AGRICULTURAL AND FISH PRODUCTION

(January-June 2020)

Introduction

This issue of the Economic and Social Indicators presents data on agricultural and fish production for the Island of Mauritius for the first six months of 2020, as well as revised figures for year 2019. It is to be noted that the lockdown due to the COVID-19 pandemic has adversely affected production in first semester of 2020. Additionally, unfavourable climatic conditions have affected the production of agricultural crops. Table 1 shows area harvested and production in respect of the main agricultural crops, while Table 2 shows production of the main agro-industrial products. Details on the sugar industry and food crops are given in Tables 3 and 5 respectively.

2. Sugar cane

At the end of June 2020, some 467 hectares under sugar cane were harvested, yielding 37,104 tonnes of sugar cane and 5,082 tonnes of sugar. The corresponding figures for the same period in 2019 were 1,228 hectares, 96,747 tonnes of sugar cane and 11,709 tonnes of sugar respectively. The average extraction rate as at end of June 2020 was 8.68%, higher than the 8.48% as at end of June 2019.

According to Mauritius Chamber of Agriculture, production of sugar for the crop year 2020 will be around 290,000 tonnes, representing a decrease of 12.4%, compared to 331,105 tonnes in 2019.

3. Tea

At the end of June 2020, area under tea plantation was 685 hectares representing an increase of 4.4% over the figure of 656 hectares during the same period of 2019. However, the production of green tea leaves went down by 47.6%: 2,606 tonnes in first semester of 2020 as compared to 4,970 tonnes during the same period of 2019.

Consequently, the production of manufactured tea decreased by 45.2% from 899 tonnes in the first semester of 2019 to 493 tonnes in the same period of 2020. Further details on tea production are given in Table 4.

4. Food crops

Data on food crops (except paddy rice) production, are supplied by the Food and Agricultural Research and Extension Institute (FAREI). Figures are thereafter adjusted to take into account backyard production of banana, eddoes, manioc and sweet potato. Data on paddy rice was obtained from concerned establishment.

The area under food crops harvested decreased by 7.9% from 3,238 hectares in the first semester of 2019 to 2,981 hectares in the same period of 2020. The production of food crops decreased by 17.8% from 37,846 tonnes to 31,120 tonnes during the same period. It is to be noted that there was no rice cultivation in the first semester of 2020 compared to 6 hectares harvested during the same period of 2019. There was no production of paddy rice in the first semester of 2020 compared to 21 tonnes during the same period of 2019.

5. Livestock

Data on production of beef, goat meat, mutton and pork are supplied by Mauritius Meat Authority. It is to be noted that these data represent only animals slaughtered by the Central Abattoir, including live animals imported from Rodrigues and other countries for slaughter.

During the first half of 2020, the production of beef from live cattle was 946 tonnes, as compared to 1,161 tonnes registered in the corresponding period of 2019. Beef production from the slaughter of imported cattle, accounting for 98.7% of the total production, decreased by 16.6% from 1,120 tonnes to 934 tonnes. Local beef production went down from 41 tonnes to 12 tonnes.

The production of goat meat and mutton dropped by 22.2% from 27 tonnes during the first semester of 2019 to 21 tonnes for the same period of 2020. The share of local production, inclusive of Rodrigues, stood at 28.6%.

The production of pork fell by 17.0% from 271 tonnes in the first semester of 2019 to 225 tonnes during the same period of 2020.

6. Poultry

The production of poultry decreased by 8.5% from 24,600 tonnes in the first semester of 2019 to 22,500 tonnes during the same period of 2020.

7. Fish

Total fish production went down by 22.3% from 15,800 tonnes in the first six months of 2019 to 12,278 tonnes in the same period of 2020. This decrease was attributable to a drop of 21.4% in the production of other catch (tuna, bank etc) from 14,932 tonnes in 2019 to 11,736 tonnes in 2020, as well as a decrease of 37.6% in the production of fresh coastal fish catch from 868 tonnes in the first semester of 2019 to 542 tonnes during the same period of 2020.
