## Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE) 3rd Quarter 2020

## 1. Introduction

This issue of "Economic and Social Indicators" (ESI) presents the results of the Quarterly Survey of Employment among Export Oriented Enterprises (EOE), conducted by Statistics Mauritius at the end of September 2020.
It also includes provisional figures on EOE imports and exports for the third quarter of 2020 as well as figures for the years 2018 and 2019. Table 1 shows the main indicators of the EOE sector for the period 2011 to 2019.

EOE consist of enterprises formerly holding an EPZ certificate as well as enterprises manufacturing goods for export and holding a registration certificate issued by the exBoard of Investment.

## 2. Employment

### 2.1 Employment - 3rd Quarter 2020

Compared to the second quarter of 2020, employment in EOE decreased by 2,054 $(-4.8 \%)$ from 42,651 to 40,597 . Male employment dropped by 651 from 22,270 to 21,619 and female employment decreased by 1,403 from 20,381 to 18,978 (Table 2).

The number of Mauritians employed in the EOE sector went down by 1,011 $(-4.5 \%)$ ( -201 males and -810 females) from 22,562 to 21,551 and the number of foreign workers decreased by $1,043(-5.2 \%)(-450$ males and -593 females) from 20,089 at the end of June 2020 to 19,046 at the end of September 2020 (Table 2).

The decrease of 2,054 in employment in the EOE sector during the third quarter of 2020 is the net result of 170 jobs created due to expansion in existing enterprises and 2,224 jobs lost. The job losses were due to the contraction of workforce.

### 2.2 Evolution of employment from September 2019 to September 2020

From September 2019 to September 2020, total employment in EOE decreased by $5,053(-11.1 \%)$ from 45,650 to 40,597 . The number of Mauritian workers decreased by 3,356 ( $-1,000$ males and $-2,356$ females). Employment of foreign workers decreased by 1,697 ( $-1,148$ males and -549 females) (Tables 2 and 5).

Job losses occurred mainly in enterprises engaged in the manufacture of "Wearing apparel" with a decrease of 3,827 jobs (Table 4).

More details of employment by product group and sex are given in Table 3 and changes in employment by product group in Table 4.

## 3. Exports and Imports

Statistics on imports and exports are compiled from declarations lodged at Customs by importers and exporters. Some of these declarations are, at times, revised at a later period and corrections made accordingly on the computerised database of the Mauritius Revenue Authority (MRA) - Customs Department. Thus, while figures for 2018 are final, those for 2019 and for the first three quarters of 2020 are subject to revision as and when the MRA - Customs Department submits latest amendments to Statistics Mauritius.

### 3.1 Exports and Imports - 3rd Quarter 2020

### 3.1.1 Exports (f.o.b)

Provisional figures show that EOE exports during the third quarter of 2020 amounted to R 11,458 million, that is, $\mathrm{R} 6,154$ million ( $+116.0 \%$ ) higher compared to R 5,304 million in the second quarter of 2020 (Table 6). That was mainly the result of increases observed in exports of "Articles of apparel and clothing" ( $+\mathrm{R} 3,103$ million or $+176.5 \%$ ), "Fish and fish preparations" ( $+\mathrm{R} 1,043$ million or $+64.9 \%$ ), "Textile yarn, fabrics, made up articles" $(+\mathrm{R} 740$ million or $+137.3 \%)$ and "Pearls, precious and semiprecious stones" ( +R 632 million or $+1053.3 \%$ ).
Compared to the figure of $\mathrm{R} 10,677$ million for the corresponding quarter of 2019, EOE exports increased by R 781 million or $+7.3 \%$.

Details on EOE exports by section are given in Table 7.
South Africa, United Kingdom (UK), United States of America (USA) and France together accounted for R 6,064 million ( $52.9 \%$ ) of total EOE exports (Table 9). The table below highlights the changes in our main EOE exports markets.

Compared to the previous quarter, EOE exports to our main markets showed increases as follows: South Africa ( $+446.9 \%$ ), United Kingdom ( $+80.9 \%$ ), USA ( $+72.8 \%$ ) and France ( $+49.5 \%$ ).

When compared to the third quarter of 2019, exports to South Africa showed an increase of $32.0 \%$ whilst decreases of $15.1 \%, 4.0 \%$ and $1.2 \%$ respectively were noted for USA, United Kingdom and France.

Further details are given in Table 9.

### 3.1.2 Imports (c.i.f)

EOE imports during the third quarter of 2020 were estimated at $\mathrm{R} 5,350$ million, representing an increase of $\mathrm{R} 1,657$ million ( $+44.9 \%$ ) compared to $\mathrm{R} 3,693$ million in the second quarter of 2020 (Table 6). This increase is mainly due to higher imports of raw materials by R 1,649 million ( $+47.4 \%$ ).

Compared to the figure of R 6,113 million for the corresponding quarter of 2019, EOE imports decreased by R 763 million ( $-12.5 \%$ ), mainly due to decreases in imports of "Textile yarn and fabrics" by R 375 million ( $-31.9 \%$ ), "Cotton" by R 148 million ( $-38.7 \%$ ) and "Wool and other animal hair" by R 128 million ( $-89.5 \%$ ). Details on EOE imports by section are given in Table 8.

### 3.1.3 Net exports

Net exports, i.e. exports minus imports, amounted to $\mathrm{R} 6,108$ million in the third quarter of 2020 and its ratio to total exports worked out to $53.3 \%$ compared to $42.7 \%$ in the corresponding quarter of 2019 (Table 6).

It is to be noted that the above exports and imports figures do not include transactions of the EOE with the Freeport. EOE sales to the Freeport, considered as local sales, were valued at R 6 million in the third quarter of 2020 compared to R 41 million in the third quarter of 2019. These sales are included in exports of Freeport, as and when the goods leave the country.
