

External Merchandise Trade Statistics – 2nd Quarter 2020

1. Introduction

This issue of Economic and Social Indicators presents external merchandise trade statistics for the first and second quarters of 2020 and the years 2019 and 2018. These statistics are compiled from declarations lodged at the Customs Department of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA), by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are usually revised at a later period and corrections are made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA).

Thus, while revised figures for 2018 are published in this indicator, those for 2019 and 2020 are still provisional and subject to revision as and when the Customs Department of the MRA submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

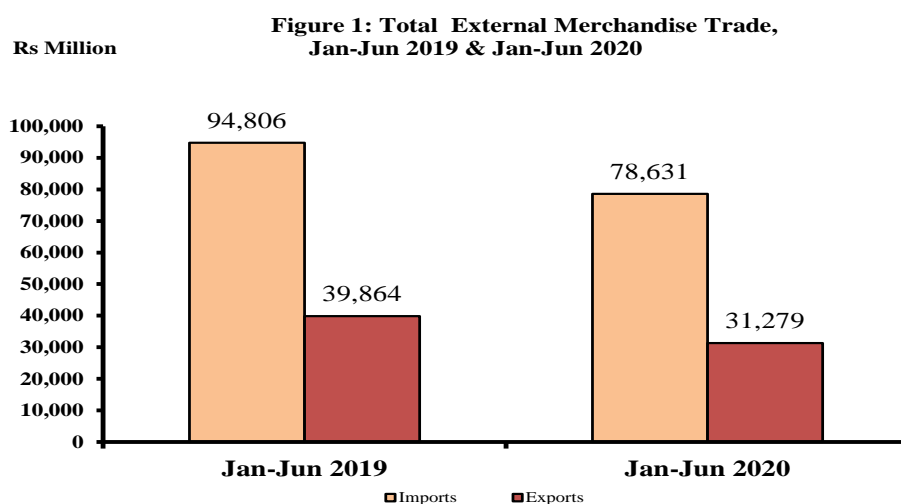
Data on external merchandise trade are compiled as per the recommendations of the United Nations General Trade System. According to this system, all goods entering and leaving the national frontier, including trading activities of the Freeport zone should be accounted for.

2. Total value of trade and trade balance

Total external merchandise trade for the second quarter of 2020 was valued at Rs 46,818 million, i.e. 25.8% lower than the value of Rs 63,092 million of the previous quarter and 32.2% lower than the value of Rs 69,032 million of the corresponding quarter of 2019.

For the second quarter of 2020, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers¹) were valued at Rs 12,279 million against total imports of Rs 34,539 million. In the previous quarter, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores and bunkers) amounted to Rs 19,000 million against total imports of Rs 44,092 million while for the corresponding quarter of 2019, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers) amounted to Rs 20,505 million against total imports of Rs 48,527 million. In the second quarter of 2020, total exports and total imports were lower by 35.4% and 21.7% respectively, compared to previous quarter while compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019, total exports and total imports went down by 40.1% and 28.8% respectively.

The resulting trade deficit for the second quarter of 2020 worked out to Rs 22,260 million, 11.3% lower than the deficit of Rs 25,092 million of the previous quarter and 20.6% lower than the deficit of Rs 28,022 million of the corresponding quarter of 2019.



¹ Ships stores and bunkers, which consist of jet fuel and victuals supplied to foreign vessels and aircraft, are included in total exports and are shown separately

From Figure 1, compared to first semester of 2019, total exports (inclusive of ship's stores & bunkers) dropped from Rs 39,864 million to Rs 31,279 million, showing a decrease of around 21.5%. A similar decreasing trend was observed in total imports for the same period. Total imports, fell by 17.1% in first semester of 2020, compared to the corresponding period. Consequently, the trade deficit for first semester of 2020 works out to around Rs 47,352 million, compared to Rs 54,942 million in the corresponding semester. An improvement of 13.8% in the balance of visible trade was observed.

