1. The Consumer Price Index (CPI) increased by 0.9 point or 0.8% from 106.1 in December 2020 to 107.0 in January 2021. The main contributors to the change in the index between December 2020 and January 2021 were:

- 2. **Year-on-year (Y-o-y) inflation worked out to 1.0% in January 2021,** down from 2.0% in January 2020. **Headline inflation for the 12-months ending January 2021** worked out to 2.5%, compared to 0.6% for the 12-months ending January 2020.
- 3. **Y-o-y CORE1 inflation stood at 2.6% in January 2021**, compared to 0.3% in January 2020 while, **y-o-y CORE2 inflation for January 2021** was 3.8%, compared to 1.5% in January 2020.
- 4. **CORE1 inflation for the 12-months ending January 2021** stood at 2.0%, up from 0.3% for January 2020. Similarly, **CORE2 inflation for the 12-months ending January 2021**, was 3.2%, compared to 1.7% in January 2020.



Notes:

- a) **CORE1** excludes "Food, beverages and tobacco" components and mortgage interest on housing loan from headline inflation.
- b) **CORE2** excludes Food, beverages and tobacco, mortgage interest on housing loan, electricity, gas, other fuels and items whose prices are controlled from headline inflation.
- c) The **headline inflation rate** is calculated by using the annual average method, that is, by comparing the average level of prices during a twelve-month period with the average level during the corresponding previous twelve-month period.
- d) The **year-on-year inflation rate** is calculated as the percentage change in the CPI for a given month with respect to the CPI for the corresponding month of the previous year.
