Balance of Visible Trade showed a deficit of Rs 15,930 million in December 2021, lower by 6.7% compared to the previous month and higher by 61.9% compared to the corresponding month of 2020.

In December 2021, Madagascar (9.4%), South Africa (9.2%), United Kingdom (8.4%), United States (8.3%), France (8.2%) and Viet Nam (5.9%) were our major exports destinations while our imports were mainly from China (22.1%), India (13.0%), South Africa (9.9%), France (7.6%), U.A.E (7.4%) and Turkey (3.5%).