3. Total Exports

3.1 Total exports (Tables 1 & 3) – 2nd Quarter & 1st Semester 2020

Total exports proceed for the second quarter of 2020, including domestic exports², re-exports³ and ship's stores and bunkers amounted to Rs 12,276 million, showing a decrease of 35.4%, compared to the previous quarter. This is mainly explained by decreases in exports of "Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials" (-98.9%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-51.7%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-47.0%), "Machinery and transport equipment" (-38.5%), "Ships' stores & bunkers" (-34.6%), "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (-26.4%) and "Food and live animals" (-26.2%), partly offset by increases in exports of "Animals and vegetable oils, fats & waxes" (+33.3%) and "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s." (+24.4%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019, total exports for the second quarter of 2020 decreased by 40.1%. This is mainly explained by decreases in exports of "Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials" (-99.0%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-60.2%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-60.0%), "Machinery and transport equipment" (-58.9%), "Food and live animals" (-22.8%) and "Ship's stores & bunkers" (-19.8%), partly offset by increases in exports of "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (+34.7%) and "Chemicals and related products" (+12.7%).

Compared to corresponding semester of 2019, total exports for the first semester of 2020, decreased by 21.5% which is mainly explained by decreases in "Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials" (-49.9%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-38.5%), "Machinery and transport equipment" (-34.3%), "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-33.1%), "Food and live animals" (-12.0%) and "Chemicals and related products, n.e.s." (-6.5%), partly offset by an increase in "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (+60.2%).

Domestic exports, amounting to Rs 7,588 million, accounted for 61.8% of total exports in the second quarter of 2020. Compared to a value of Rs 11,993 million recorded in the first quarter of 2020, domestic exports decreased by 36.7%. This is mainly explained by decreases in domestic exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-56.6%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-48.9%), "Crude materials, inedible, except fuels" (-43.3%), and "Food and live animals" (-21.2%), partly offset by increases in domestic exports of "Machinery and transport equipment" (+40.0%) and "Beverages and tobacco" (+36.4%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019, domestic exports were lower by 45.4%, mainly explained by decreases in exports of "Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material" (-64.4%), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (-62.0%), "Machinery and transport equipment" (-30.0%) and "Food and live animals" (-20.3%), partly offset by an increase in domestic exports of "Beverages and tobacco" (+95.7%).

² Domestic exports are defined as goods of national origin.

³ Re-exports are goods which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged.

Compared to corresponding semester of 2019, domestic exports for the first semester of 2020, was lower by 26.0%. This decrease is mainly due to decreases in “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-38.7%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-35.3%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-26.8%) and “Food and live animals” (-12.0%), partly offset by an increase in “Beverages and tobacco” (+95.0%).

For the second quarter of 2020, re-exports stood at Rs 2,407 million, i.e. lower by 31.5% compared to the previous quarter, mainly due to decreases in re-exports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (-98.9%), “Food and live animals” (-43.6%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-42.2%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-30.6%), and “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-9.7%), partly offset by an increase in re-exports of “Chemicals and related products” (+22.2%) (*Table 5*).

Compared to the corresponding quarter, re-exports of merchandise goods dropped by 36.0% mainly explained by decreases in “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (-99.0%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-60.6%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-43.5%), “Food and live animals” (-33.2%) and “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-18.4%) partly offset by an increase in “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (+20.2%).

Compared to the corresponding semester of 2019, re-exports decreased by 22.2% in the first semester of 2020. This decrease is mainly due to fall in exports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (-49.9%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-37.7%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-34.7%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-15.4%) and “Food and live animals” (-11.9%), partly offset by an increase in “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (+3.1%).

3.3 Exports of Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) – 2nd Quarter 2020

For the second quarter of 2020, exports of EOE amounted to Rs 5,304 million, compared to Rs 9,535 million in previous quarter (-44.4%) and to Rs 11,461 million in the corresponding quarter of 2019 (-53.7%) (*Table 1*).

