested and production in respect of the main agricultural crops, while Table 2 shows production of the main agro-industrial products. Details on the sugar industry and food crops are given in Tables 3 and 5 respectively.

2. Sugar cane

At the end of June 2019, some 1,228 hectares under sugar cane were harvested, yielding 96,747 tonnes of sugar cane and 11,709 tonnes of sugar. The corresponding figures for the same period in 2018 were 1,658 hectares, 116,353 tonnes of sugar cane and 14,350 tonnes of sugar respectively. The average extraction rate as at end of June 2019 was 8.48%, compared to 8.89% as at end of June 2018.

According to Mauritius Chamber of Agriculture, production of sugar for the crop year 2019 will be around 325,000 tonnes, representing an increase of 0.5%, compared to 323,406 tonnes in 2018.

3. Tea

At the end of June 2019, area under tea plantation was 656 hectares same as the figure for the corresponding period of 2018. The production of green tea leaves went up by 20.2%: 4,970 tonnes in first semester of 2019 as compared to 4,136 tonnes during the same period of 2018.

The production of manufactured tea increased by 24.9% from 720 tonnes in the first semester of 2018 to 899 tonnes in the same period of 2019. Further details on tea production are given in Table 4.

4. Food crops

Data on food crops (except paddy rice) production, are supplied by the Food and Agricultural Research and Extension Institute (FAREI). Figures are thereafter adjusted to take into account backyard production of banana, eddoes, manioc and sweet potato. Data on paddy rice was obtained from concerned establishment.

The area under food crops harvested increased by 16.1% from 2,789 hectares in the first semester of 2018 to 3,238 hectares in the same period of 2019. The production of food crops increased by 35.3% from 27,965 tonnes to 37,846 tonnes during the same period. It is to be noted that area under rice cultivation harvested declined by 53.8% from 13 hectares in the first semester of 2018 to 6 hectares in the same period of 2019. However, the production of paddy rice went up by 10.5% from 19 tonnes to 21 tonnes during the same period.

5. Livestock

Data on production of beef, goat meat, mutton and pork are supplied by Mauritius Meat Authority. It is to be noted that these data represent only animals slaughtered by the Central Abattoir, including live animals imported from Rodrigues and other countries for slaughter.

During the first half of 2019, the production of beef from live cattle was 1,161 tonnes, as compared to 1,169 tonnes registered in the corresponding period of 2018. Beef production from the slaughter of imported cattle, accounting for 96.5% of the total production, decreased by 2.2% from 1,145 tonnes to 1,120 tonnes. Local beef production went up from 25 tonnes to 41 tonnes.

The production of goat meat and mutton dropped by 6.9% from 29 tonnes during the first semester of 2018 to 27 tonnes for the same period of 2019. The share of local production, inclusive of Rodrigues, stood at 44.4%.

The production of pork rose by 9.3% from 248 tonnes in the first semester of 2018 to 271 tonnes during the same period of 2019.

6. Poultry

The production of poultry increased by 2.5% from 24,000 tonnes in the first semester of 2018 to 24,600 tonnes during the same period of 2019.

7. Fish

Total fish production went up by 1.7% from 13,829 tonnes in the first six months of 2018 to 14,063 tonnes in the same period of 2019. This increase was attributable to a rise of 1.6% in the production of other catch (tuna, bank etc) from 12,977 tonnes in 2018 to 13,180 tonnes in 2018, coupled with an increase of 3.6% in the production of fresh coastal fish catch from 852 tonnes in the first semester of 2018 to 883 tonnes during the same period of 2019.
