In January 2023, United Kingdom (11.6%), South Africa (11.3%), France (9.0%), Spain (8.1%), Madagascar (7.7%) and United States (7.5%) were our major exports destinations while our imports were mainly from U.A.E. (20.4%), China (14.3%), South Africa (7.2%), France (6.6%), India (6.4%) and United States (3.1%).