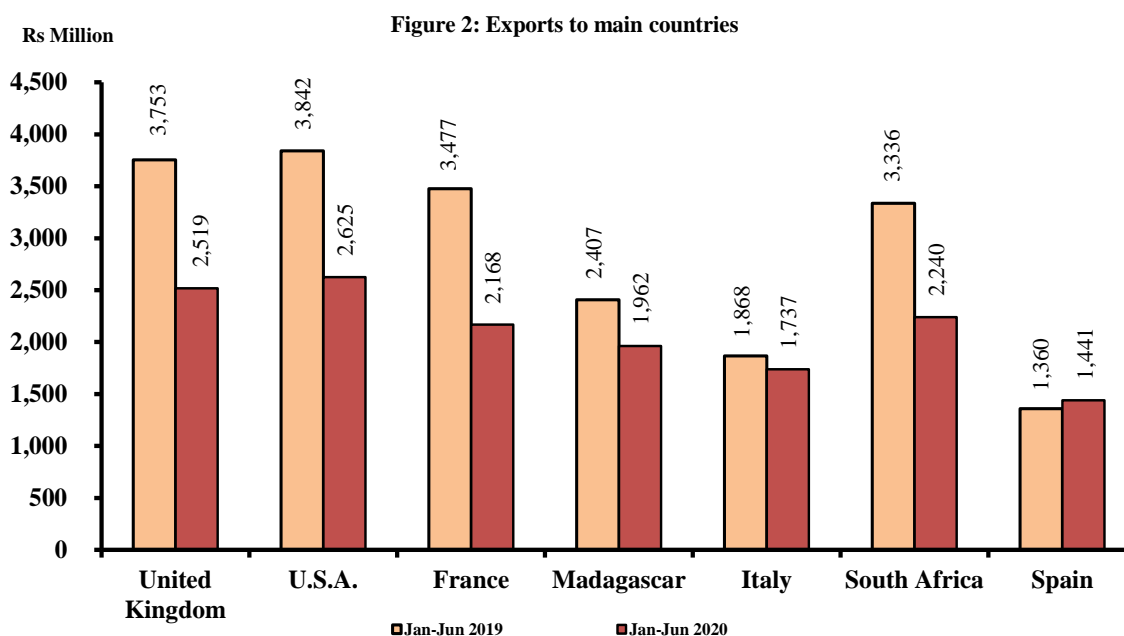
Compared to the corresponding semester, exports of EOE decreased by 31.5%, from Rs 21,676 million to Rs 14,839 million in the first semester of 2020.

Further details on these transactions will be presented in the issue of the Economic and Social Indicator on Export Oriented Enterprises, to be released on 28 September 2020.

3.4 Exports by country of destination (Table 7) – 2nd Quarter 2020

Analysis of exports figures by country of destination for the second quarter of 2020 shows that the European countries were our main buyers, purchasing some 47.6% of our exports for a value of Rs 4,759 million. Among countries, the major destinations for our exports were U.K (10.6%), U.S.A. (10.5%), France (10.0%), Madagascar (8.6%), Italy (8.3%) South Africa (7.5%) and Spain (4.9%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019, exports to South Africa, U.S.A, France, U.K, Spain, Madagascar and Italy dropped by 60.0%, 46.3%, 42.5%, 40.0%, 34.4%, 30.2% and 23.9% respectively.



From Figure 2, compared to the corresponding semester, exports to main markets decreased in the first semester of 2020. Exports to France, UK, South Africa, U.S.A, Madagascar and Italy witnessed decreases of 37.6%, 32.9%, 32.9%, 31.7%, 18.5% and 7.0% respectively, as compared to Spain which has witnessed an increase of 6.0%.

4. Total Imports

4.1 Total imports (Table 10) – 2nd Quarter & 1st Semester 2020

Total imports for the second quarter of 2020 amounted to Rs 34,539 million, showing a decrease of 21.7%, compared to the previous quarter. This is mainly due to decreases in imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (-62.5%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-32.5%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-22.5%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-9.6%) and “Chemicals and related products” (-0.6%), partly offset by an increase in the imports of “Food and live animals” (+22.3%).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019, total imports for the second quarter of 2020 decreased by 28.8%. This is mainly due to decreases in imports of “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (-55.2%), “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-45.9%), “Machinery and transport equipment” (-37.3%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-32.7%), “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (-26.1%) and “Chemicals and related products” (-16.6%), partly offset by an increase in the imports of “Food and live animals” (+11.7%).

Compared to the corresponding semester of 2019, total imports decreased by 17.1% in the first semester of 2020. This decline is mainly explained by decreases in the imports of “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (-30.1%), “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (-27.2%), “Crude materials, inedible, except fuels” (-25.4%), “Mineral fuels, lubricants, & related products” (-18.5%), “Machinery & transport equipment” (-18.2%), “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s.” (-14.1%) and “Food and live animals” (-1.4%) partly offset by an increase in “Animal & vegetable oils and fats” (+35.6%).

4.2 Imports by SITC section (Table 10) – 2nd Quarter 2020

Around 27.2% of imports in the second quarter of 2020 consisted of “Food and live animals” (Rs 9,394 million), 20.4% of “Machinery and transport equipment” (Rs 7,046 million), 16.1% of “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” (Rs 5,568 million), 11.5% “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” (Rs 3,989 million), 10.6% of “Chemicals and related products” (Rs 3,663 million) and 7.4% of “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” (Rs 2,546 million).

Compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019, total imports decreased by 28.8%. Main changes by section are as follows:

- “Mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials” decreased by 55.2%, mainly due to a decrease in the imports of “Refined petroleum products” (-61.3%) and “Gas, natural and manufactured” (-71.1%).
- “Miscellaneous manufactured articles” decreased by 45.9%, mainly due to decreases in the imports of “Jewellery, goldsmiths' & silversmiths' wares, n.e.s ” (-84.7%), “Watches and clocks & optical goods” (-60.0%), “Articles of apparel and clothing” (-48.0%) and “Professional, scientific & controlling instruments & apparatus, n.e.s ” (-24.7%).
- “Machinery and transport equipment” decreased by 37.3%, mainly due to decreases in the imports of “Road vehicles” (-35.0%), “General industrial machinery & equipment, n.e.s., & machine parts, n.e.s” (-21.0%) and “Telecommunications & sound recording & reproducing apparatus & equipment” (-39.1%).
- “Manufactured goods classified chiefly by material” decreased by 32.7%, mainly due to decreases in the imports of “Pearls, precious & semi-precious stones” (-82.7%), “Cement” (-67.2%), “Textile yarn” (-47.7%), “Cotton fabrics” (-31.2%), “Manufactures of metal, n.e.s” (-31.9%) and “Iron and Steel” (-26.8%).
- Crude materials, inedible, except fuels decreased by 26.1% mainly due to decrease in “Textile fibres” (-21.2%).
- “Chemicals and related products” decreased by 16.6%, mainly due to decreases in the imports of “Fertilisers” (-36.3%), “Dyeing & tanning materials” (-30.0%) and “Medicinal & pharmaceutical products” (-2.3%).

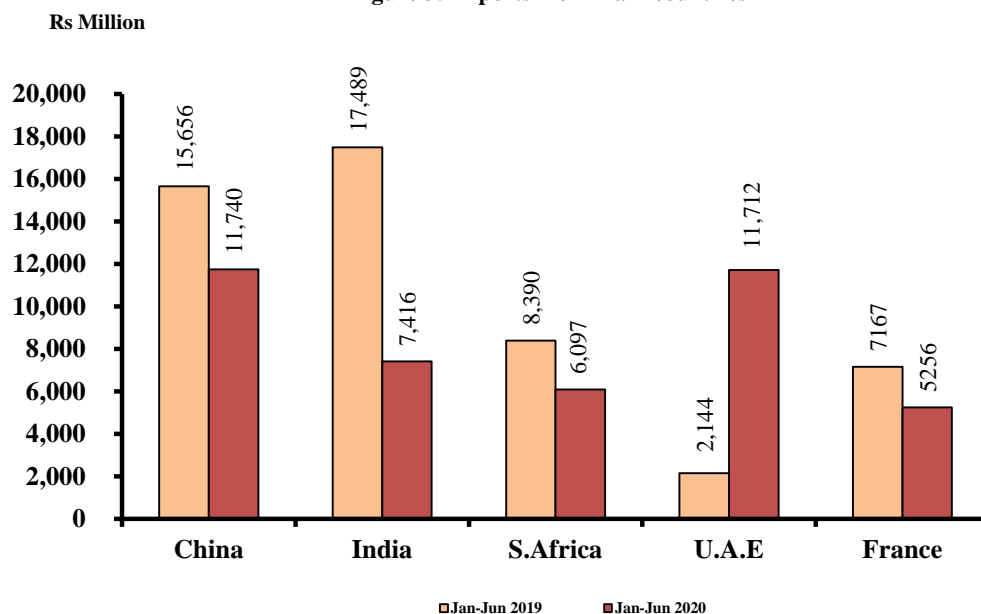
Note that the above mentioned decreases were partly offset by increases in imports of “Animal & vegetable oils and fats” (+ 22.5%) and “Food and live animals” (+11.7%).

4.3 Imports by country of origin – 2nd Quarter 2020

During the second quarter of 2020, our imports originated from five main countries, namely: China (17.9%), India (9.3%), South Africa (8.3%), U.A.E (7.7%) and France (7.3%) (*Table 13*). Among continents Asia was our main supplier with a share of Rs 17,895 million, representing 51.8% of total imports.

Compared to the corresponding period of 2019, total imports from U.A.E rose by 111.8%, while imports from India, South Africa, China and France fell by 64.8%, 30.8%, 24.3% and 24.0% respectively.

From the above Figure 3, compared to the corresponding semester of 2019, China, India, South Africa and France have witnessed decreases of 25.0%, 57.6%, 27.3% and 26.7% in total imports for the first semester of 2020, respectively, as compared to total imports from U.A.E which has increased by 446.3%.

5. Trade with Member States of Regional Organizations – 2nd Quarter 2020

During the second quarter of 2020, total exports to African, Caribbean and Pacific (ACP) States stood at Rs 2,378 million against imports of Rs 4,153 million (*Table 14*). The trade deficit with ACP countries worked out to Rs 1,775 million. South Africa, with a share of 69.3%, is the main supplier whilst Madagascar, with a share of 36.3%, is the main buyer.

Exports to COMESA member states attained Rs 1,455 million while imports from these countries amounted to around Rs 1,406 million, resulting in a trade surplus of Rs 49 million. Madagascar was the main buyer with a share of 59.4% followed by Kenya (20.8%). Our main suppliers were Kenya (31.5%), Egypt (26.4%) and Seychelles (25.5%) (*Table 15*).

Trade with SADC countries showed a deficit of Rs 1,645 million, resulting from imports of Rs 3,576 million against exports worth Rs 1,931 million. The main suppliers were South Africa (80.5%) and Seychelles (10.0%) and our main buyers were Madagascar (44.7%) and South Africa (38.6%) (*Table 16*).

6. Trade in Freeport Zone – 2nd Quarter 2020

During the second quarter of 2020, total imports of the Freeport Zone stood at Rs 1,271 million, lower by 42.6% compared to the corresponding quarter of 2019 and by 25.9% compared to the previous quarter – (*Table 12*). Compared to corresponding semester of 2019, freeport imports fell by 36.7% and for this period, the main items imported were “Food and live animals” (40.1%) and “Chemicals & related products, n.e.s.” (21.3%).

Re-exports were valued at Rs 1,793 million, representing a decrease of 33.4% compared to the corresponding period of 2019 (*Table 6*). Compared to corresponding semester, a decrease of 21.5% was noticed mainly explained by decreases in the main items re-exported namely “Food and live animals” and “Chemicals and related products, n.e.s”.

7. Forecast 2020

Based on trends and information from various sources, the forecast of total exports for 2020 will be around Rs 64,400 million, 18.6% lower than the total exports of around Rs 79,100 million in 2019. Total imports for 2020, including one-off items such as metro trains and linear accelerator for cancer treatment, will be around Rs 187,700 million, 7.1% lower than the total imports of around Rs 202,000 million in 2019.

The trade deficit for 2020 is forecasted at around Rs 123,300 million, 0.3% higher as compared to around Rs 122,900 million in 2019.

Notes

(1) Scope and coverage

External merchandise trade statistics are compiled according to the General Trade System as recommended by the United Nations. Using the national boundary as the statistical frontier, the General Trade System is a record of all goods entering (imports) and leaving the country (exports).

Imports include goods brought in directly for domestic consumption plus goods imported into customs bonded warehouses.

Exports cover:

- Domestic exports defined as goods of national origin, that is goods produced in the exporting country.
- Re-exports which are exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor operations which leave them essentially unchanged and include re-exports from customs bonded warehouses.
- Ship's Stores and Bunkers (SSB) are included in total exports and are shown separately.

Trade by parcel post is also included in imports and exports.

(2) Valuation

Imports are valued on a C.I.F. (Cost, Insurance and Freight) basis, whilst exports on a F.O.B. (Free on Board) basis.

Cost, Insurance and Freight (C.I.F) value is the value of a country's imports of goods, including all charges for transporting and insuring the goods from the country of exports to the given country but excluding the cost of unloading from the ship, aircraft unless it is borne by the carrier.

Free on Board (F.O.B) value is the value of a country's exports of goods, including all costs of transporting the goods to the customs frontier, export duties.

(3) Classification of commodities

Commodities are coded according to the **Harmonised Commodity Description and Coding System Nomenclature (HS 2017)**. However, for the purposes of economic analysis and to facilitate international comparison of trade by commodity data, the commodities are also classified according to **the Standard International Trade Classification (Revision 4) (SITC Rev. 4)**. The HS and the SITC Rev. 4 are six- and five-digit codes respectively but have been extended to eight and seven digits to accommodate national requirements.
